Important activities during 2017 -2018 :

2nd April – World Autism Day

Observation of World Autism Day was done with a rally at Deshpriyo Park, Kolkata in which 30 trainees & parents participated .

15th April

Trainees of SKP were visited to perform on “Poila Baisakh “ – Bengali New Year Day at Baisakhi Sangha. The trainees presented a 1-hour entertainment programme which was appreciated by one and all.

23rd July

Trainees of SKP performed in the cultural evening to commemorate the 150th Birth Anniversary of Sister Nivedita organized by Ramakrishna Mission Seva Pratishthan .The presentation was highly acclaimed and appreciated by the large audience which included Monks and eminent doctors.

18th July

SKP introduced a catering service at Julien Day New Mission School .Students of this organization used to go to school and prepare sandwiches ,chowmein and other snakes delicacies for serving during tiffin hours.

August 2017 was a remarkable month for the South Kolkata Parasmoni during this month, Sip n Bite an entrepreneurship venture of trainees of this organization, was launched and the first venture was at a seminar organised at Lions Club Metropolitan where these trainees catered tea and cookies .The effort was the first of its kind and was lauded by one and all. The team has successfully served and catered orders in many seminars as well, as different fairs .The awareness spread by these boys and girls at a fair organised at Maddox Square Kolkata was commendable. I sincerely believe that the effort of

this team shall flourish and become a pioneering venture in the days to come. All they need is a bit of encouragement and guidance from us.

27th August

25th & 26th October 2017

Fourth SAFI (Self Advocates Forum of India) National Convention was held at Ahmedabad on 25h & 26th October ,Bhaskar Saha one of our trainee represented Bengal team as a Self Advocates and Sri Kalyan Kumar Sau one of our teacher attended the same as a mentor .250 Self Advocates from different parts of the country took part in this event with sessions on leadership building ,listening exercises, expressive communication techniques recreational and team building activities.

3rd December – International day for Persons with Disabilities

World disability day 2017 was observed and celebrated on large canvas by SKP. This year almost 30 children and parents participated in a big rally was organized by office of the Disability commissioner Govt. of West Bengal. There was a big fare – Rozgar Mela on 4th & 5th Dec 2017 ,SKP has actively participated in the programme. Office of the Commissioner of Disabilities have brought out a magazine with selected drawings of PWDs. Miss Apala Roy and Mr. Sumandeep Kundu's painting was selected and appears in the cover page of Sphuron magazine.

6th – 8th December 2017

It was a proud moment for SKP when one of our trainee was selected for the social role Valorization Course 2017 ,conducted by Keystone Services USA in association with Hans Foundation India & National Trust in New Delhi between 6th – 8th Dec2017 .His father ,a member of this organization accompanied his as mentor .Mentors and persons working in the Disability sector from all over India attended the course. Our trainee was the only self advocate selected for the course and it was a great exposure for him. He was accepted generously and heartily by one and all. The name of SKP became familiar all over the country and the concept of Sip n Bite was widely acknowledged.

10th December

The cultural evening of the organization was held on 10th Dec2017 at Aban Mahal Hall (CLT) with the usual pomp and

grandeur. This year the event commenced with Vedic song accompanied by dance. The day also marked the Birth Anniversary of Sri Sarda Devi .A group of elderly ladies presented a wonderful collage of songs to make the occasion. This year we felicitated three eminent personalities for their overall contribution and dedicated work. This year the students of Saturday class were included in the programme and they presented a dance drama that touched the heart of the audience. The star attraction of the evening was the presentation of Dance Drama “Alibaba “ by the students of SKP .A packed house enjoyed and were mesmerised at awesome presentation.

This year was special in many ways. Apart from the above all the teachers and non- teaching staff of the organization were felicitated on the occasion. Overall it was a wonderful evening loved and appreciated by one and all.

21st March – World Down's Syndrome Day

SKP in collaboration with Julien Day School and TKS organised a art exhibition and fashion show along with cultural programme at Nazrul Tirtha on 24th March 2018 to celebrate the World Down's Syndrome Day. A renowned painter Sri Subhaprasanna inaugurated the art exhibition. It was a fun full programme.

Activities performed by the above mentioned students in the year 2017-2018-

1. Training on spice-guiding unit.
2. Training on handloom articles.
3. Training on canteen and baking .
4. Training on silk screen printing.
5. Training on life skill and functional academics.
6. Training on Febric.
7. Training on Sewing has been introduced during this time where 7 students are regularly trained. Out of seven 5 are M.R., 1 Autistic and 1 with M.D.
8. Training on Computer application conducted by Webel an organization of govt of WB.(4 Autistic Students,12 M.R.Students.)

An entrepreneurship venture was initiated by the Organisation where 11 students are involved. They are trained on baking and confectionary and they are also carrying out catering orders in various seminars and meeting. 6 M.R. and 5 Autistic students are being trained.

In addition to above all the students are taking part in the regular and routine activities to mark different occasion like World Disability Day, world Autism Day, Raksha bandhan Down Syndrome Day etc.

The training imparted by the organization is applicable for all the students as per their ability.
