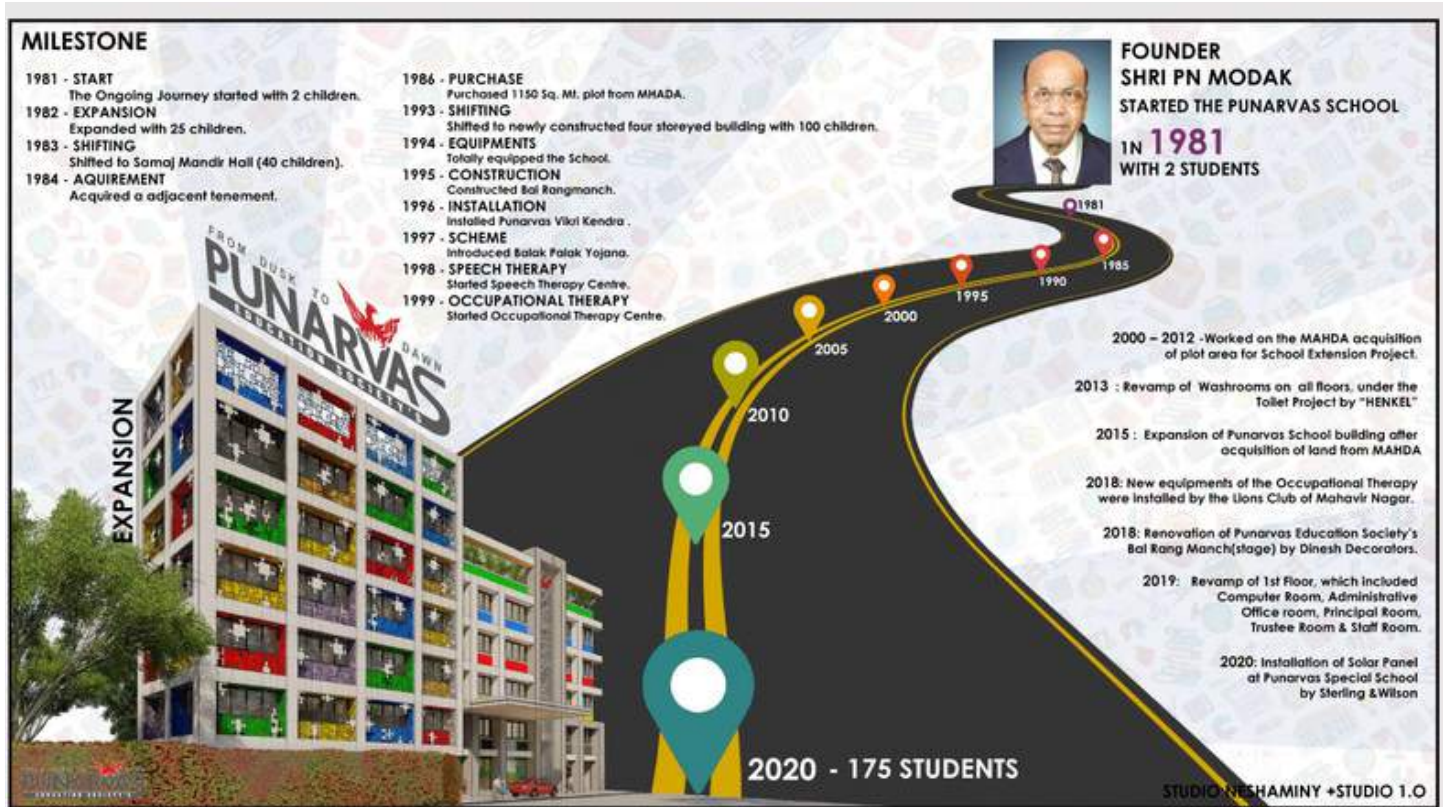

Our journey started with two Intellectually Disabled children & at present we educate 175 special needs children with a view of reaching out to 500 Intellectually Disabled children after the building expansion. We are extremely overjoyed to inform you that our School has completed 39 years on 17th July, 2020 since its Foundation in 1981.

To brief you about our school activities, we provide Education, Vocational training, Life skills training, along with paramedical facilities such as Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, and Individual & Group Counseling to 175 Intellectually deficit children & Adults to help bring a positive influence of growth in their life & to make them individualistic.. We also help children excel in extracurricular activities & hobbies like dancing, Singing, Art & Craft, Sports etc.

## REPORTS OF VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS

### SCHOOL SECTION

Shri Devrajji Gundecha Punarvas Special School & Vocational Training Centre for Mentally Handicapped has 2 sections : Aided Section & UnAided Section



### AIDED SECTION

is aided by Social Welfare Department & has 50 students under this. Aided section is manned by 7 Staff members including:

- Principal,
- 2 Special Educators,
- 1 Craft Teachers
- 1 Junior Clerk
- 1 caretaker.

### UNAIDED SECTION

It is totally funded by Punarvas Education Society & has 60 students & is manned by 24 staff members including

- 8 Special Educators,
- 1 Computer Instructor,
- 1 Counselor,
- 1Speech Therapist,
- 1Occupational Therapist
- 1On visit Psychiatrist,
- 4 Administrative Staff,
- 2 Watchman ,
- 1 Caretaker
- 4 Classroom Assistants.

Punarvas Special School have 112 students in the School Unit with 10 students being transferred to Vocational Unit . 4 new admissions were taken during the year.. The School has 10 Special Educators, 1 Craft Teacher, 1 full time Counselor,1 Speech Therapist & 1 Occupational Therapist. Shri Devrajji Gundecha Punarvas Special School has also employed 10 ex- students as Teacher Assistants to help out in various departments.



## ONLINE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMES

Ongoing pandemic situation everywhere has made a severe impact on the Schools functioning. However we decided & have been making continuous efforts to make use of technology (online mediums such as Whats app, Google Meet, Zoom app) to ensure that children can get as much training as possible online so that the progress of students do not get hindered. Along with educational training students we have & are providing theraputic help (Counseling, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy etc) online on regular basis .School reopened on 15th June 2020 virtually for all the students due to pandemic situation everywhere. Assessment and observation of students were done between 15th June to 30th June, 2020. New Educational Curriculum Programmes were designed & prepared for students from 1st July to 20th July 2020 given and discussed with parents in last week of July & First week of August 2020 virtually as well as in person.

6 Monthly Assesment reports of students were shared with the parents in the month of November end in person.

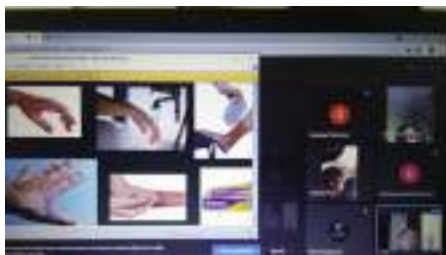

## **PUNARVAS EDUCATION SOCIETY'S LIONESSE CLUB OF MALAD-BORIVALI EARLY INTERVENTION CENTRE**

Early Intervention Centre started with four children in 2002. This year our school had 10 children of age group between 4 to 6 years. We have multiple handicapped children like Autistic, ADHD (Attention Deficient Hyperactive Disorder) & also children with cerebral Palsy. Along with intervention of Occupational Therapy, Nursery Group programme for these children also included training in perceptual-motor skills, Personal Skill, Psycho-social skill etc. Main focus was put in to improve their attention & concentration span. Water Therapy and sand play therapy are also included as a part of curriculum training which help them a lot to improve in their social & fine motor skills.

However this year due to ongoing pandemic situation bringing in some restrictions our teachers have put in a lot of efforts to keep up with the pace of providing therapies & training & education on daily basis using virtual medium (Whats App, Zoom, Google Meet etc).



## **PUNARVAS EDUCATION SOCIETY'S VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE**

The Centre has 38 trainees & is manned by 2 Instructors. Support is given by Craft teachers for Self Employment & trained for trades such as making Agarbatti, Liquid Soap, White Phenyl, Office Files, Screen Printing, Sewing aprons, purses & making paper bags etc. They are also being trained for trades such as making handicraft items i.e. Seasonal Greetings, Rakhies, Diwali Diyas, Letter Pads, Wicks for Diya & floating Candles etc. We also train them in self-employment.

Group I: Out of 18 students 12 are in the process of being trained for Candle making, file making, Screen Printing & 6 students have been fully trained for the same trades.

Group II : Out of 20 students 14 can independently make Agarbattis, Soap, Decorative Items & 3 students have completed their training. 3 students can independently make office files, Xeroxing etc.

However this year due to ongoing pandemic situation everywhere product making have been affected but we have been making lot of efforts in keeping up with the pace of production of vocational products by providing training of product making online and giving required raw materials to students to make products at home on daily basis.



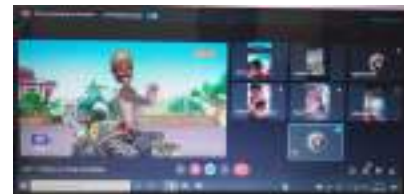
## **PUNARVAS EDUCATION SOCIETY'S COUNSELLING & GUIDANCE CENTRE**

Dr. Jayesh Ghodke Psychiatrist has been taking students for Behaviour Modification Treatment with regular parent counselling. Ms. Tejal Tirodkar School Counsellor assisted him in the programme & had taken up students for Behavior Modification & other treatment as required. In addition Group Counseling is also given to students, from 10 years & above which helps in developing their Social & Communication & emotional skills thus enhancing their overall personality. Topics for group counseling included peer pressure, listening skills, Appropriate behaviour etc.

### **OUT PATIENTS**

Parents or outpatients requiring guidance were counseled by Mrs. Savita Jawale & Ms. Tejal Tirodkar. They were provided with guidance on availability of different schemes and benefits for special needs along with the Schools & Workshops available for them at various places. Apart from this we are also reaching out to college students and other public and cover as many students to create awareness about the prevalence of disability & stressing on prevention etc.

This year due to ongoing pandemic situation everywhere Group as well as Individual Counseling was given on regular basis virtually by making use of online apps such as Google Meet, Whats App, Zoom etc.



## **PUNARVAS EDUCATION SOCIETY'S COMPUTER CENTRE**

Every year there are 45 to 50 students for Computer Training. The topics that are taught to students as per their levels include Computer Fundamentals, Introduction to Computer & their parts, Use of Computer in different jobs, Notepad, MS Paint, MS OFFICE (MS word, MS Excel, Paint & MS Power point), Educational CD'S ( To help the progress in language, Maths, Science etc. subject as per their syllabus.

Language: Writing alphabets in capital as well as in small words, phrases & simple sentences, use of question mark, coma, full stop, inverted coma's etc. Writing simple essay on simple topics in five lines, fill in the blanks write name & address etc.

Computer Training helps each child in different categories in various aspects. It improves their attention span, concentration level during the work. It helps improve their Action Reaction time tremendously, control as well as posture while sitting, also eye hand co-ordination. It helps them to improve their perceptual as well as reasoning through games & subject activities. It helps the children over all class room development.

However due to pandemic situation everywhere this and schools being shut physically due to Lockdown computer training was not being possible to be given to all the students as most of them do not have computers, laptops at home for virtual training. However 6 to 8 students were given computer training online.



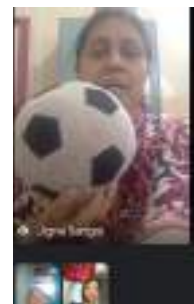
## **PUNARVAS EDUCATION SOCIETY'S LIONS JUHU MOHANDAI OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY CENTRE**

In the academic year 2020-21 due to pandemic situation everywhere students were given Occupational Therapy & Exercises training virtually (Online). In all 30 students received Occupational Therapy Department and 60 students were provided Gym excersises thrice a week throughout the year. Occupational Therapy is provided to students who have difficulties in Fine & Gross Motor Coordination, Eye Hand Coordination, ADL Activities, Attention Deficit. Hyperactive, Balancing difficulties, Sensory Issues, Eye Hand coordination difficulties etc. The therapy helps students in their overall development by showing gradual improvement in their functions. Occupational Therapy is given by 1 full time Occupational Therapist for 40 minutes a session per student twice to thrice a week. Gymnasium programme was also introduced for students above 15 years of age for weight management and fitness. About 60 students underwent the programme twice a week and 30 students on daily basis.



## **PUNARVAS EDUCATION SOCIETY'S SPEECH THERAPY CENTRE**

This year due to ongoing Pandemic Situation all around putting schools to halt in person Speech Therapy was given to students online using various mediums such as Zoom, Google Meet, Whats App etc. Our Speech Therapist Ms. Jigna Sangoi took in all 30 students for speech therapy this year from July 2020 to April 2021. All these children are from Mild to severe categories of speech Impairment with no speech, unclear speech etc. Therapy is provided twice a week basis with session lasting for approximately 30 minutes each child. Group Therapy sessions are also conducted to encourage inter personal Communication. Progress Reports have been maintained and issued to the parents so as to monitor progress and plan further goals. Parents are encouraged to meet the therapist to discuss the problems if any. All the children have shown appreciable improvement according to their level after giving Speech Therapy. The assistance provided by the teachers and parents is commendable.
