AMAR JYOTI FOUNDATION ANNUAL REPORT 2022-23

The Amar Jyoti Foundation (Haryana) a registered Non-Govt. organization has been serving the deprived and weaker section of the society for the last 34 years. The Foundation has continued its developmental & welfare programs through various Schemes & Projects sponsored by Govt. of India for the benefits of youth, women and poor aged people. The organization also works for Mentally RetardedChildren, Deaf & Dumb Children, Multi-Disabilities Children including teacher training Course. Beside this, Awareness programs on Anti-Drug, respect for older people and social awareness programs are also undertaken.

Main Achievements:

The organization has continued its efforts to implement & supplement various Welfare Schemes & Development Projects sponsored by Govt. of India resulting the benefits to the deprived & weaker section of population. A sense of security of lives among the destitute & deprived aged people was built up. Awareness programs & Social Events were organized and a large population benefited through these programs. Trainings were conducted for capacity building, behavioral changes and self employment. Private resources have been consistently tapped for providing welfare services to the weaker sections of the Society. Emphasis laid on community involvement.

Major Events:

The major activities carried out by the organization during the year 2021-22 are given below, these activities were conducted by keeping in view of protocol of Covid-19 issued by the Ministry from time to time:-

Special School (Non-Residential) for Mentally Retired and Children with Hearing Impairment:

The Foundation has been running a special School for 45 Mentally Disabled Children with financial assistance from Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment (Govt. of India) since 2002 and school for 29 children with Hearing Impairment has also been

running since 2010. As per DDRS Scheme Disabledchildren including Mentally Retired & Hearing Impairment were enrolled in the school and getting food, books, uniforms free of cost. An office vehicle is also provided to carry the children. A team of doctors comprising of physician, child specialist and psychologist regularly does checkup physical & mental health of the children. As per DDRS scheme, Special Education has been providing by Special Educator to the children through Toys, Ludo Games, Carom Boards & others teaching learning of recreational educational aids.

Women Empowerment Programme:

Increase in number of unemployment is all apparent & the gravity of the problem needs immediate attention. Employment for rural women and youth is the area of greater concern because despite of the increase in literacy rate, job opportunities are limited for them. Thus, the rural youth and women seek earning opportunities in vocational trades. Keeping this felt need in view, Amar Jyoti Foundation has undertaken the following vocational trainings for the youth & women from weaker section of the society.

Skill Training Programme :

The Cutting & Tailoring Program has also been undertaken from its own sources. App. 30 women/girls are getting training in cutting & tailoring trade for duration of one year. The trainees from SC & BC communities were provided with sewing machines and raw materials during the course. Trained Instructors have also been appointed to impart quality training. Besides, they were also involved in other awareness program conducted by the organization for their benefits as well as to make other aware so that they may also benefit.

Computer Training Centre:

The foundation is providing Computer Training. The main aim to arrange the Computer education is that Computer literacy is the basic need of each sector for modern technologies. Trainee is being benefitted free of cost. All the expenditure is being born by the foundation. The organization has its own computer systems and equipment to run the training programs.

Beautician Training

To make the girls/women belonging to economically poor family background, Amar Jyoti Foundation has been running a Training of Beauty Culture for girls/ women for the last 10 years. The training is imparted by the organization through its own resources. The training has proved very successful for making the girls/ women economically sound by seeking Job opportunities as well as establishing their own business. After becoming economically sound, they are capable to take decision in the family as well as in the society.

Old Age Home for Older Person:

The organization has been running Old Age Home (Maintenance of Senior Citizens Home) at Julana, Distt. Jind (Hr.) with the financial assistance from the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India. The project aims to provide the basic amenities of life i.e. food, shelter, clothing & health care and security of life to the needy, neglected and deprived old people. Some of them were discarded, neglected and even beaten by their children/ family members. They were asked to work hard in the family and were not get basic necessities of life. A total average of 27 older persons are residing in this old age Home. They are getting food, shelter, clothing and security of life. Apart from these they are sharing their experiences. The doctor has also been visiting the home regularly for health check up and treatment of minor ailments. For major diseases, the doctor refers them to Civil Hospital. The Old Age Home is equipped with nine rooms, Varamda, Recreation Room, 3 Wash Rooms, 3 Toilets, Kitchen & water cooler with R.O. for safe drinking water etc. The older people are residing in the clean environment. All the rooms are airy. Staff members comprising of superintendent, social worker, doctor, nurse and other supportive staff are available for smooth functioning of the project. Recreational activities as playing carom board, Cards & Chess etc. also Newspapers, Television (LED) are available. The older people were also used to go for outdoor picnic. The NGO have been providing counseling the inmates and time to time provide the necessary helps by ongoing Govt. Schemes.

D.Ed. Spl. Education for IDD & H. I.:

The Foundation has been running D.Ed. Spl. Edu. for ID and Children with Hearing Impairment since the year 2015-17 with approval from RCI. Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) under Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India at Julana, Distt. Jind. The institute has intake capacity of 35 seats for each courses. Person with disabilities form an integral part of our society, therefore more attention needs to be given them so as to include them in mainstream of society with the enactment of Right to Education Act 2009 and sensitivity towards equal opportunity to person with disability has seen significant change. With the development of education, a large number of children with disabilities, now attending the school regularly. Hence, Special Educators are needed to provide quality services to Divyangjans. Apart from Haryana, Teacher Training from nearly states are attending the regular classes of D.Ed. Spl. Ed.

Drug De-addiction Program:

The main aim of the program is to share awareness and initiate counseling to outdoor addicts for recovery. Now a day, taking drug substances is the symbol of modernization. The tendency is seen mostly in youth. The organization conducted 18 awareness programs on Anti-Drug. The addict were also pour seled by the counselor and briefed the ill effects of the use of drug substances. During the year approx. 145 reported addicts were benefitted.
