ABOUT CHOTAY TARAY FOUNDATION

The Chotay Taray Foundation was established in the year 2000 by a group of like-minded individuals who shared a deep desire to assist people with Multiple Disabilities. At that time, there was no organization in Kashmir dedicated to aiding such individuals. The foundation was formed with the vision of nurturing and developing these individuals from all aspects and witnessing the fruition of their potential. Over the years, the foundation has made significant achievements, allowing its founders to take pride in their noble mission. Prior to its existence, families of disabled individuals often felt hopeless and burdened. However, with the establishment of Chotay Taray Foundation, their attitudes have transformed, and they now find a ray of hope in the organization's efforts.

Presently, the Chotay Taray Foundation is managed by a group of eminent and professional personalities, including its President and other members of the managing body. This body consists of doctors, social activists, and other experts who share a common dream of enabling these deprived children to exceed their own limitations and reach new horizons. Initially, the foundation began as a special school for disabled individuals and continued as such until November 2006. It then obtained Registration under Societies Registration Act 1980 as a non-governmental organization (Regd. No. 5007-S of 2006), with the aim of working comprehensively for the development and welfare of the disabled. The organization recently received the new registration number **7778 -s of 2023** under Societies Registration Act 1980. The foundation's key areas of work encompass **Disability, Mental Health, Child Development, Childcare and Protection, Livelihood, Skill Development, and Emergency Crisis & Relief**. In the past, the foundation has collaborated with esteemed organizations such as CRY, United Nations Children's Emergency Fund, various corporate institutions, and the Government. Through its dedicated management and strategic focus on key areas, the foundation has consistently worked towards comprehensive development and welfare of people. By partnering with renowned organizations and actively collaborating with the government, the foundation has been able to extend its impact and fulfill its noble mission. The Chotay Taray Foundation stands as a testament to the power of compassion, commitment, and determination in creating a better world.

PROJECTS IMPLEMENTED AND ACHIEVEMENTS

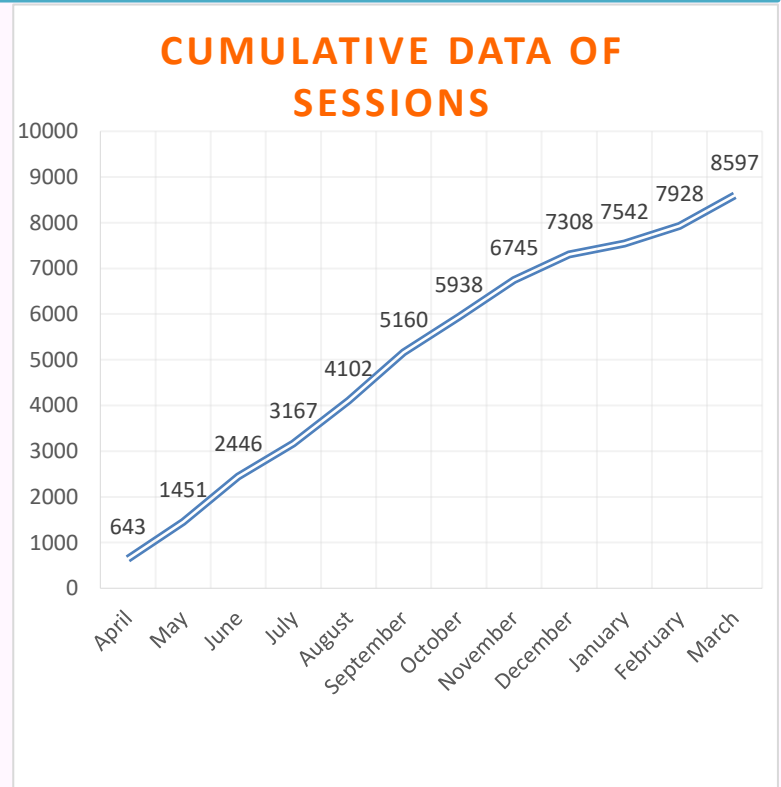
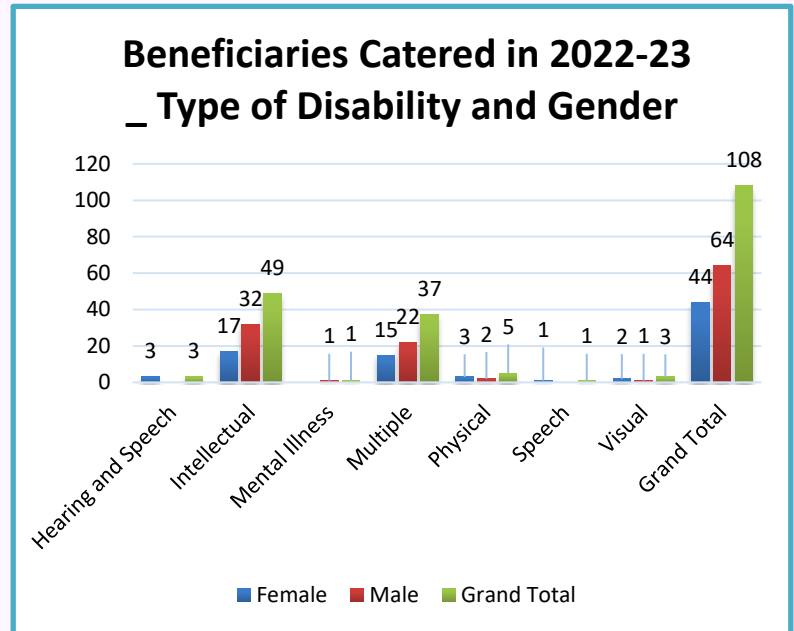
1) Rehabilitation of Children with Disabilities

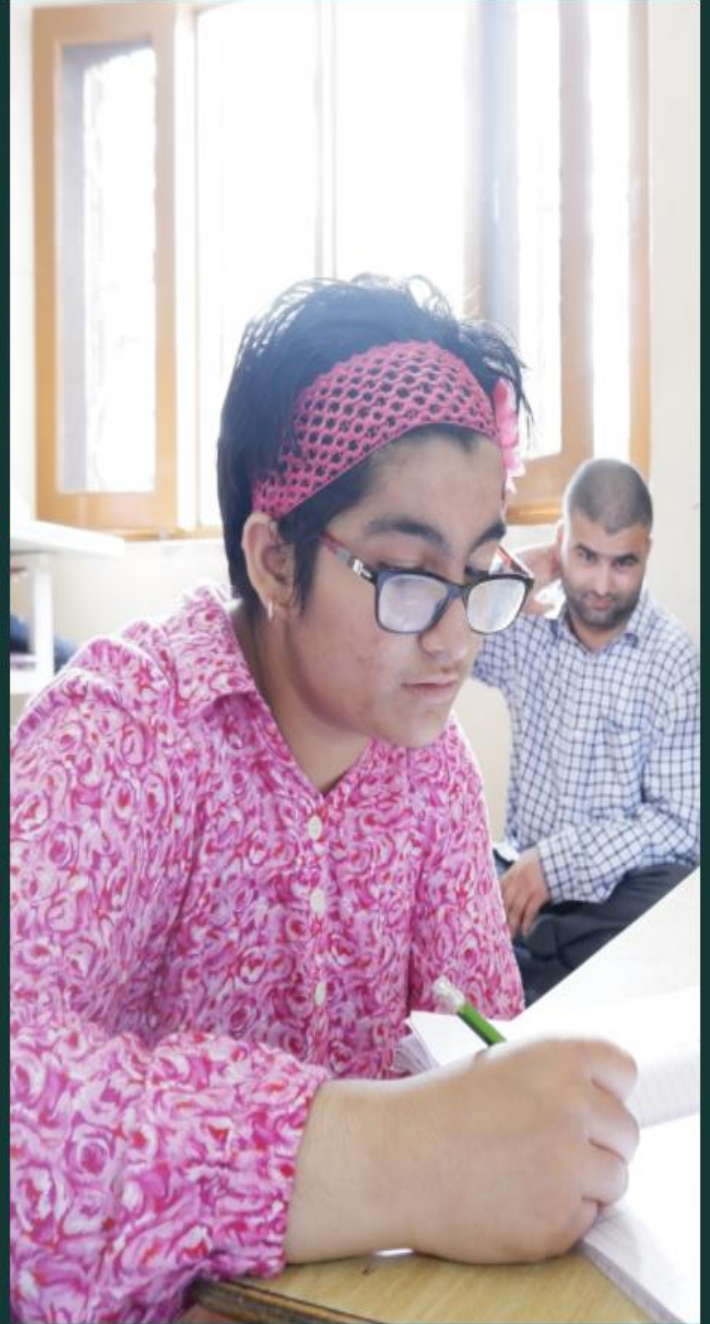
With over 23 years of expertise, we continued our mission to provide comprehensive rehabilitation services to children with disabilities. Our highly experienced and qualified staff demonstrated exceptional proficiency in delivering rehabilitation services, including special education, to enhance the independence and well-being of these children

During this reporting period, we provided rehabilitation services to **108** children with disabilities, with the primary objective of optimizing their independence in all areas of life. Our team of therapists conducted thorough assessments using standardized formats to evaluate each child's needs. Based on these assessments, individualized rehabilitation plans were developed and implemented accordingly.

Range of rehabilitation services we offered encompassed physiotherapy, vocational training, speech therapy, special education, and counseling. Our dedicated rehabilitation staff successfully delivered **8,597** sessions tailored to meet the unique requirements of each beneficiary.

We are proud to highlight that as a result of our interventions, two children with disabilities were successfully rehabilitated and enrolled in mainstream schools for regular education. This achievement exemplifies the positive impact of our efforts in creating an inclusive and supportive educational environment.






EMPOWERING DISABILITIES

2) Mental Health Services and Awareness

A staggering 792 million people worldwide, equivalent to 10.7% of the global population, grapple with mental health disorders. Among students, a troubling one in seven experience such challenges, contributing to a remarkable 13% of the disease burden within this age group. Shockingly, suicide rates remain alarmingly high, with young individuals disproportionately affected. Nowhere is this crisis more apparent than in **Kashmir, where a dire 45%** of the population suffers from mental distress. Adolescents, in particular, battle soaring anxiety levels, hampered by a lack of awareness, pervasive stigma, and barriers hindering their ability to seek help. Responding to this pressing need, the visionary collaboration between CTF and the Directorate of School Education Kashmir initiated a series of impactful mental health awareness sessions. Targeting adolescent students in the districts of Budgam, Ganderbal, Pulwama, and Srinagar, **a total of 2185 students (Male 741 and Female 1444) and 112 school staff (Male 46 and Female 66) participated in the awareness session.** The sessions aimed to promote and support the mental well-being of our young learners, shed light on the diverse manifestations of mental health issues, and provide invaluable strategies for cultivating and nurturing positive mental health and overall well-being. Moreover, these transformative sessions strive to instill a vital help-seeking behavior among students, empowering them to build resilience against life's challenges.

Further, in our efforts to address mental health concerns, our dedicated staff has extended counselling services to **62** number of individuals facing various mental health issues. The core aim of these services was to enhance their mental well-being and promote overall emotional and psychological wellness.

3) Children in Need of Care and Protection

Chotay Taray Foundation runs a child care institution, the institutional has diligently provided comprehensive care, secure shelter, nourishment and health services to a total of 59 children hailing from different states. Under this domain the CCI works in closing liaising with the police department, judiciary, child protection and social welfare department. All the children coming to our CCI are safely handed over to families either by accompanying them to their homes or making arrangements for their family travel, thanks to our staff for their hard work and commitment.

This year alone, 11 children have been beneficiaries of our exceptional services. We take immense pride in stating that all cases entrusted to our organization are referred by the esteemed Child Welfare Committee, a testament to our recognized quality of care. As an expert and trusted institution, we strive to create a safe haven for children in need of care and protection. Our dedicated efforts remain steadfast in ensuring the well-being and holistic development of every child entrusted to our care.

4) Child Development Programme:

All children have the right to education, safe, healthy, and happy childhood. No child should be denied these basic rights because of their family's socioeconomic status. When children grow up in poverty, they are more likely to experience health problems, drop out of school, and become involved in child labor and many other abuses. Supporting these children can help break the cycle of poverty and create a more prosperous society for all. Chotay Taray Foundation with the support and funding of Child Nurture Relief, USA empowers such children with education, provides them healthcare and nutrition to build a more inclusive, prosperous, and peaceful society. This year we supported 937 children under this programme.

Upscaling of Child Development Programme:

To reach more children, this year we organized several surveys and hundreds of households were interviewed across all the interventional districts. After a thorough assessment and due-diligence process, 580 children from underprivileged families were enrolled in the program.



5) Skill Development

The region of Kashmir has been grappling with high unemployment rates, posing a pressing socio-economic challenge. Equipping young individuals with the necessary skills is paramount to enhance their employability, create sustainable livelihood opportunities, and mitigate the adverse effects of unemployment

Chotay Taray Foundation with the kind support of Child Nurture and Relief, USA, has been diligently working to address the skill development needs of Kashmir's youth. Through our skill development program, we have established E Labs and Skill Development Centers to provide comprehensive training and support. These initiatives aim to empower the youth with the necessary skills to excel in their chosen fields and create a positive impact on the region's economy.



E-Labs:

This year we relaunched the highly anticipated E-Labs project at the prestigious Government Higher Secondary School in Amira Kadal. This incredible initiative kick started with an enthusiastic batch of 35 bright students, with 30 of them actively participating in the captivating world of marketing.

The E-Lab premises were abuzz with creativity and entrepreneurial spirit, as we installed a remarkable total of 7 vibrant stalls. These stalls showcased an impressive array of street food, mesmerizing cosmetics, trendy women's accessories, exquisite handmade perfumes, fashionable clothing, refreshing shakes, and stylish footwear, just to name a few!

The delighted buyers at our E-Lab stalls included not only the enthusiastic school students but also the esteemed teachers and members of our staff members.

Moreover, we are thrilled to announce that a remarkable group of 18 talented trainees have successfully graduated from our comprehensive course. This course featured multiple sessions focused on 21st-century skills, including vital life skills and the renowned "4 Cs". Moreover, our trainees also delved into the realms of risk-taking and astute business planning, equipping them with the tools they need to thrive in today's dynamic world.

Youth Graduate from Skill Development Centres:

In the year 2022-23, we proudly empowered a remarkable group of 270 ambitious and talented youth, both men and women, through our state-of-the-art skill development centers. We offered them comprehensive training in a diverse range of sought-after skills, including cutting and tailoring, knitting and crochet, crewel embroidery, tilla embroidery, digital learning, electrical courses, and computer skills.

Our intensive programs not only equipped these aspiring individuals with valuable expertise but also instilled in them the confidence and determination to become economically independent. To kick-start their entrepreneurial journey, we went the extra mile by providing selected trainee with the necessary equipment to establish their own thriving business units.

Self Help Group:

An impactful Self Help Group (SHG) was formed of the women who have previously graduated from our skill centers. Already, the trained group has begun receiving numerous orders, showcasing their dedication and fostering steady growth. Understanding the importance of financial literacy and management, we took an extra step by providing a comprehensive orientation on maintaining and managing financial accounts. This invaluable knowledge equips the group with the tools necessary to navigate the intricacies of financial matters successfully. In a remarkable show of unity and collective progress, the group has come together to create a joint account, allowing them to save their hard-earned earnings. By supporting initiatives like the SHG, we have the privilege of uplifting communities, fostering self-reliance, and empowering individuals to break the cycle of poverty.

6) Sports

Chotay Taray Foundation a firm believer in the transformative power of sports, with the support of child Nurture and Relief (USA) and in collaboration with different Higher Secondary School, we organized a series of thrilling volleyball tournaments that left the crowd in awe. Through this exceptional initiative, Chotay Taray Foundation succeeded in bringing about positive social change, inspiring individuals to

push their limits and excel both on and off the court, also fostered a sense of unity and cooperation. The tournaments attracted a vibrant audience that included locals, community leaders, school principals, and teachers. To honour the remarkable efforts of players, trophies were awarded to the victorious team and exceptional performers, recognizing their exceptional talent and commitment.

7) Livelihood: Commitment to uplifting

Chotay Taray Foundation in partnership with Child Nurture extended meaningful livelihood support to several deserving individuals in different regions, Shafiq, a single mother from Batamaloo, was provided with dress material for ladies to sell door-to-door, enabling her to earn a modest income and support her daughters. Similarly, Heena, residing in a tin shed was equipped with a sewing machine and an interlock machine. As a skilled tailor, this support from CTF allowed her to break free from working under a local tailor on a commission basis and enabled her to generate a sustainable income.

Nisar Ahmed, struggling to make ends meet, received livelihood support in the form of an auto-rickshaw, this assistance from CTF has maximized his monthly savings, providing a more stable future for his family. Additionally, Ghulam Rasool Kral, hailing from Srinagar, was granted livelihood support to start a roadside vending business. With a handcart selling winter garments, he transitioned from daily labor to a more sustainable source of income for his family.

These stories illustrate Chotay Tarays Foundation's dedication to transforming lives by providing practical assistance and opportunities to those in need. Through their comprehensive programs and initiatives, CTF empowers individuals to overcome adversities, build sustainable livelihoods, and pave the way for a brighter future.

8) Quality Education:

Chotay Taray Foundation is dedicated to revolutionizing the educational landscape and empowering children minds through its comprehensive quality education programme. Our mission is to bridge educational gaps and elevate the standard of education delivered to children. Our remedial education approach caters to the individual needs of students, ensuring that every child gets the support they require to excel academically. We invest in their professional development through comprehensive training sessions, equipping them with cutting-edge teaching techniques and strategies. This year Chotay Taray Foundation operated in 25 schools and 45 community learning centers across interventional districts, benefiting a total of 1575 students.

9) Medical Camps:

Further, this year we organized several medical camps with the support of Child Nurture and Relief USA and in collaboration with department of health to address healthcare needs of children, promote community well-being, and extend healthcare services to marginalized populations. The camps were organized in Srinagar, Budgam, and Kupwara districts. The department of health ensured availability of physicians, dentists, ophthalmologists, pediatricians, gynecologists, counsellors, pharmacist, clinical psychologists, and various health workers to cater variety of needs. Around **400** people were benefited from the camps and even free medicines were also provided.

10) Distributions of Essential Items and Education Material.

Chotay Taray Foundation with the support of Child Nurture and Relief (USA) provided wide range of aid to 400 families of children registered under child development programme. The families are living in poverty and are facing immense challenges, including livelihood, nutrition, and lack of access to many basic services necessary for survival. Several distribution events were organized especially during Ramadan, EID and winter. The families were provided food items, clothing, blankets, local heating products, personal hygiene items, and other essential items.

11) Workshops and Trainings

Holistic Education: Several trainings were organized in the reporting year to build capacity of our staff, teachers and fellows. The training focused on capacity building, self-awareness, foundational literacy, creating a holistic school development plan, effective lesson planning, classroom management, socioemotional learning, leadership development and 21st century skills.

MENTAL HEALTH TRAINING PROGRAM: 02 Staff members of CTF

successfully participated in the training programme. The intervention given were modified to deliver activity-based therapy sessions to the beneficiaries. These sessions have impacted the beneficiaries. Along with the beneficiaries, support group of the parents have been created and they were involved in this journey of the rehabilitation.

TRAINING ON Disaster Risk Reductions: Staff members of CTF participated in the 03 days training programme on DRR organized by IMPA. All staff were later familiarized with the concepts of DRR.

EARLY CHILDHOOD STIMULATION: Staff of CTF participated in the training on the activities of daily living and socialization of the children in order to coup their behavioural issues.

12) Events
