

Aims and Objectives:

Autism Educational Welfare Society has been conceived.

- 1.** To impart special education, pre vocational training and job placement to the mentally challenged persons.
- 2.** To start an OPD services to persons with disabilities.
- 3.** Prevention of Disability.
- 4.** Job placement in a sheltered and protected environment for the persons having different categories of mental retardation.
- 5.** Self production unit
- 6.** Provide financial assistance for organizing sports and other creative activities for the mentally disabled children.
- 7.** To create awareness among the persons and their families.
- 8.** To provide legal and financial assistance to the persons with disability who do not have family support including orphaned distributed.
- 9.** Tie up with business and supporting houses for on job training, placement and participation in the development programmers for these disabled children.
