

INVITATION OF BIDS FOR INTERNAL AUDIT FOR 2016-17

The National Trust is an Autonomous Body set up in the year 1999, under an Act of Parliament by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India, for the welfare of the persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation & Multiple Disabilities. The purpose and objectives of setting up of the Trust are:

1. To enable and empower persons with disability to live as independently and as fully as possible within and as close to the community to which they belong;
2. To strengthen facilities to provide support to persons with disability to live within their own families;
3. To extend support to registered organizations to provide need based services during period of crisis in the family of persons with disability;
4. To deal with problems of persons with disability who do not have family support;
5. To promote measures for the care and protection of persons with disability in the event of death of their parent or guardian;
6. To evolve procedures for the appointment of guardians and trustees for persons with disability requiring such protection;
7. To facilitate the realization of equal opportunities, protection of rights and full participation of persons with disability; and
8. To do any other act which is incidental to the aforesaid objects.

In order to meet its objectives, the Trust has been provided with a Corpus Fund of Rs. 100 crore by the Govt. of India. Interest earned on investment of corpus fund is the only source of income for running 10 Schemes developed for the welfare of target persons with disabilities. These schemes are run through organizations registered with National Trust.

The National Trust invites sealed quotations from the eligible firms of practising Chartered Accountants to conduct the Internal Audit for the Financial Year 2016-17. Quotations must be supported by documentary proof for fulfilling the following eligible criteria

Eligible Criteria :

1. The firm must be empanelled with C.A.G. for Internal Audit of government accounts.
2. The firm should have the work experience of at least 5 years in conducting audit of any Government Department.
3. Firm should have sufficient number of auditors and should be capable to conduct the Internal audit at least once in each quarter.
4. The firm must have its office in Delhi to be contacted at any time for facilitation/consultation.

Terms & Conditions:

1. Quotations must reach this office in sealed cover within 15 days of the publication on website. The quotations shall be opened in National Trust by the procurement committee and the successful bidder shall be informed accordingly.
2. National Trust reserves the right to cancel or withhold the bids without assigning any reason.
3. National Trust also reserves the right to negotiate further with the selected bidder.
4. The contract will be for one year but can be extended for more years depending upon the performance of the firm.
