## **INTRODUCTION**

### **AAKANKSHA LIONS INSTITUTE OF LEARNING AND EMPOWERMENT**

Aakanksha Lions Institute of Learning And Empowerment run by Lions Sewa Samiti (reg no.No.905 dt.17-12-1991) started on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 1994. There are 75 professional and personnel taking care of 336 special children (from the three centres of Aakanksha at Raipur , Beergaon and Dharsiwa and also services rendered to special children for speech therapy, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, and Remedial services.The OPD services for the psychological assessment and counseling is 124 and services for persons with deafblindness is 100. Hence a total of 560 beneficiaries were benefitted from the services of Aakanksha Lions Institute of Learning and Empowerment Raipur Chhattisgarh.

All the centre based services in Raipur are functional in a barrier free building with a provision of Smart Classes for both the special children and Student Trainees . The ground floor comprises of a well equipped physiotherapy unit, speech therapy unit, remedial unit, multisensory stimulation room, occupational therapy unit, seminar hall, classrooms for diploma in special education in intellectual disability , Visual Impairment, Cerebral Palsy, and Bachelors in Education-B.ED. Special (Intellectual Disability) courses, and the administrative section. The first floor comprises of special school, pre-vocational training centre, 2<sup>nd</sup> year classroom for Bachelors in Education-B.ED(I D ) and girls hostel for the trainees.

## **OBJECTIVES**

- To enhance self-dependence of children through application of special education and behaviour modification principles.
- To provide need based intervention and training to the persons with disabilities by reaching to the unreached.
- To train and develop human resources to prepare special teachers to train persons with special needs in individual and group settings.
- Enhance Mobility and balance through Sensory swing and Garden.

- Improve Control in muscles joints to be achieved through stimulation in swings.
- Improving eye-hand co-ordination.
- Developing social and communication skill.
- Improving their digestive system while playing for half an hour in the garden.
- Training in curricular and co-curricular activities.
- Rehabilitate them in main stream.
- Improvement in confidence.
- Happiness on parent's face when they watch their children play.
- Sensory Garden given by AOF enhanced children's happiness. Job placement for children with special needs.

## **VISION**

Serving humanity is one of the better versions of social work .It is difficult to serve the people with special needs and even more so to serve mentally challenged people. We choose the most challenging and most neglected option due to various reasons:

Lack of adequate facility in Raipur, C.G., to serve all the mentally challenged

- By serving the mentally challenged people we empower and strengthen the families of the special children to cope up with their difficulties in bringing up these children.
- Providing respite to parents and siblings and thereby helping them to constructively contribute elsewhere.
- Skill development in children and persons with special needs.

The vision of Aakanksha is kaleidoscopic, providing need based intervention and training to the persons with disabilities by reaching to unreached.

Our mission is to create core competence in children with special needs residing in urban and rural areas through application of special education, advanced therapies, superior and barrier free infrastructural facilities, provide vocational training for creating better opportunities for employment and develop human resources, so that person with disability can cope up with the challenges of society they live in and lead a respectable life.

- Vocational training.

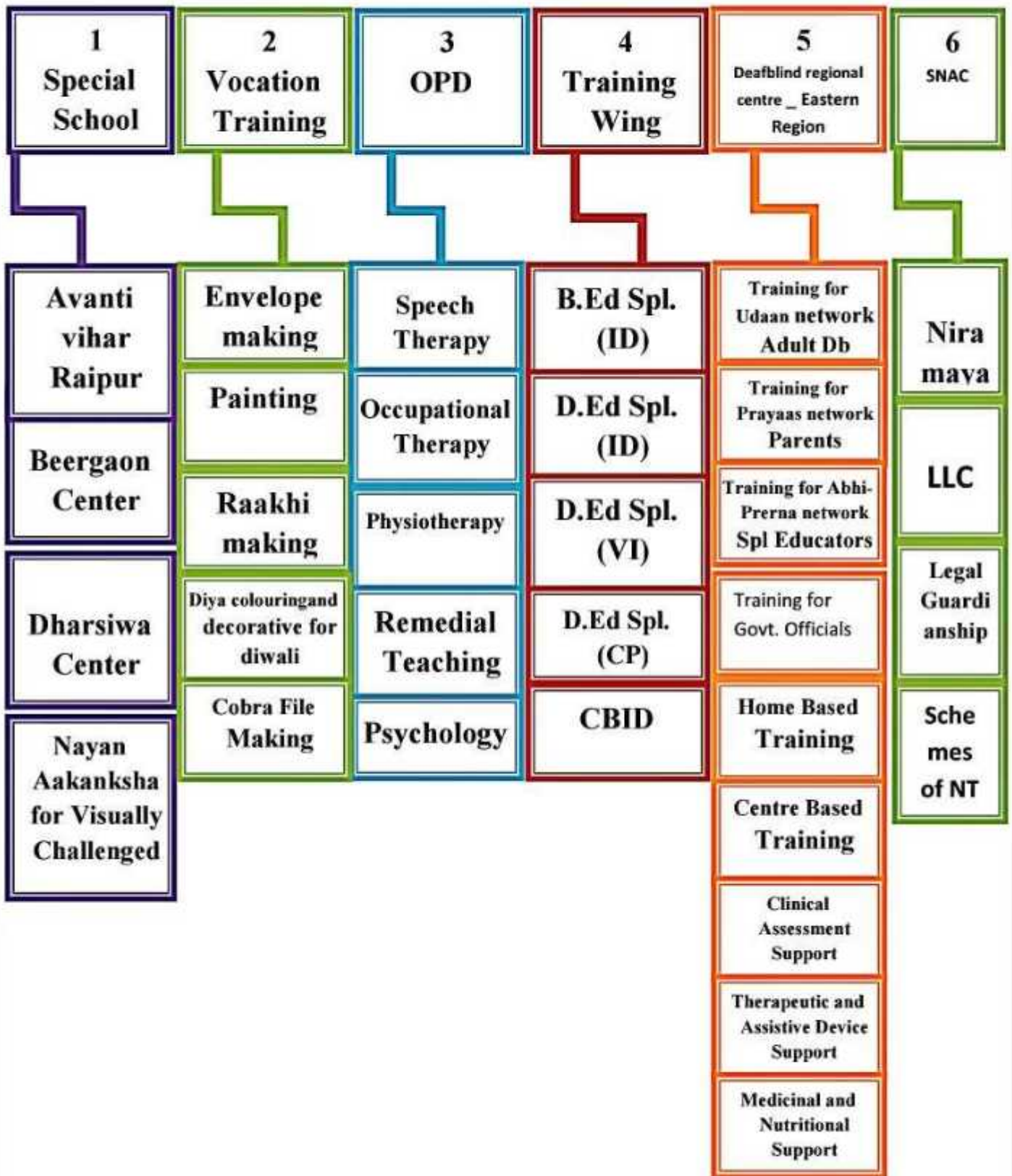
### SPECIAL SCHOOL /DAY CARE CENTRE

3. Psychological Services (I.Q. Assessment, Behavior Modification, Remedial Teaching for Slow Learners etc.)
4. Pre-Vocational and Vocational Training children are being trained in making Diya and Paper Bags in this section.

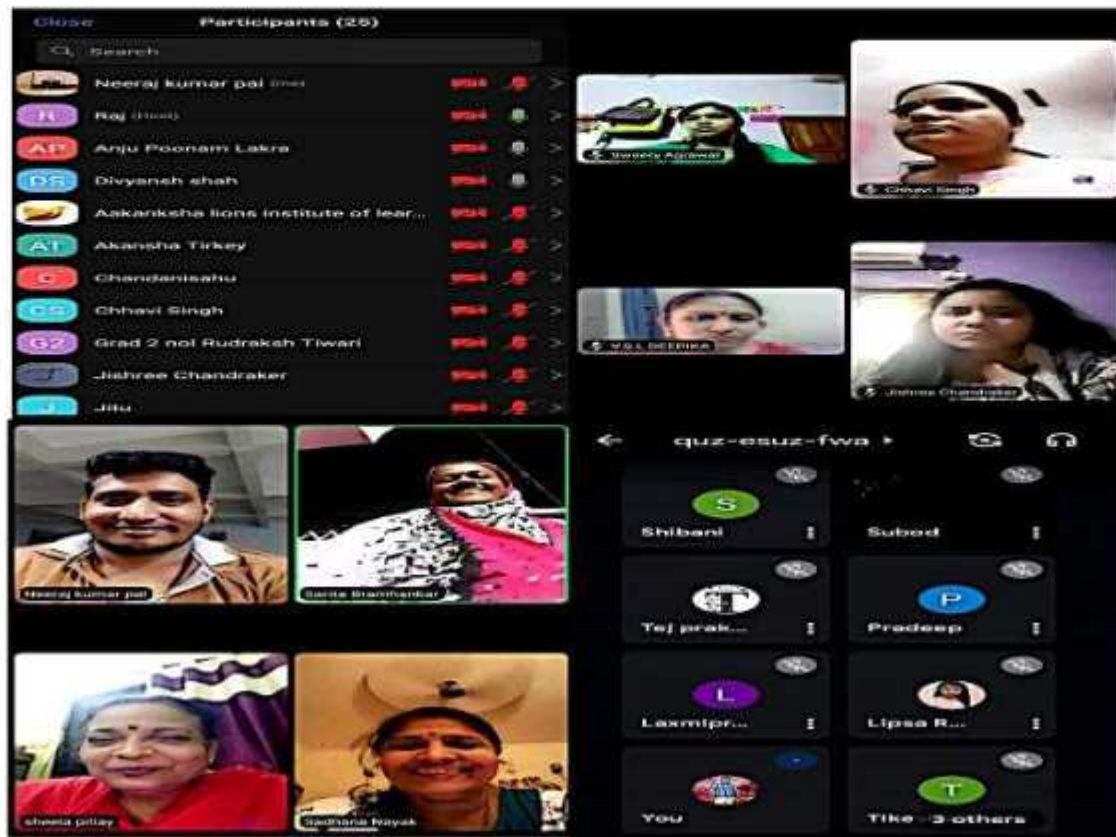
### INDUCTION PROGRAMME

## COMMUNITY BASED INCLUSIVE DEVELOPMENT (CBID)

The Certificate in Community Based Inclusive Development (CBID) is a 6-month, full-time, competency-based vocational education program developed through and for the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disability's (DEPWD) Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI), in collaboration with the University of Melbourne. It conforms to the requirements of a Level 4 (postsecondary, non-tertiary) qualification as stipulated by the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED) (UN, 2011).<sup>1</sup> The RCI accredits and offers the course. The course was started on 20th September 2021.

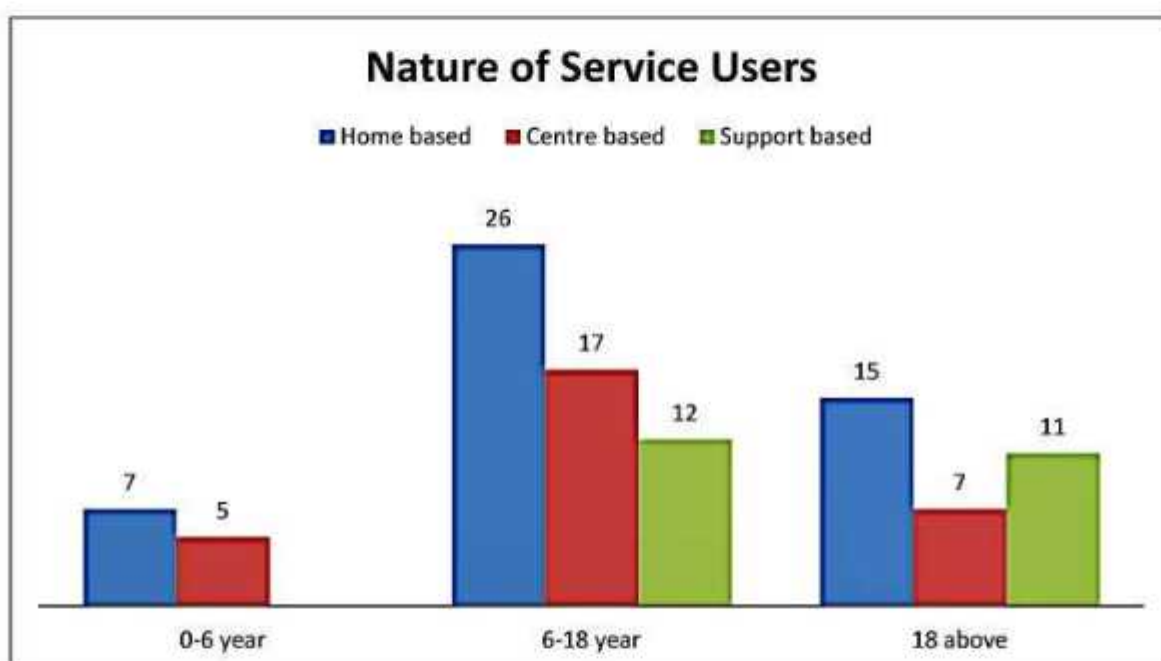
To develop teamwork and leadership, different types of activity work such as setting goals and planning to achieve them many such tasks are being done continuously by the trainees.

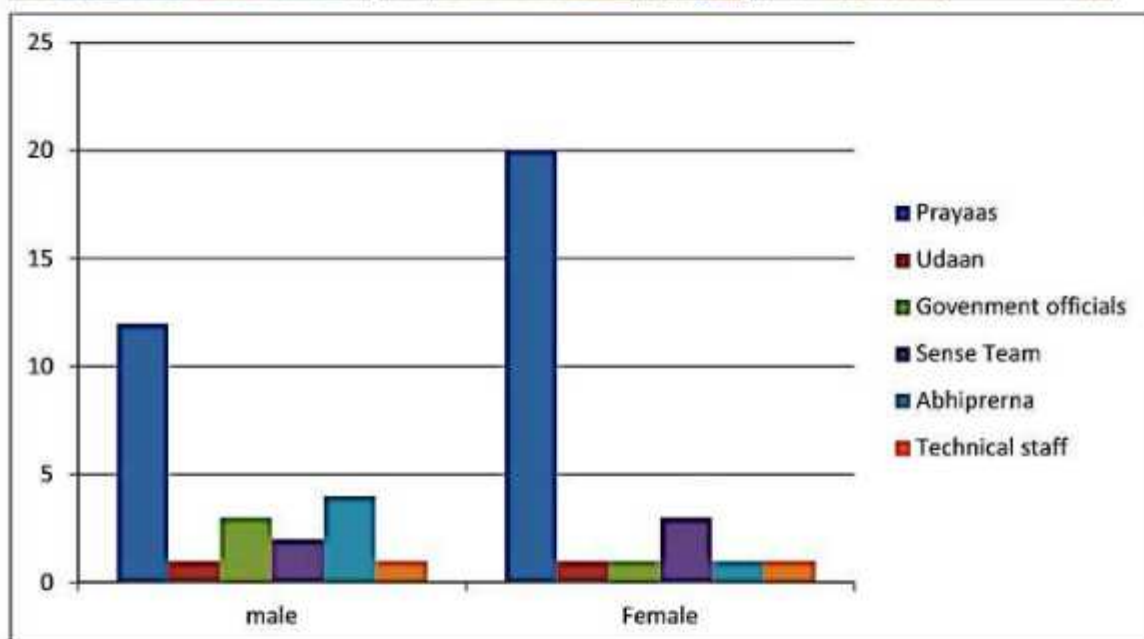

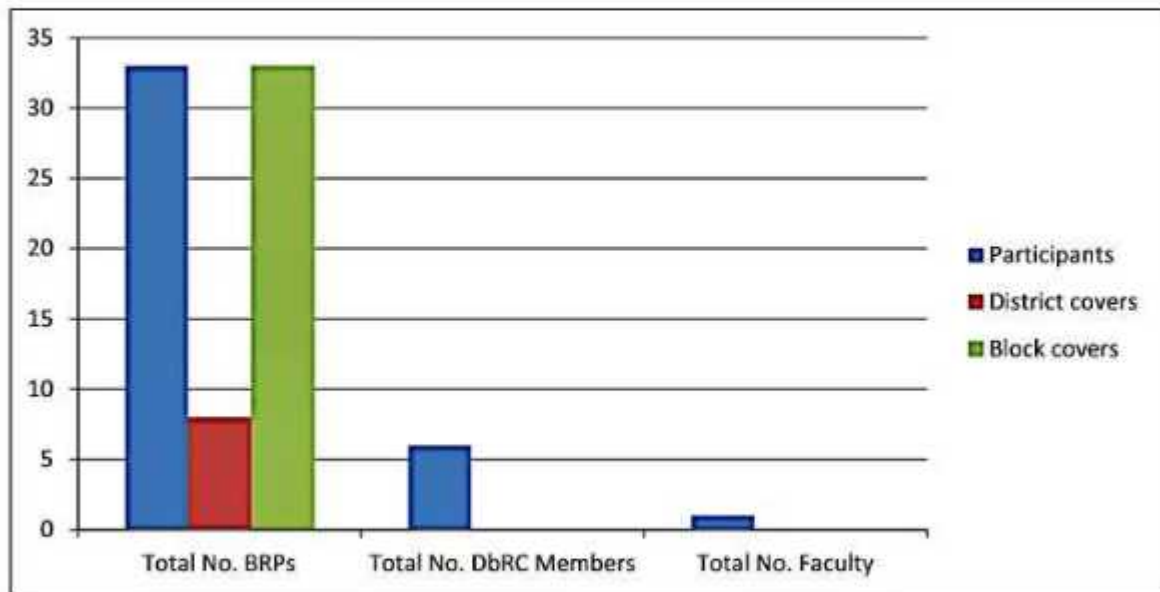

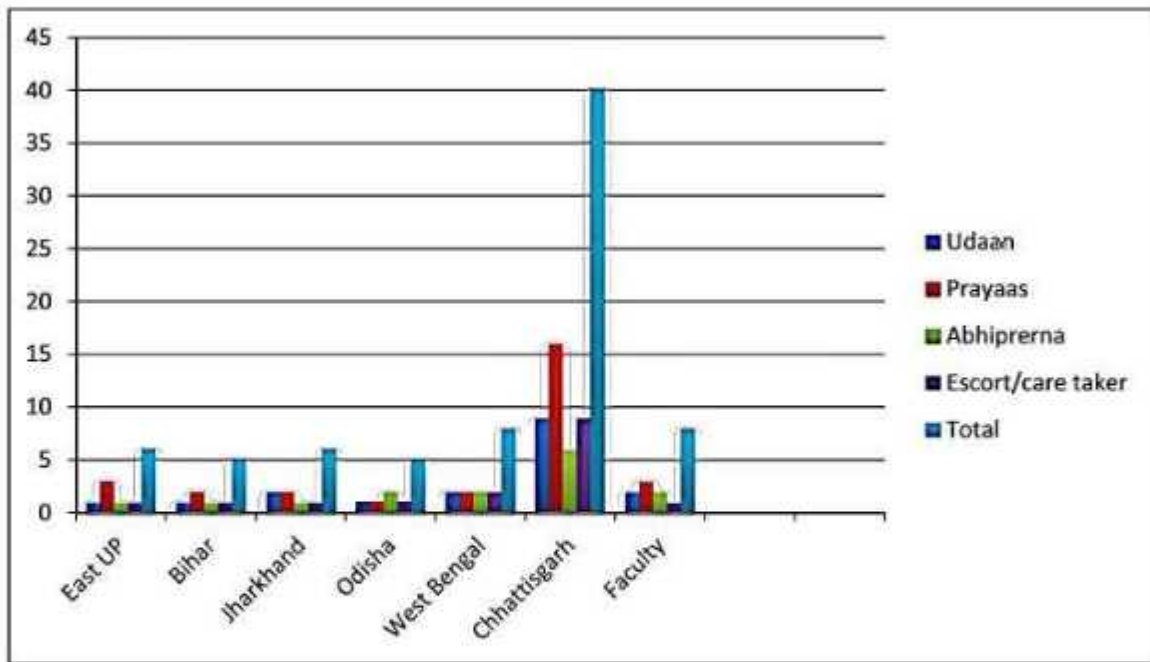




## Regional Level Networks Meet (Abhi-Prerna, Prayaas & Udaan)

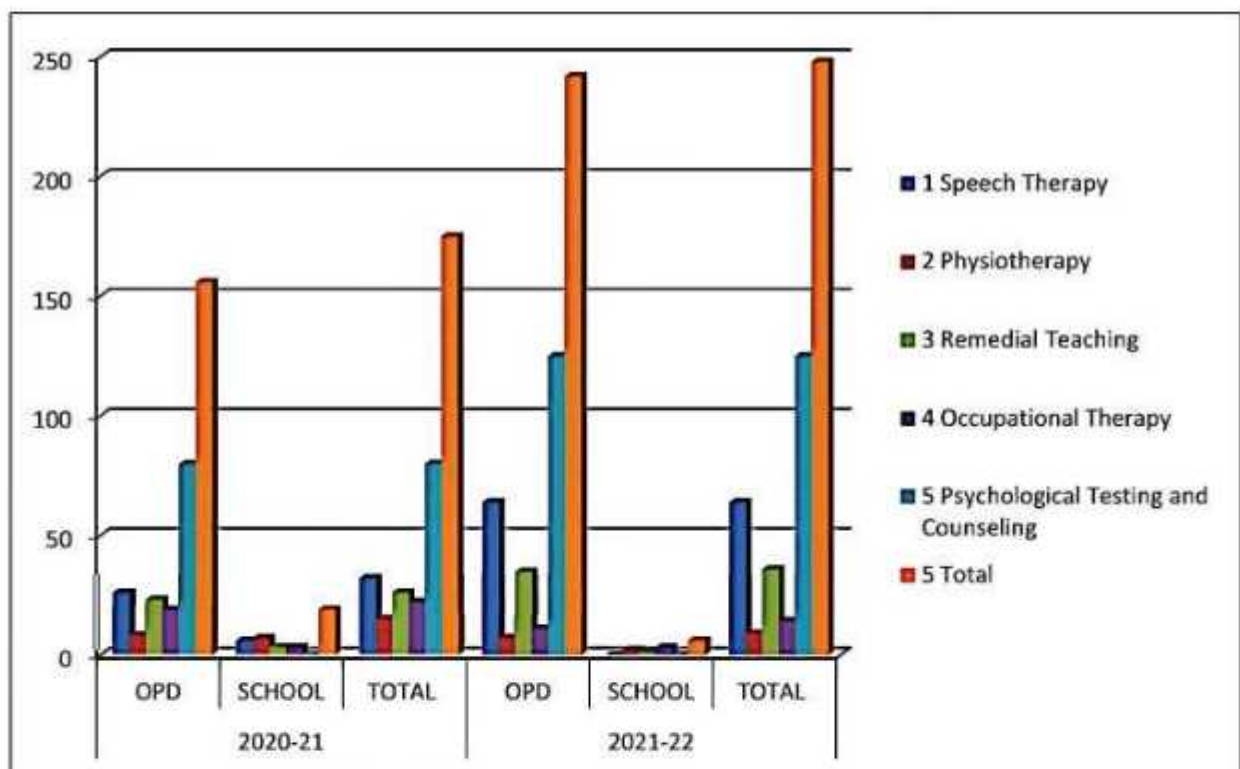
