Thousands of people with disabilities have so far been benefitted and rehabilitated through the sincere efforts put by our organization. The organization has been promoted by a group of social workers and activists through organized and sincere efforts to address the grass root community issues with special focus to PWDs. So far, we have played a pioneering role in initiating and augmenting services for PWDs and endeavored to meet the growing needs for children and adults with locomotor disabilities, cerebral palsy, autism, hearing impairment and multiple disabilities in the community. So far, we have been getting support from Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, New Delhi for the cause.

The organization is operational in Muzaffarpur and Sitamarhi districts in Bihar and managed by a seven member executive committee comprising 1 female and 6 males. The organization visualizes a progressive and sustainable society

The problem of disability is gaining more and more importance all over the world. In India "3% of India's children are mentally/physically challenged."In its endeavor to extend educational opportunities to the ignored special children especially who are mentally disabled, Baba Garibnath Viklang sah-jan seva sansthan for mentally challenged.

BGVSJSS School for Mentally Challenged was setup in the year 2001 with a vision to create and provide educational infrastructure for the neglected children of the society due to their mental disability. The vision of the school is to create & provide education infrastructure for the mentally disabled children to assist them in normal development and attain inclusive education. The entire process shall instill a confidence among these children to face life with courage and confidence in the society.

BGVSJSS School for Mentally Challenged offers a learning friendly environment, to facilitate the learning and development of the mentally disabled child. The School uses services of Special Educators who are trained to understand the special needs of the mentally disabled children for ensuring effective delivery of the school curriculum. Multiple techniques of teaching are adopted and incorporated by the Special Educators for teaching the children of the school. Sensory training & perceptual knowledge is stressed on and the children are taught utilitarian tasks to help them become more independent.

Since its inception, BGVSJSS School for Mentally challenged has successfully educated more than 12 special children and provided them an equal opportunity to live a respectable life.









Details of SERVICES PROVIDED:

Considering the needs of the special students a well equipped and planned building is designed. In all 05 Class rooms are provided. Separate class rooms are provided for various subjects: Maths, Language, Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Physiotherapy, Special Child class room, Sports room, Music Room, Medical check up room, Staff room & Principal Room.

World Disabled Day:- On World disabled day our aim to promote awareness and understanding disability issues and to mobilize support for dignity rights and well-being of person with disability. Every year we do so many programme to encourage our students.









World Deaf-Dumb Day:- We celebrate important days and events in our school inviting the students from local school in order to promate awareness about the disabilities and also to develop empathetic concern and social responsibility towards the special children.



Economic Empowerment and Entrepreneurship:- Not only the students at the vocational unit but also their parents are empowerment and encouraged towards Entrepreneurship. The parents make money through the sale of School bags, blouses, skirt, shirt and salwar suit. to the local shops. The tailor unit run by the parents association is also making good money and support the parents.

COVID19:- We provide Foods such as (biscuits, rice, pulses, salt, oil, potato, onion, spices & etc.) to poor people and disabled children's family.

We give mask and sanitizer in rural and urban both areas. Also do awareness program about the importance of hand wash and mask.
