

Mrs. Amiya Pathak Borpujari, Secretary, MRC announced the objectives of the meet. Mr. Biplob Parashar Khound, Assistant Director, Mrinaljyoti presented the Annual Activity & Financial Report (2018-19), both of which were accepted by the house. The "Gulab Rai Nihalani Scholarship (2018-19)" was awarded to Riya Sonowal (₹5000.00), Duliajan, Rinku Bora (₹2500.00), Digboi and Krishna Mallik (₹2500.00), Rajgarh along with a certificate to each by Mrs. Anita Nihalani. The President and members of Zaloni Ladies Club handed over a cheque of ₹60,000.00 to the Secretary of MRC as an annual donation.



2. Independent Projects

i) School (Inclusive and Special Schooling)

The school run by Mrinaljyoti has two setups, they are special and inclusive. The special setup was started in the year 1999 which marked the beginning of the organization itself. Keeping in view the necessity; Mrinaljyoti also started the inclusive setup in 2016. The school got prior permission to start an elementary school under the Directorate of Elementary Education, Government of Assam and its registration is under the process in the Directorate which will be completed very soon. The school is governed by a School Management Committee (SMC) as per the School Management Scheme which has been constituted according to the Section 12 of 'Assam Non-Govt. Educational Institution (regulation & management) act 2006 and rules 2007'. 18150610806 is the UDISE Code of the school.



ii) Early Intervention (EI)

It has been proven that early intervention is the best intervention and early rehabilitation is the best rehabilitation. Since the past few years as rehabilitation centre, our prime focus has shifted to detect children with disabilities at an early age, so that we can provide them with necessary interventions and to mainstreaming them. Our early intervention services include early detection, physiotherapy, speech therapy, occupational therapy, counseling, school readiness program etc. We have been closely monitoring the children who have been already mainstreamed & keeping an eye on their development for their good performance.



iii) Vocational Activities

To impart livelihood trainings to Persons with Disabilities, Mrinaljyoti started the vocational training center and has been providing various vocational training to them through vocational class. The areas of skill development trainings are:

- a. Sewing
- b. Weaving

- c. Embroidery
- d. Knitting

- e. Tailoring
- f. Block printing
- g. Handicraft making

- h. Diya making
- i. Food processing

During the year various initiatives and steps were taken to rejuvenate the vocational center of Mrinaljyoti. In the process the vocational center was named "PUSHPDALUM". The 'Griha' is an inevitable part of the project Pushpdalum which produces food items and markets them as well. To professionalize the vocational activities of Mrinaljyoti project 'PARIJAT' has been started under the flagship of OIL about which elaborate description is given under the trailing head 'Unified Project'. The project Griha was launched on 11.09.2019 by Srijut Rameswar Teli, MOS, Food Processing Industries, Govt. of India.



iv) Outreach Centers

Special Education, physiotherapy, speech therapy, occupational therapy, counseling, awareness programme, school readiness etc. are some of the services provided in the outreach centers. Addresses of both the centres are given below:

3. <u>Unified Projects</u>

i) Jyotiniwas (Home for Children with Disabilities)

The children home provides care, protection and education to the destitute children mostly referred by the Child Welfare Committees (CWCs). Children with Disabilities from incapacitate parents are also given hostel facilities here under the CWC. To run this home for boys and girls financial support is being provided by State Child Protection Society, Assam. There are 7 girls and 24 boys in the home.



ii) RAISE-North - East

Mrinaljyoti is a partner organization in the Regional Action for Inclusive Education-North - East (RAISE-NE) project along with 15 NGOs and 3 INGOs and is working to promote inclusive educational environment in SSA schools. The project is in its fourth and penultimate year. Under the project Mrinaljyoti has been working with 5 SSA partner schools viz. Kachari Pathar ME School, Madhya Zaloni LP School, Pragjyotishpur LP School, Naharkatia Town LP School and Nabajyoti Adarsha School. Through the project Mrinaljyoti is developing itself in to a resource centre.



iii) Uttaran (DISHA Project)

"DISHA" is an early interventional project that Mrinaljyoti is currently running under the National Trust, MSJ&E, Government of India viz. Uttaran. The aim of the project is to mainstream Children with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities by providing various supportive services like physiotherapy, speech therapy, special education, counseling etc. from the age group of 0 to 10 years. The batch capacity of the project is 20 at a time. 13 nos. of CwDs were mainstreamed during the past years.



iv) Community Based Rehabilitation (CBR)

The CBR project of Mrinaljyoti is supported by the Caritas India- CBRF, Bangalore. The project lunched on 1st April, 2019 is being implemented in 22 villages of Tengakhat Development Block to empower Persons with Disabilities in five CBR matrix viz. health, education, social, livelihood and empowerment. The number of beneficiaries under the project is 222 (by 31st March, 2020).

v) Project Parijat

Project PARIJAT is a venture under the flagship of Oil India Limited, Duliajan. The project was inaugurated by Mr. Pranjit Deka, RCE, OIL, Duliajan on 30.11, 2019. The aim of the project is to produce baby kits for the new born babies born in OIL Hospital, Duliajan. This project engages PwDs who are 18 years and above and whose school life in Mrinaljyoti is over and are sitting at home idle. With this initiative from OIL, these children are not only engaged but they are also earning a livelihood with dignity. The project aims to employ more Children with Disabilities in the near future. We thank OIL for supporting this venture and we pray that this project continues and help more Children with Disabilities.

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

OPINION

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of <u>MRINALJYOTI RAHABILITATION</u> <u>CENTRE, KUMUD NAGAR, DULIAJAN, Dist.
