
In case of Intellectual Disability & Cerebral Palsy children there is a greater need of therapeutic service. As therapy service is highly expensive, it is purely impossible to avail therapeutic service to all the ID, CP, Autism & Multiple Disabilities Children as they are more deteriorate condition in our district. So we have applied to Social Security & Empowerment of Persons with disabilities (SSEPD) Department.

Under the sponsorship of SSEPD Department we are running Therapeutic Centre at Angul with taking 30 numbers of Intellectual Disability, Cerebral Palsy, Autism & Multiple Disabilities children with a non-residential setup. Where one Physiotherapist, One Speech Therapist, One Occupational Therapist, One Special Educator, One Care Taker and One Care Giver has been appointed by our organization for the service of inmates. This year we have completed 04 years successfully by providing therapeutic service to the poor Intellectual Disability, Autism, Multiple Disabilities & Cerebral Palsy children of our locality.


We have utilized the funds successfully by implementing the scheme "Rehabilitation of Physically and Mentally Challenged Socially Disadvantaged Persons".




- 1. By providing appropriate therapy to the Intellectual Disability & Cerebral Palsy Child

- 5. We have appointed one number of experienced care taker an one number of care giver for providing better care to the beneficiaries.









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












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## School for Mentally Retarded

To feel the current situation of Intellectual Disability in Angul District we have taken step for opening of Special School Intellectual Disability in the year 2018 at the district head quarter, Angul with taking 30 numbers ID students

The institution is running through collection of donation from donors and well wishers of Angul town as well as nearby rural areas. Now the institute consists of 05 numbers of staffs. Out of this 02 numbers of Special Teacher, One Warden, 01 number of Attendant and one Cook.

## **Special School for Cerebral Palsy**

Cerebral Palsy is a group of disorder that affects movement and muscle tone or posture. It caused for by damage that occurs to the immature brain as it develops most often before birth. So Cerebral Palsy children are facing much more problem in the community. Basically spastic cerebral palsy children is common and found everywhere, but in case of athetoid Cerebral Palsy it is more difficult to manage.

We are running Special School for cerebral palsy at the District Head Quarter, Angul since last three years with taking 30 numbers of inmates with non-residential setup. We are providing Special Education and ADL skill to the Cerebral Palsy children as they have lack of eye-hand coordination. Our organization have appointed experienced personnel for proper care of these students.


#### **Project Activities**
