'Ma'din School for the Intellectually Deficient', formerly known as 'Ma'din VikalangaVidyalayam' is the special school run by Ma'dinu Ssaquafathil Islamiyya, a registered organization as per the Society Registration Act of 1860. As per the vision and objectives mentioned in the Memorandum of the Association, the organization has been involved

in following activities for the welfare of persons with disabilities especially for the categories targeted by National Trust

'Ma'din School for the Intellectually Deficient' has been providing comprehensive services such free food, accommodation and all learning support materials for children with intellectual disability, cerebral palsy and autism. Advanced multidisciplinary rehabilitation services for children with Intellectual Disability, ADHD are given through 'Ma'din Lifeshore – Advanced Paediatric and Adult Rehabilitation Centre'. Under the banner of 'Ma'din Able World', variety of public awareness and community extension programs are conducted regularly.

As on today there are **60 boys** and **6 girls** attending regular classes with the support of food, accommodation, education and rehabilitation services
