## Annual Report/Activities performed related to National Trust Disabilities in 2017-18

Society namely Universal Disabled Care Taker Social Welfare Society, Prabh Aasra (Home for helpless), village Padiala, Kurali, Tehsil Kharar, Mohali has come into existence with effect from 13<sup>th</sup> February 2004. Society is registered under Societies Registration Act 1957, Under Section 12AA of the Income Tax Act 1961, Under Sub Section 3 of Section 34 of Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children Act 2000). Society is also registered under P.W.D. Act 1995. The donations given to the Society are exempt under section 80G of the Income Tax Act 1961.

Organization is looking after and making efforts for rehabilitation of abandoned and unclaimed mentally retarded persons, persons with multiple disabilities, autism, cerebral palsy, orphans, old aged, ailing, needy persons, widows and missing destitute. These persons are referred for admission to Society by different Govt. Agencies such as D.C., SDM, Distt. Child Protection Officer Distt. Social Security Officer, Municipal Councilors, Hospital Authorities and Police Authorities etc. Our top most priority remains at to give good medical treatment and opportunities for quick rehabilitation of inhabitants housed in Society. We have service oriented philanthropic mission to provide service to those persons who are unable to take care of themselves because of their disabilities.

During the year under report following persons suffering from mental retardation, multiple disabilities, autism and cerebral palsy were residing in Society. All the activities carried out in Society are for rehabilitation of these inmates. Thus they all are beneficiaries as far as National Trust Disability is concerned. However activity wise number of beneficiaries have also been mentioned in foregoing paragraphs.

Every day activities of inmates start as under:

- a. Morning bath, changing of clothes etc.
- b. Morning tea
- c. Brushing of teeth and dressing of hair
- d. Morning prayers
- e. Break fast
- f. Daily Exercise
- g. Giving of daily routine medicines prescribed by doctors
- h. Daily shifting seriously ill inmates to hospitals for routine check up and follow check up

- i. Daily medical checkup by visiting doctors and nursing staff
- j. Physiotherapy given to inhabitants suffering from Cerebral Palsy and body deformation
- k. Attending classes for special education and vocational training
- I. Evening games for special children and evening walk for others who can not take part in games

A detailed report of these activities is mentioned as follows

The Society made efforts for the rehabilitation of Mentally retarded inhabitants, Inhabitants with multiple disabilities, cerebral palsy and autism. They were engaged in education, vocational training and extra curricular activities. With the improvement of their health they were made to take part in different competitions held at State level and National Level. Our efforts and their improvement gave the following results.

## Medical Treatment

The inmates were taken to hospitals in the ambulances of Society for routine check ups, follow check ups, Laboratory tests, X-ray and Ultrasound etc. The treatment given was strictly followed to improve their health. The Society has purchased a dispensary adjacent to Jhanjheri branch known as Prabh Aasra Sewa Medical Centre. Free medical services were provided to poor people including persons suffering from mental retardation, multiple disabilities, autism and cerebral palsy. Pathology tests were also carried out at subsidized rates.

Physiotherapy department has been set up in the Padiala Ashram. Physiotherapist appointed by Society and also a team of doctors from Fortis Hospital, Mohali visited the Society to give physiotherapy to the inmates suffering from **multiple disabilities/ Cerebral Palsy**.

A Clinical Psychologist appointed attended for regular counseling to mentally retarded and mentally ill patients.

## **Education**

Some children suffering from mental retardation have been admitted to Balaji Special School at Ludhiana. Two deaf and dumb students have been admitted to Red Cross School, Farindkot. All the expenses on account of their education were incurred by Society. For other mentally retarded students, students with multiple disabilities, Autism and cerebral palsy living in Society Special teachers have also been engaged to give training and make them toilet trained and self dependant.
