#### Achievement of Our School -:

The School has been appointed to perform at March Past, Cultural Programme on the 69<sup>th</sup> Republic Day at Police Line like previous year in the August Presence of D.M., S.P., A.D.M, A.S.P, D.I.C.O., D.S.W.O. and other honorable persons of the locality like previous year.

- On 9<sup>th</sup> February 2019, Foundation Day of Our Institution was Celebrated and Swami Divyanandaji Maharaj, Secreaty Ramkrishna Mission Saradapitha, Belur, was present on that Particular Day and Ms. Basabdutta, Secretary, Zilla Parishad, was the Chief Guest of the Function and VIP Guests were also present on that auspicious occasion.

- On 08/03/19 a Regional Meeting of DDRS was held at Lalit Great Eastern Hotel, KOLKATA and problems faced regarding entry in PFMS as discussed at the Meeting. Shilpi Mondal Smriti Drawing Competition was held by Rotary Club at Arabinda Stadium, Burdwan and Rupam Mondal Ranked in the said Competition.
- Our students participated in the parade of Republic Day which was observed at Police Line on 26/01/19 and also took part in the cultural programme and awarded 3<sup>rd</sup> best presentation in cultural acivities at Police Line, Burdwan.
- "ARANYA SAPTAHO" was observed by the District Forest Department at Ramna Bagan Golap Bag, Burdwan. Our students participated in the Sit and Draw competition and won prize in different group.
- Our Kanyashree Club is running in the institution like previous year.
- Anandabazar Patrika a famous publishing group, ABP LTD, is supplying paper like previous year for the Kanyasree Club Members to enhance their knowledge as also to inform them any overwhelming performance of an Kanyasree Club Member.
- An Awareness Camp for their Menstrual Hygiene was held with help of their members at our institution
- A Sit and Draw Competition was organized by West Bengal Association of the Deaf.
- On 9<sup>th</sup> March 'Women's Day' was observed at our School Campus.
- Our students took part in the 'Samanunuvuti Yatra' PWD Awareness on Wheel with VVPAT on 1st April 2019.
- Najmin Khatun our student was selected as District PWD VOTER ICON.
- As per order of the District Magistrate, Burdwan Mid-Day Meal was started and running at our School.
- For Mid Day Meal Rs.13,975/- was provided by the Mid Day Meal Committee to purchase Utensil for cooking etc.
- Mid Day Meal Committee was also provided Rs. 300/- for purchasing of cleaning materials for Utensil.
- For extension of the Kitchen Room for Mid day Meal Rs.2,70,000/-(Rs.two lakh seventy thousand) only was allotted to our institution and the work has been completed.
- After completing their course from our institutions our students are getting Service.
- After completing Vocational Course our students received Rs. 15,000/- from Vocational Rehabilitation Centre
  and most of the student started their own business.

Our institution is facing an acute financial hardship due to irregular release of Grant-in-Aid from the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment. A hostel for the CWSN children is running at our School Campus and we cannot provide sufficient foods to them due to shortage of fund as sufficient Grants are not released from the Ministry. Teachers of our institutions not are getting their honorarium in time and it has become a matter of great concern for the Managing Committee of the Institution to run the Institution.

We are facing also a new problem for the past few months, as Public Fund Monitoring System (PFMS) has been made mandatory by the DDRS as all entries of the Cash Book Ledger etc. are to be entered in the system through online but due to some technical problem, each and every time we enter our records in their system it is rejected. We have asked for technical support from them through email



repeatedly but we were not replied till today. We personally met Sri Ramanuj Dey, Under Secretary, Department of Empowerment, of Persons with Disabilities Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, New Delhi on 08/03/19 at a Regional Meeting of DDRS held at Lalit Great Eastern Hotel, KOLKATA and he assured us to contact him personally at his Department so that all disputes regarding entry in PFMS (which is mandatory for receiving grants) can be solved but we were unable to contact with him at Delhi due to financial crisis and measures will be taken very soon to solve this problem.

Further, I want to draw the kind notice of all of our respected members regarding irregular release of Grant-in-Aid from Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, DDRS, New Delhi which has caused a disaster for the management to run the institution smoothly.
