

## ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2020- 2021

1. The annual report of Asha School is a reflection of initiatives, efforts and projects undertaken towards achieving aim and objective of ASHA SCHOOL HISAR CANTONMENT, covering the period from Apr 2020 to Mar 2021. Asha School was established in 1998 for training and rehabilitation of the special children. This institute undertakes the unique task of mitigating the mental/ physical handicaps faced by special children in their day to day life.


2. **Online Education.** Special children, most of them with multiple disabilities were registered during the period of this report. Keeping in mind, the outbreak of COVID-19, Asha School, Hisar Mill Stn is providing online special education to specially abled children through WhatsApp based on guidelines received from NIEPID (National Institute For Empowerment of Personnel's with Intellectual Disability) from school premises. The salient aspects of the online education system are listed in succeeding paras as under :-

(a) **Methodology.**

- (i) Zero cost online education commenced from 13 April 20.
- (ii) Management staff, teachers & parents connected through WhatsApp medium.
- (iii) Category & age specific training programe formulated for all students.
- (iv) Learning through videos & live chat.
- (v) Student teacher ratio - 3:1.

- (iii) Weekly feedback taken from parents and necessary amendments made to the training programme.

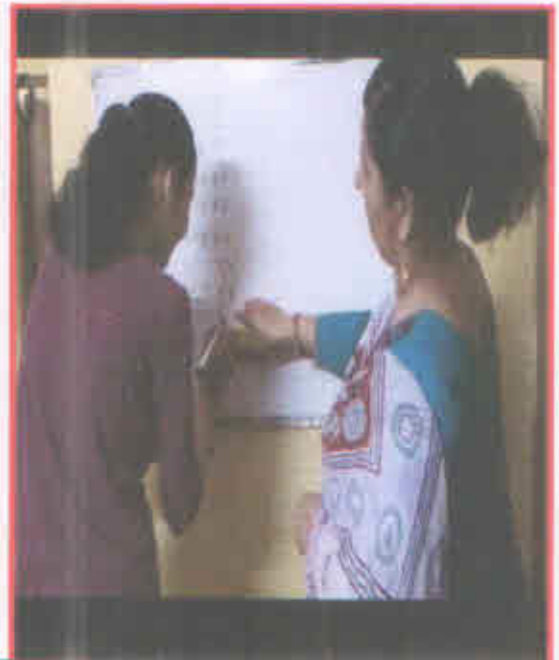


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(c) **Involvement of Parents.**

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4. **Online Speech Therapy.** As per feedback received from parents during online PTM, a session of online Speech Therapy was conducted from 18 May 20 under guidance of experts Dr Satyender Verma, Red Cross, Hisar and Mr Sachin Kumar, Speech Therapist from Vision Diagnostic Centre, Ujjain (M.P) alongwith Mrs Anju Pal, Spl Educator of School. The Speech Therapist was able to spend approx half an hour with each of the student.



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5. **Online Psychological Counseling.** Mrs Bindia Guatam, Psychologist conducted Psychological Counseling for students and their parents on weekly basis, so as to identify the special needs of each & every child to prepare a tailor made & focused special education program through involvement of parents & teachers.
