Sumangal School for Intellectual Disable Children (SSIDC) Reg. No. 0942 (2004) No. of Students : 75

This special school includes activities such as playgroup education in pre-primary & primary classes. For severe & profoundly retarded children they have special class. In all these classes they improve cognitive, psycho-social, motor, communication, & activities of daily living skills. Co-curricular activities like yoga, music, physical education, dance, play, craft, drawing are also given due importance in their curriculum. Regular health check up camps creates awareness about all disabilities, good health, cleanliness, hygiene and consequences of bad habits. The children are provided adequate recreation with television, audio-visual aids like E-learning project and other educational equipments in the school. Students are also given pre -vocational & self-advocacy training from grass-root level before placing them in vocational training centre.

The evaluation capabilities of the students, age, and functionalities are classified as follows: -

- 1) Nursery class
- 2) Pre-primary class
- 3) Primary class
- 4) Pre-vocational class
- 5) Special class

Various school activities are as follows -

- 1) Functional Education
- 2) General Knowledge
- 3) Self help activity
- 4) Value Education
- 5) Educational Tour
- 6) Physical education, yoga, dance, drama, sports, music & craft etc.









Palavi Early Intervention Centre (PEIC) Reg., No. B 0063 (2018) No. of Student 22

To enhance capacity and quality of Early Intervention Care for Early Intervention Center in Pen. Adding much needed component of professionals, therapy equipment & community base rehabilitation.

Early intervention Centre are special services for infants and toddlers at risk of developmental delays. These services are designed to identify and meet children's needs in five developmental areas. These are physical, cognitive, communication, social or emotional development, sensory and adaptive development. Early intervention includes provision of services to such children and their families for the purpose of lessening the effects of the condition. Early intervention can be remedial or preventive in nature remediating the existing developmental problems or preventing their occurrence.

If provided with early intervention care in the pre-schooling stage many of these children can be integrated in inclusive education environment and remaining in special schools. Besides it enables the children with development delays and severe disability to become independent in their activities of daily living by maintaining communication with their care givers. Therefore Early Intervention & Care is a critical requirement for every developmentally delayed child.

In the entire Raigad district there is only on Early Intervention Centre (EIC) at Panvel. The need of EIC is very high in these rural & tribal areas & therefore the only Centre of Panvel cannot fulfill feeds of 0 to 6 years of babies & children who are at-risk to disabilities.

Beneficiaries: All the at risk babies between the age range of 0 to 6 years need special services of rural & tribal areas of Raigad district.



Eklavya Vocational Training Centre (EVTC) Registration No. A-930 (2012) No. of Students 75

The centre trains the intellectually disabled adults for their vocational rehabilitation. This was started in 2010-11. At present the strength of students in EVTC is 75. In the age of 18 & above after appropriate skilful pre-vocational training these adult students of Sumangal school promote to EVTC. This is a sheltered workshop for students where they learn various skills & trades as per their capabilities take orders & earn money & help their abilities. The institution gives stipend of Rs. 100/- every month to each adult of EVTC who is above 18 years.

For this group we also teach safety skills, leisure & recreational skills, emotional skills, work related & work behaviour skills, sex education as per their comprehension abilities alongwith parent's assistance.

For marketing the various products made by students EVTC also participate in exhibition-cumsales at various places mentioning few places like Mantralaya Consumer Society, Jondhle Engineering College, Dombivali, Nerul, Navi Mumbai, Malhar Festival, Panvel, Pen Festival, Pen etc. Activities like music, dance, picture reading, cricket, volley ball, storytelling etc., use as leisure & recreational activities for these adults.

Special Achievement of EVTC: Feeling very proud to tell you that this year we sold nearby 6000 rakhis made by our EVTC students at varius places like Mumbai, Pune, Thane, Alibag, Pen. We are very much thankful to all those buyers who showed faith in our students, not only they trusted our students, but they increased the confidence of our students, staff, parents.



Light House Special Teacher Training Centre (LHSTTC) Reg. No. 17-569D.Ed.Spl Ed(MR)RCI/ 7339 (2011) No. of Trainees 156

In Raigad district there was not a single Special Teacher Training Centre. Being rural & tribal area, there was no awareness regarding intellectual disability. To make people aware, to provide special services to these special children as per their special needs, to rehabilitate & to bring them in the mainstream of the society, special training centre was an important need & a serious requirement in these Rural & Tribal areas of Raigad. After 12th if anybody wants to do such courses, all the way they had to go to Mumbai for the same which was very costly & hectic, so people avoid to do such courses & also ignore this field, which was not proper. To know all these difficulties the institution started a Special teacher's training centre for D.Ed Special Education (Mental Retardation), which is recognized by Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi affiliated to 'Indira Gandhi National Open University'. It is the "First" special teacher's training centre in entire Raigad district, named as 'Light House' Special Teacher's Training Centre, where students from all over India can take admission. Since last three years RCI in collaboration with Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University (YCMOU), Nasik started a Distance B.Ed in Special Education (MR) & out of 5 centres in Maharashtra they selected our centre. This year we are having our 4th batch of 50 students. Students from all over Maharashtra & other states have connected due to this course. 3291A is a centre code of our institution for distance B.Ed. Special (MR) course.


