April 2018–March 2019

Introduction

As we felt the special needs of persons with Mental Retardation, Cerebral Palsy, Autism and Multiple Disabilities, we decided to form organization “HOPE”, under the guidance of members of parents association Home & Hope, of Rourkela.

HOPE came into existence on 10.02.2001. Special centre was started on 01.04.2001 (Utkal Diwas) in a players rest room at Rajgangpur stadium. Due to certain difficulties like lack of supply water, frequent interruption of special centre activities due to other activities of athletic association and other activities like Puja Pandals, Meena Bazaar Etc., the special centre was shifted to Block 7 Qtr. No. 137 & 138, O.C.L. India Ltd. with due permission from management.

Due to increase inmates the space was inadequate in couple of years. Hence, we started to look for bigger space. Management of O.C.L. India Ltd. was kind enough to give financial help as Mrs. Ranjeet Kaur donated a place in Ranibadh New Colony.

With the help of friends and members of “HOPE“ we completed the Special centre and residential space for children’s coming from far away tribal areas like Kutra, Badgaon, Kalunga and even remote Villages during 2009.

List of Inmates: We are now capable to handle 50 Divyang students in our Day-care special centre and Vocational Training centre. Many children’s with Mental Retardation, Cerebral Palsy, Autism and Multiple Disabilities has been identified in and around Rajgangpur town. Some Children’s from Kalunga, Kutra, and remote tribal area’s also attends special centre and stay at our residential hostel from 2016.


Management: Executive committee of “HOPE” manages the special centre. The members are mostly parents, motivated doctors and officials from local cement plant and teachers from various special centres of rajgangpur.

Staff: At present we have two Special Educator, one Physiotherapist, one Vocational trainer, one Craft trainer and four attendants.

General Education: Children’s are grouped according to their capabilities and strength. Children’s are taught about motor skills, skills required for A D L (Activities of Daily Living) Communication, Social Behavior etc. Some Children’s are taught to read and write, do simple mathematics like addition, subtraction and read simple sentences.

These children’s are taught reading Maps, safe walking and signpost identification etc.

The special educators also counsel new parents and help them evolving strategies to cope better along with members and volunteers of HOPE, gives home visit to ensure good attendance of the child, home based program is an important activity of special educator and physiotherapist.

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Library: Publications from National Institute for mentally handicapped, Secunderabad, few publications from Chennai like success & ability are kept in special centre for reference for educator and parents.

Accommodation: In the second year of construction of new HOPE Special centre building we had 30 inmates in our residential special centre as well as Day-Care special centre facility.

Vocational Training & Production Centre: We have inducted our 18+ age group students to vocational training centre to learn and can be self sufficient in any of the below activities. We provide trainings on Candle Making, Incense Stick Making, Phenyl making, Masala grinding, greeting cards, paper bags, artificial flowers and Tailoring. These training and products are not taken the form of profitable production centre.

Health and Medical Facilities: since there are many doctors in HOPE as members and some of them are in executive committee, regular health checkup and treatment of our children's are done for free of cost. We have one regular physiotherapist. Speech therapist from Ispat General Hospital gives their voluntary service from time to time.


Early Intervention Clinic: We started our specific Early Intervention Clinic at Subash Bose Hospital from 2nd October 2007 on Gandhi Jayanti. Guidance is given to parents after examination of children by eminent doctors, special educator, speech therapist, physiotherapists and psychologist.

Yoga and Moral Teaching: One of the officials from OCL India Ltd. gives yoga and meditation teaching. Members of ART OF LIVING from Rourkela joined us to help these children's.

Parents Meeting: Since HOPE is a parent association, it's foundation is monthly meeting of executive committee, where valuable decisions are taken about smooth running of special centre and any specific problem is solved.

Fund Raising: we are fortunate enough to get support from Dept. of SSEPD, Govt. of Odisha, local companies like O.C.L. India Ltd., L & T Kansbahal, HML and other Industries, friends, well-wishers who came forward to help us with finance for smooth running of special centre.

Sports Activities & World Disability Day: International day for Dibyangs falls on 3rd December every year which is celebrated by organizing annual sports day for children's of HOPE as well as children's from different special centres for divyangs. This meet is one of its kind where children's with different abilities are brought under one umbrella. The happiness on faces of these children's are quite satisfying, it's worth conducting such program regularly.

January-2019


1. New Year & Picnic

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Activity Reports "HOPE"

Special education:

In hope special education of verbal and nonverbal communication and social interaction is done which affect a child educational performance. Repetitive activities are done so that children get acquaint to it .

Prevocational training : Prevocational training involves training in basic work skills and counselling as required for a typical employment setting.

Vocational training: Vocational training is training that focuses on the practical application of skills learned. job specific technical training is taught to the autistic child with a view that they may gain employment at some point in the future.

Yoga class:

As yoga increases the strength and flexibility and increases the sense of peace . It also help in reducing pain, anxiety ,aggression, obsessive beahaviour and self stimulatory activities.

Physiotherapy : People on the autism have delays, differences and disorders in many areas. In addition to developmental delays, most have low muscle tone and experience difficulty with gross motor coordination (running, kicking, throwing, etc.). These issues can interfere with basic day-to-day functioning, and they're almost certain to interfere with social and physical development.

Occupational therapy: A person who has autism spectrum disorder (ASD) often has trouble communicating and interacting with other people; his or her interests, activities, and play skills may be limited. Occupational therapy may help people with autism develop these skills at home and in school.


Dance therapy: Dance/movement therapy has the capacity to meet people with autism in many ways. This approach is not only *unique*, but unlike many treatment approaches in autism, the goal in dance/movement therapy is to channel the communication patterns into "dances of relationship."

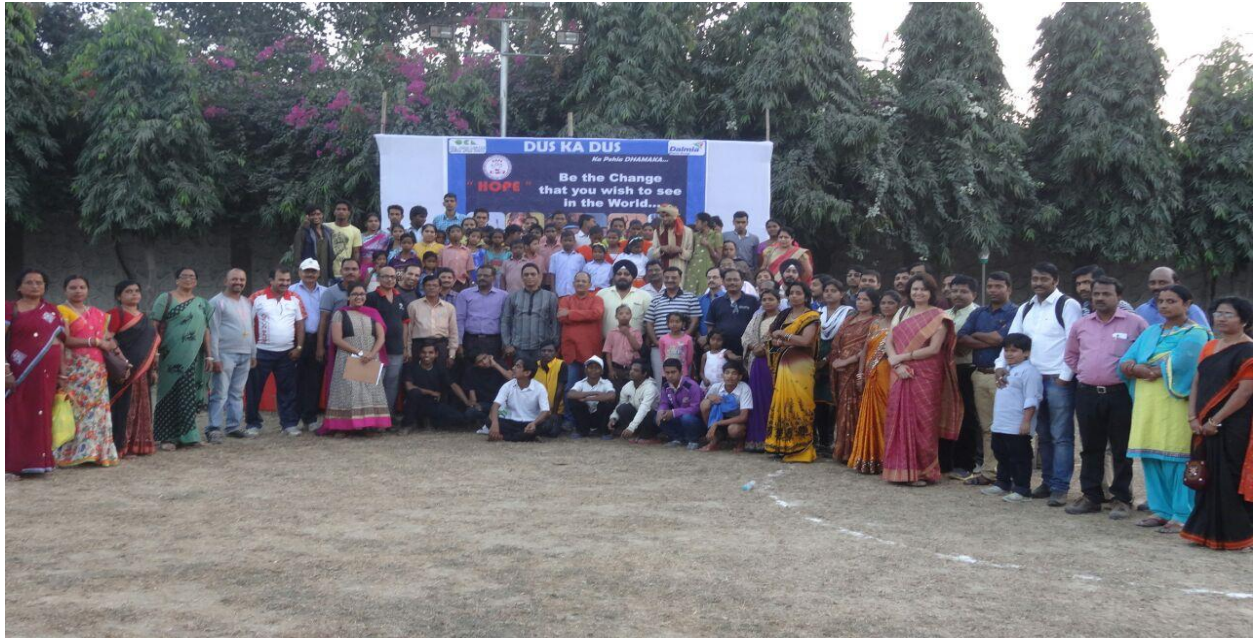
