As the area is very much backward and interior, the people of the area are very ignorant and illiterate. The economic condition of the population of this area is very gloomy because maximum population is seasonal agricultural labours who are landless and some of them are marginal landholders. As there are no industry or factory or any scope of employment hence maximum population are depend on only daily and casual labour. Since 2010 the informal groups started activities towards the above population on Education, Medical, Vocational, Awareness Generation, Community Welfare and Development, Relief and Rehabilitations with care and identification/ protection of all categories of disabled population such as Orthopedically/ Locomotors, Intellectual Disability (Mentally Retardation, Cerebral Palsy, , Autism, Multiple Disabled), Visually Impaired, Hearing Impaired & Speech and Leprosy cured disabled and finally registered under Societies Registration Act, 1961 in the year 2012 -2013 as “**JOYGRAM SOCIAL WELFARE SOCIETY**”.
