Annai Jothi Seva Trust is situated in the banks of the Papanasam river in the Adayakarungulam village.

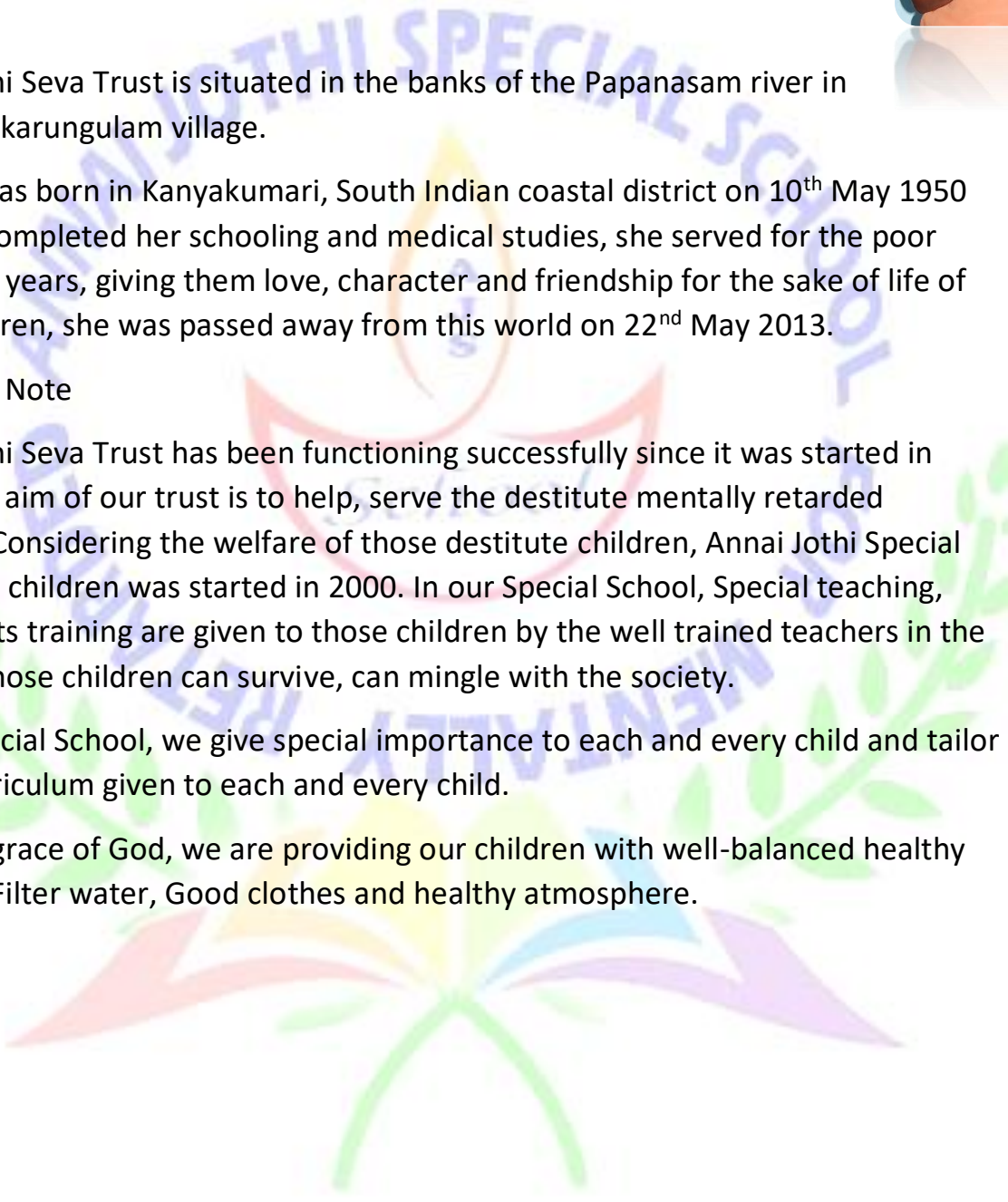

Director`s Note

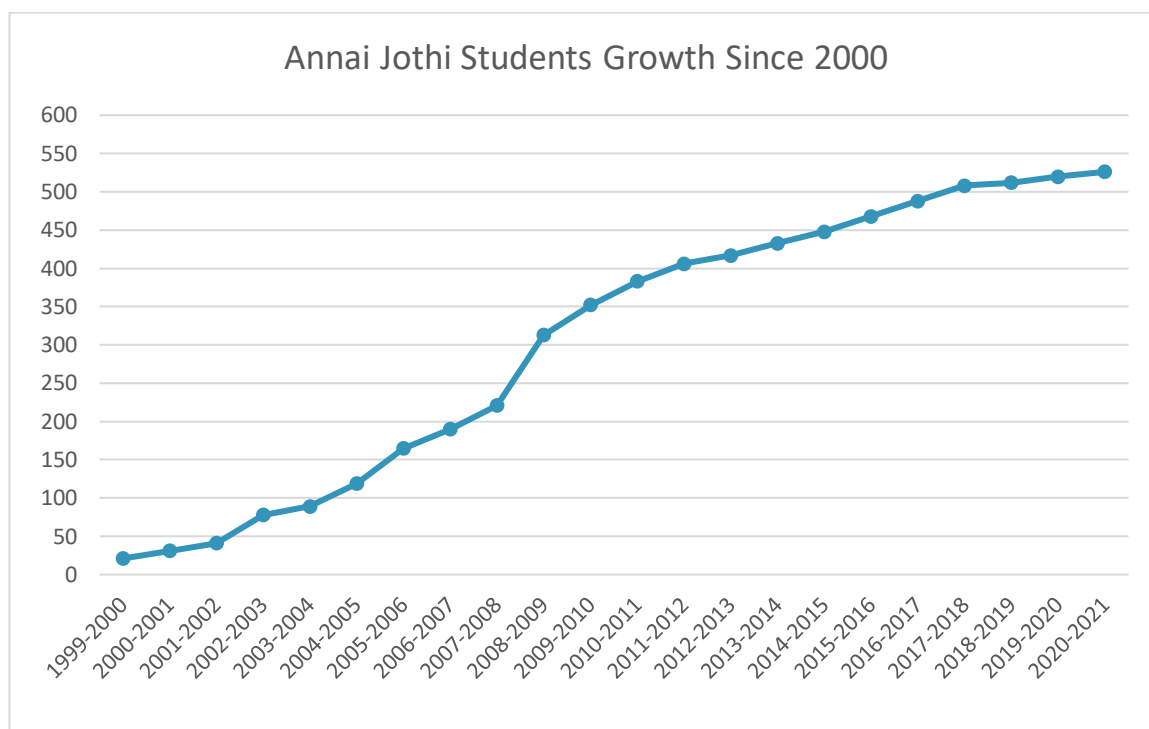

## Major Events

### 1. DDAWO`s visit and Appreciation

7<sup>th</sup> January 2021 - Inspection visit of Mrs. Shanthi Glory Emerald – DDAWO to our Institution and she was much happy about the students' performance and the progress. She appreciated much about the various craft works done by our special children.



## 2. Clothes for the needy

During the month of January 2021, around 235 poor families around our trust in Adayakarunkulam village were given Dhotis and Sarees by Ajay Sethupathiyar Trust. The event is being organized and coordinated by our trust.



## 3. Corona Relief Work

The essential provision items kit given by the Differently Abled Welfare Department was being distributed to the 91 beneficiaries as Phase 1, on 20<sup>th</sup> August 2021 in our trust.

Phase 2 of the distribution was being done on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2021 in St. Andrews Matric School for 204 beneficiaries.

Phase 3 of the Differently abled who could not reach our trust were visited in their own location and 73 persons were benefited.

In total 368 persons were benefited by the end of 20<sup>th</sup> October 2021. This special responsibility assigned by the District Differently Abled Welfare office of Tirunelveli District in executing these Corona Relief measures, were completed up to the satisfaction of the authorities.



## 4. Distribution of Supportive Equipment to the Differently Abled under ALIMCO ADIP scheme.

On 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2020 ADL Kit for one person given in our Trust.

On the same day (22<sup>nd</sup> Oct 2020) Smart Cane for two persons were given.

44 beneficiaries were benefited by the supportive equipment given from Ambai Taluk DDARO. These programmers were organized by our Annai Jothi Seva Trust.





## 5. UDID Smart card work

Our trust supported the UDID Smart card work assigned by the DDAWO office in contacting the differently abled person and verification and uploading of their Identity details.

Through this campaign around 500 differently abled persons were benefited.



## 6. Ddawo Meeting

On 8<sup>th</sup> January 2021, the Special Teachers meet was conducted in Anis Special School and our institution Special Teacher Mrs. Santhana Lakshmi attended the meeting on our trust behalf.



## 7. National Voters Day Campaign

On the occasion of the National Voters Day on 25<sup>th</sup> January 2021, we attended the Campaign headed by the District Collector Mr. Vishnu and organized the participation of Ambai Taluk Differently Abled person who have the voting eligibility.



## 8 Training supports extended to the Students of Social Work Department

In our institute, we admit the students of St. Xavier's college of Social Works Department and gave them training and education on the functioning of Special schools and handling the Intellectual children. There were 3 students participated in the one-month training.



## 9. Excursion

On 12<sup>th</sup> February 2021, we spent the day in outing with our Special children. Our Intellectual Children and teachers enjoyed the nature around Manimuthar Dam Area.

It was really a learning experience for our children to understand the society and the social behaviors.



## 10. Cent percent Voting Campaign

On 25<sup>th</sup> March 2021, the awareness rally focusing on 100% voting was done in Ambai area as per the DDAWO's instruction and all the Differently abled persons of our area were communicated and rally were conducted in creating awareness among the public on the importance of exercising the authority of voting.

Vocational training is given to our Intellectual Children's well. They are trained in making basket, mat, artificial flowers vase, toys, tailoring, charcoal made attractive things.

Our Intellectual Children's can make types of baskets like sivankan basket, biscuit basket etc... Our Intellectual Children's are trained in making plastic wire flowers



vases. Our Intellectual Children's are trained in making flowers, using organic cloth, shocker cloth, Reeth, Hand bouquets etc., Reeth,

### Mat :

Our Intellectual Children's are specially trained in making mats. By this practice, They get hand-co ordination

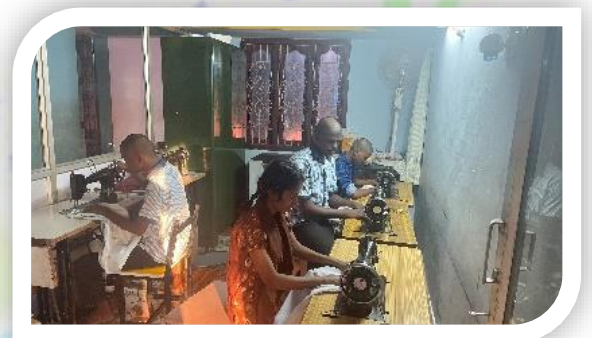


### Painting & Printing

## HOME ACTIVITIES

Our Seva Trust was started in order to improve welfare, to rehabilitate the Intellectual Children's. In our school, Nutritious food as breakfast, as lunch and healthy tiffin in the evening (cereals, fruits, tubers) are granted to the children. Monthly one, All the children are medically checked up. Proper care is taken on their health and diet.
