Welcome to 9th year of Vihang. It has been extremely fascinating and had our heels on run.

Vihang started its year with beautiful doctors on the eve of doctors day. This year we celebrated Doctors Day and Ashadi Ekadashi together. Doctors actively participated as Warkaris and enjoyed with doctors. Doctors gave certificates to students who passed open schooling examination.

Vihang School believes in making parents efficient so our parents support group collaborated with national body "SAKSHAM" and conducted one week course "Lets Learn Differently". We had a international speaker "Mrs Neelima Aachwal" from Dubai. She is a behavior analyst along with her experts in aurangabad and pune guided parents about various aspects of differently able children.

In Aurangabad we were not getting disability certificate for autism. They were labelling children with autism as intellectual impaired. We created immense pressure on the authorities and started the facility of autism disability certificate

सॉफ्टवेअर अपडेट केल्याने घाटीतन काही मलांना ऑटीझमचे स्वतंत्र प्रमाणपत्र मिळण्यास

सरुवात झाली आहे.

मानसोपचारतज्ज्ञांनी आयक्य टेस्टमधून मुलाला ऑटीझम आहे, असे सिद्ध होत असले किंवा क्लिनिकल सायकोलॉजिस्ट मुलांचे मुल्यमापन करू शकतो तरी प्रमाणपत्र देताना मार्गदर्शक सचना (गाइडलाइन्स) उपलब्ध नाही. यामुळे पालकांना मानसिक

मुले आणि पालकांच्या समस्या मांडल्या होत्या. २०११ च्या जनगणनेनुसार शहरात ५८,५८० येतील, असे लेखी कळविले होते.

Students celebrated Friendship Day by tying friendship bands to each other and enjoyed friendship day




Rakshabandhan Day was celebrated with students of Sharda Mandir and we had a very nice inclusive event
