We started formation and strengthening of the Female Carers group along with the Parents group of persons living with disability. The team of **Bhavishya Kiran** contributed significantly in developing state level issue based action plan on disability, participated in state level advocacy drives and supported some national and state level issues. At the same time we also succeeded in meeting the expectations of the community at the grass root level.

Rehabilitation, Education, Child Protection, Skill development and Advocacy remained our core thematic areas of intervention. We believe that this year too **Bhavishya Kiran** was successful in bringing smile on some faces, protecting some lives, making some people to lead their life independently and some to improve their quality of life. Special efforts were made to strengthening Self Advocacy along with running Day Care Centre. A brief account of our major activities during the year is as follows:-

Briefe of CBM Prog

परिवार नेटवर्क मेंटर प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम वाकई में बहुत ही अच्छी प्रोग्राम है इसके लिए CBM एवम PARIVAAR को बहुत-बहुत धन्यवाद इस प्रोग्राम की खास बात यह है कि इस प्रोग्राम के माध्यम से बौद्धिक दिव्यांग के साथ-साथ मेंटर जो 7 सप्ताह तक प्रशिक्षण लेते हैं उनमें काफी परिवर्तन देखा गया है | भिविष किरण पैरंट्स एसोसिएशन को पायलट प्रोजेक्ट के रूप में मिली थी जिन की सफलता के बाद दोबारा कार्य करने का मौका मिला मैंने ऐसा महसूस किया है कि ये पूरा प्रोग्राम समर्पित पर खड़ा है इस प्रोजेक्ट के प्रथम चरण में मेंटर प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम झारखंड राज्य के 5 जिलो में 40 मेंटर को प्रशिक्षण देना है और सेल्फ एडवोकेट यानी 400 बौद्धिक दिव्यांग जनों का चयन करना है|

परियोजना के प्रथम तिमाही का रिपोर्ट इस प्रकार है

सभी पार्टनर के साथ 9 मार्च को अशोक वाटिका विशेष स्कूल के सभागार में आयोजित किया गया जिसमें प्लैनिंग एवं रणनीति मुखय एजेंडा था और इस कार्यक्रम में

और कई संस्था के लोग उपस्थित हुए जिसमें सभी के द्वारा कार्यक्रम को कैसे एवं किस रूप में करने पर चर्चा किया गया एवं परिवार के तरफ से मिलने वाले पर योजना के अंतर्गत रकम की भी जानकारियां दी गई |

प्रथम मेंटर प्रशिक्षण के रूप में झारखंड पेरेंट्स एसोसिएशन रांची में आयोजित किया गया जिसमें 10 मेंटर एवं 8 ID बच्चों के साथ दो दिवसीय प्रशिक्षण किया गया |

दूसरी मेंटर प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम जमशेदपुर के जमशेदपुर पेरेंट्स एसोसिएशन में करना था, लेकिन उनके यहां प्रशिक्षण हेतु पर्याप्त जगह नहीं रहने के कारण, अंतिम समय में जगह परिवर्तन किया गया/ उसके बाद थकती डीह कम्युनिटी सामुदायिक भवन में आयोजित किया गया इस दो दिवसीय प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम में जमशेदपुर से पांच संस्थान के सदस्य भाग लिए/

के अभिभावगण, सदस्यगण मेंटर के रूप में 27 लोगों ने प्रशिक्षण लिया | इस प्रशिक्षण के दौरान लगभग 12 ID बच्चे उपस्थित थे इस 2 दिवसीय प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम बहुत ही उल्लास के साथ अभिभावकों ने रुचि लेकर अपना प्रशिक्षण लिया|

तीसरा मेंटर प्रशिक्षण जो जमशेदपुर से 55 किलोमीटर हट के मौसाबनी में स्कूल ऑफ जॉय के सेंटर में दिया गया इस दो दिवसीय प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम में कई कठिनाइयां चैलेंज मिला जिसे दूर करते हुए प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम को सफल बनाया| इस प्रशिक्षण के दौरान लगभग 8 ID बच्चे उपस्थित थे, मेंटर के रूप में 12 लोगों ने प्रशिक्षण लिया |

<u>नोट चैलेंज</u>

मौसाबनी झारखंड के एसा जगह है जहां हिंदुस्तान कॉपर लिमिटेड की खदान है और यूरेनियम की माइन्स है और यह जगह नक्सल प्रभावित छेत्र है इन कारणों से यह इस क्षेत्र को काफी सेंसिटिव रूप से माना गया है और दिव्यागता की संख्या भी अधिक है | लेकिन जागरुकता का काफी अभाव है इस प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम के दौरान ऐसे अभिभावकों से मुलाकात हुई जिनके बच्चे का प्रमाण पत्र नहीं बना था पर उन्हें यह भी नहीं जानकारी थी कि प्रमाण पत्र से क्या क्या लाभ होती है| मेंटर की प्रशिक्षण में मास्टर ट्रेनर श्रीमती माला झा सुनील कुमार प्रशिक्षित मेंटर श्रीमती नीरा रानी अन्य के द्वारा विभिन्न ट्रेनिंग मॉडल के माध्यम से एक्टिविटी करवाते हुए प्रशिक्षण दिया गया | इसके लिए साउंड सिस्टम एवं प्रोजेक्टर का मदद लेते हुए प्रशिक्षण दी गई

PROMOTION OF PARENTS AND PWIDDS CHILDREN

Parents Awareness Pogramme

PARIVAAR, National Confederation of Parents' Organizations for Persons with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities supported for the four district level awareness programme for the parents. The programmes were organized at Ramgarh, Jamsedpur, Mosabani, Ranchi and Bokaro. In the programmes State Disability Commissioner, Deputy Commissioner, Rehabilitation Professional, different Service providers also participated alongwith the Parents. The programmes upgraded the knowledge of the parents and service providers on the different models of disability, key provisions for the PWD, Rights of the PWD, Acts and Policies for them etc. These programmes also identified the key challenges and issues of the parents.

Mainstreaming Persons with intellectually and developmentally delayed through Self Advocacy

Background:

Mainstreaming and Inclusive development have became the epicenter of public discourse and development process in the last decade. The initiatives like- Rights of Persons with disability Act, sustainable Developmental Goal and flagship programs like Accessible India have acted as catalyst to boost inclusion process. But in spite of all these, persons with intellectually and developmentally delayed are still excluded, unheard and discriminated. PARIVAAR- National Confederation of Parents Organization has attempted to address this issue through SAFI- Self Advocacy Forum of India. Under this programme persons with intellectually and developmentally delayed are trained on their life skills, communication skills, self protection skills etc. This programme supported by PARIVAAR and CBM, Bangalore is being implemented in five districts of Jharkhand by Bhawisya Kiran.

Project Brief:-

The aim of the project was "Promoting initiative by parents and Self Advocates for Community Based Inclusive Development". The specific objective of the 6 months project was "to promote mainstreaming of PwIDDs by improving access to Government schemes". The project covers 40 clusters across five districts of Jharkhand. Major expected results were

- 40 Mentors will be trained to promote Self Advocacy among PwIDDs
- Persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities will move towards mainstreaming through promotion of 40 Self Advocacy groups
- Programmes & schemes of Central and State Government will become more accessible to PwIDDs and their families.

The impacts:

Six month is too short period for expecting any tangible impacts. However during this short period the reflection by the parents indicates some of the changes in the life of the PwIDDS:

- "I used to consider myself as a good parent. I used to support my Down Syndrome child as I was unaware of hidden potential of my son. I am surprised to witness changes in him."
- "She has become very social. Now I can take her to market. All these happened because of the oppourtunities given to her for express her desire"
- "I have changed. Now I can guide my child in better way"

"One of the major worries removed, when I saw my daughter to protecting herself (from bad touch)

Major Outcomes:-

- 04 new (total 05) organization including 02 Parents Organizations developed conceptual clarity about Self Advocacy
- 42 (F-16, M-26) Rehabilitation workers/parents acquired knowledge and skill for mentorship to Self Advocates
- 40 groups of Self Advocates have been formed across 05 districts (Dhabad, Bokaro, Hazaribag, Ramgarh, and Ranchi)
- 04 groups (40 PWIDDs) of self Advocates trained for seven weeks
- Increased Awareness on Self Advocacy among 165(direct participants) & 5000 (indirect- through media/ social network) people
- Self Advocates and Parents are more aware of the Government Schemes and proocess. During the project period 112 self advocates realized at least one entitlement.

Major Activities:-

- 1. Adaptation of training module for mentors
- **2.** Project orientation cum Strategic planning workshop:- In the workshop besides orientation of the project and finalization of the formats following criteria were finalized:

Selection Criteria for Mentors:

- Any disability related course
- *Minimum three years experience*
- Good communication skill.
- Interest in the programme and willingness to devote the time
- Written consent in the proscribed format

Selection Criteria for the Volunteers:-

40 volunteers were selected on the basis of following criteria:

- Minimum two years experience
- Good communication skill.
- Interest in the programme and willingness to devote the time
- Written consent in the proscribed format

Groups of Self Advocated:-

The criteria for formation of the Self Advocate groups of Persons with Intellectual and Developmental Disability were as follows:-

- *Profile of 10/07 Self advocates*
- At least two orientation meetings (with reports in the prescribed format)
- Online Assessment of all members.
- 3. **Awareness programme**:- Two awareness programmes one each at Ramgarh and Dhanbad were conducted. Key outputs of the programme were as follows:
 - Better understanding about PARIVAAR, SAFI and programme
 - Conceptual clarity among 89 participants about Self Advocacy and Mentorship
 - Selection of 12 Mentors
 - *Short listing of 29 potential volunteers*

- Awareness through Media/ Establishing Mentorship as an issue
- **4. Mentors Orientation:** 18 key mentors were oriented as per the training module. The orientation contributed in the following:
 - Better understanding about PARIVAAR, SAFI and programme
 - Conceptual clarity among 89 participants about Self Advocacy and Mentorship
 - Finalization of 12 Mentors
 - Conceptual clarity role of mentors and volunteers
 - Mentors developed understanding on Self Advocay and mentorship as per module-2,3
 - Finalization of the Action plan
- 5. Volunteers training: 42 volunteers were provided 2 days training on Mentorship

Key Contents:-

- Brief about PARIVAAR, SAFI, and PARIVAAR Network Programme
- PWIDDs
- Self Advocacy
- Mentorship
- Role of Mentor
- Mentorship as per module

Key Outputs:

- Better understanding about PARIVAAR, SAFI and programme
- Conceptual clarity about Self Advocacy and Mentorship
- Knowledge on Self advocacy and mentorship acquired as per training module
- 42 Mentors acquired basic skill for mentorship
- Practical training schedule finalized.
- Profile of the selected mentors developed
- 6. Formation of groups by volunteers: 40 groups including 400 PwIDDS were formed
- 7. Practical training of Volunteers: Selected 40 volunteers were imparted seven weeks (one day in a week) training in four batches, each consisting 10 volunteers as per the training module of PARIVAAR.
- 8. Data base of the mentors and Self Advocates: Data base is under process

The programme will complete in the third week of December with the state level dissemination programme.





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
