# Introductory Information about the Organization

YVSS Jaya Lakshmi and Y Srinivas are the proud parents of a Special Daughter, precious jewel SINDHURI who is microcephalus having problems in speech, self care and academics. Because of her condition, Mrs. Jayalakshmi was compelled to restart education career in 2002 and completed diploma in special education and B. Ed (Special Education). From 2003 to 2009 worked as a special teacher in various institutions. Mrs. Jayalakshmi has succeeded a lot in training her daughter and improving her behavior. This inspired us to share our skills and extend services to many children with similar disorders, hence started an individual therapy centre for special children (Intellectually Challenged) from 2009 with 2 children along with Sindhuri.

There were many parents who were looking for this kind of support mainly because of lack of knowledge and proper understanding about handling this kind of situation and condition of their children. Within a couple of years the centre had 20 children to attend and be treated. We have registered by name PRABHATA SINDHURI EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY under registrar of societies on 11<sup>th</sup> Jan 2012. Since then we have been training intellectually challenged, Autism, Cerebral Palsy and Multiple Disabled Children.

## **Organization Activities**

- Special School for Children with Intellectual Disabilities
- Conducting Screening camps for identification of children with IDD
- Training to the Parents on Home Management for the development of the children with IDD
- Awareness Camps about the right perspective towards the IDD children from all sections of society
- Providing Health Insurance NIRAMAYA through The National Trust, New Delhi for all the children with IDD.
- Working closely with likeminded NGO's who are from the similar field for the uplilftment of the children with IDD.

PRABHATA SINDHURI EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY is the implementing agency on behalf of The National Trust, New Delhi for the Project Disha (Early Intervention & School Readiness Program) Centre and Vikaas (Day Care) since 15th March 2016.

#### Services being provided to the beneficiaries

Early Intervention and Sensory Integration, Special Education, Speech Therapy, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Music Therapy, Dance, Yoga and Pre Vocational Skills

PRABHATA SINDHURI SPECIAL SCHOOL reopened on 1st June 2019 and conducted the Parents Meet on 11th June 2019. In the meeting the home tasks given were discussed, evaluated and parents have expressed satisfaction towards their children improvement. The student strength has reached to 60 trainees at the end of this academic year. To attend the needs of all the trainees, we have fulltime employees of four Special Educators, two Assistant Teachers, one Physiotherapist, one occupational therapist supported by 3 care takers and on a part time basis we have one speech therapist, one music teacher, one drawing teacher apart from Accountant cum Office Assistant. Two Doctors, One Pediatrician and one ophthalmologist visited the school as and when the need arises. We are also providing free mid day lunch and protein food as snacks to all the beneficiaries.

### Activities/ Celebrations / Workshops / Visitors from 1st June 2019 to 30th May 2020.

- On 4th June 2019, inaugurated readymade swimming pool for CP, Autism and ADHD children.
- On 15th June 2019 faculty along with vocational trainees visited chalk piece making unit here at Guntur and took training about making of chalk piece.
- On 20th June 2019 celebrated SAKSHAM 11th Foundation Day and invited all the other NGO's from Guntur and conducted sports and cultural events and distributed bus passes, certificated and prizes to the winners.
- On 21st June 2019 celebrated International Yoga Day in School premises.
- On 5<sup>th</sup> July 2019 Inaugurated Hand operated Oil expeller, Mini Floor Mill, Chalk piece making unit for the purpose of imparting pre vocational skills and also conducted workshop on the Need of Vocational Rehabilitation and the support required from the Parents.
- On 24<sup>th</sup> July 2019 we have inaugurated Tailoring Unit with 2 sewing machines. Started training in Cloth bag making to adult girls who are interested.
- On 2<sup>nd</sup> Aug 2019, we have conducted Awareness Campaign near to our School premises about the concept avoid the
  usage of plastic and encourage the cloth bags. We have also distributed 100 plants and 100 cloth bags to the public
  which were made by our trainees.
- On 3<sup>rd</sup> Aug 2019, celebrated our Foundation Day. Cultural events conducted among all the levels and distributed prizes and certificates to all the participants.
- On 9<sup>th</sup>Aug 2019 our Director attended Yoga Training camp for a period of 7 days at SVYASA at Bengaluru to support the Special Children in practicing Yoga Skills.
- On 22<sup>nd</sup> Aug 2019, Dr Syed Ali a renowned psychiatrist from CANADA visited the school and interacted with the children and assured about his support to the organization. Also verified the medical history of the special children and given the suggestions to the therapy staff and the special educators for better improvement.
- On 5<sup>th</sup> Sep 2019, celebrated Teacher's Day function and felicitated the staff members who are doing tremendous services to all the special children. Some of the vocational trainees have shared their feelings about the staff members and enjoyed their happiness.
- On 15<sup>th</sup> Aug 2019, Celebrated Independence Day and also Rakhi festival and distributed chocolates to the children and conducted cultural events. All the Rakhi's made by the children were exhibited.
- On 24<sup>th</sup> Aug 2019, celebrated Krishna Janmashtami in the school premises and all the children actively participated in the fancy dress competitions.
- On 11th Sep 2019, our Director has attended the 19th AGM of The National Trust at New Delhi and shared all the feedback to the staff members.
- On 15<sup>th</sup> Sep 2019, started the activity of painting Diyas involving all the vocational boys and girls for the purpose of Diwali festival.
- On 2<sup>nd</sup> Oct 2019 celebrated Gandhi Jayanthi and distributed chocolates to the children. From this day onwards trainees started making diyas and candles for Diwali Festival preparations.

- On 16<sup>th</sup> Oct 2019 conducted an exhibition of our vocational products Diyas, chalk piece, phenol, cloth bags, candles, different flour powders made from flourmill at Women's College, Guntur. All the students have actively participated in the exhibition and encouraged by purchasing the products. Our vocational girls have participated in cultural events also on that day.
- On 23<sup>rd</sup> Oct 2019 all the staff and children participated in Joy of Giving Program conducted by Hindu Pharmacy College Students, Guntur. We were asked to exhibit the all the products made by our vocational children and fund rising activity was also held on the same day by the Hindu College management by purchasing our vocational products.
- On 25<sup>th</sup> Oct 2019 celebrated pre Diwali festival in the school premises and by lighting the lamps by the children. Also celebrated with crackers safely and all the children were distributed with sweets.
- On 14th Nov 2019, celebrated Children's Day in school premises along and distributed chocolates.
- On 22<sup>nd</sup> Nov 2019, inaugurated the Jute Bag Sewing Machine for the purpose of training and vocational girls have shown interest in learning the jute bag making.
- On 3<sup>rd</sup> Dec 2019, celebrated WORLD DISABLE DAY in the school, conducted sports for boys and girls and distributed certificates and gifts to all the participants. On this day or Local Project committee members planted the plants and also conducted the meeting after the Program. We have also inaugurated the Sales Counter displaying all the vocational products made by the trainees.
- On 6<sup>th</sup> Dec 2019 onwards children started making the Greeting cards for New Year and Pongal Festival preparations and also aplic work on cotton bags and also started making Cotton Cloth Bags (Fridge covers) for storage of vegetables.
- On 7<sup>th</sup> Dec 2019, NGO's Meet SEVA SANGAMAM held at Vijayawada conducted by SEVABHARATHI, ANDHRA PRADESH. Prabhata Sindhuri Staff and Children participated in the event for 2 days i.e. 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>. We have also taken a stall for sales and display of all the vocational products made by our trainees. Governor of Andhra Pradesh was the chief guest for this event and appreciated the good work done by all the NGO's.
- On 11th Dec 2019, we have visited KDB Trust, Yelakurru, Krishna District (RO of National Trust) and observed the good practices followed by RO and noted. Also appreciated the management about their good work. We have visited the place called PEDANA which is famous for kalamkari work and also procured suitable moulds and colors for cloth bags making and training purpose.
- On 18th Dec 2019, Staff and Girls visited the Ramakrishna Mission to attend the Pooja on account of Matha Sarada Devi Birthday celebrations.
- On 21st and 22nd Dec 2019, We have attended National Level Workshop DHEEMAHI at Samvedana, Latur, Maharashtra (RO of National Trust) conducted by SAKSHAM. We have also identified and observed all the good practices followed by the RO Samvedana Latur. We have also visited the Residential School organized by RSS on this occasion and observed all the bio gas plant and organic methods followed in the agriculture.
- On 24th Dec 2019 conducted pre **CHRISTAMAS** celebrations.
- On30th Dec 2019, celebrated the National Trust Foundation day and distributed plants to all the parents and the trainees.

- On 31<sup>st</sup> Dec 2019, conducted Rangoli competitions among the parents and trainees and also cultural events to all the parents and the trainees. We have also attended Medical Camp conducted by SAKSHAM and the Chief Doctor Mr Taral Nagda from Mumbai came to the camp and tested all our CP students and advised about the treatment therapeutically needed and also the surgery requirement for few children.
- On 8<sup>th</sup> Jan 2020, we have celebrated pre **PONGAL** festival and explained the importance of the festival and concepts involved like Bhogi Pallu, Bhogi Mantalu, Gobbillu and Rangoli.
- On 26th Jan 2020, Celebrated Republic Day and all the children participated in cultural events. Dr Varalakshmi LPC Member and also Parent Members were present on this occasion and also distributed sweets and gifts to the children.
- On 17<sup>th</sup> Feb, 2020, we have taken the girls for outing to visit the Viswajanani Parishat (Jillellamudi Asramam) along the staff members on account of Dhanyabhishekam. All the children were actively participated the event.
- From 20th Feb 2020 onwards the vocational trainees who were involved in the cotton cloth bag making have started making the fridge coves (Pre Printed) for vegetables storage purpose.
- On 10<sup>th</sup> Mar 2020, we have celebrated HOLI festival and all the children actively participated and sweets were distributed after the cultural events.
- From 13<sup>th</sup> Mar 2020, our vocational trainees started making the cotton masks as precautions of COVID 19.
- On 21st Mar 2020 celebrated Down Syndrome Day through ONLINE and appreciated the good work done by all the trainees.
- On 11<sup>th</sup> April 2020 onwards we have distributed approx.15000 cotton reusable masks to various sections of society in and around Guntur city. We would like to convey our thanks to the management of YCT, Dr. Raghavarao and family, Dr Bala Bhaskara Rao garu and Sevabharathi, Guntur for their valuable support.

Teaching and Learning Material (TLM) provided as per the requirement from the respective classes throughout the year. Teachers meet the Management on every Saturday to discuss about the performance related issues, problems if any and achievements.

**Supporting the stranded MIGRANT Laborers** and the Economically Backward in different areas of Guntur (Janmabhoomi Nagar, Taraka Rama Nagar, Stambala Garuvu, Arandal pet etc to name a few) as responsible Indians, we identified the people who are in need and distributed free food, vegetables and groceries to all these people.
