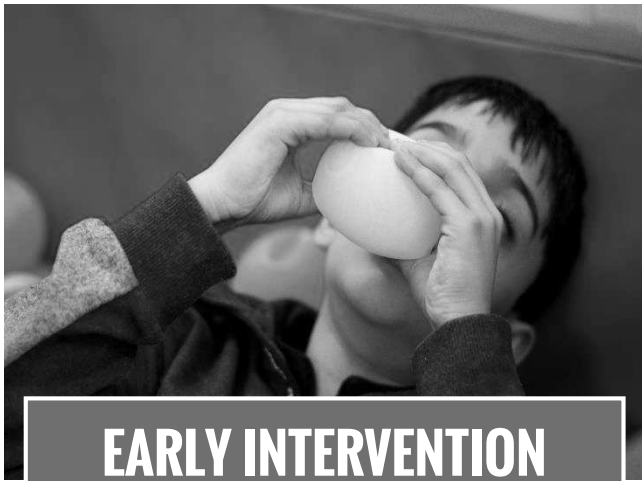

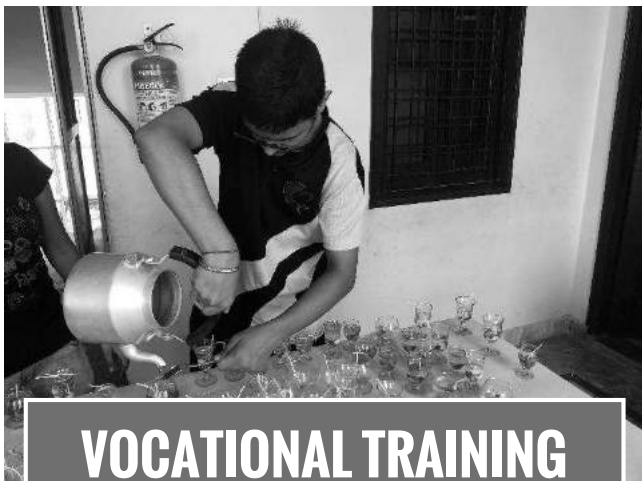

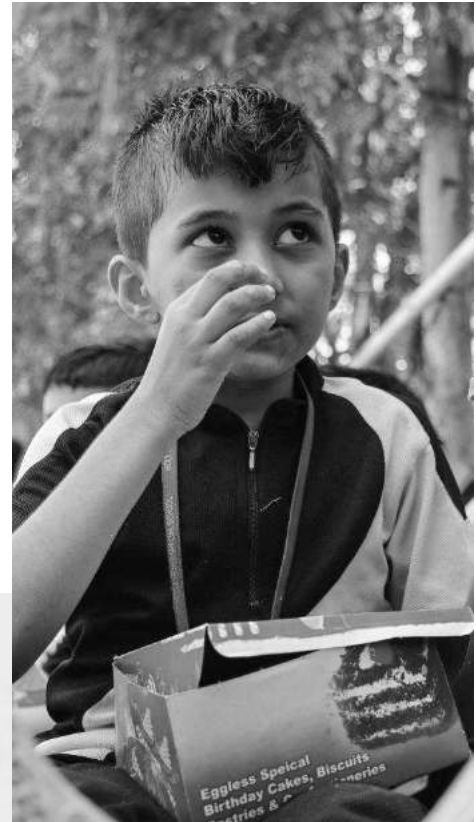

They taught drama to our kids. Every child involved in learning Drama. They enjoyed a lot

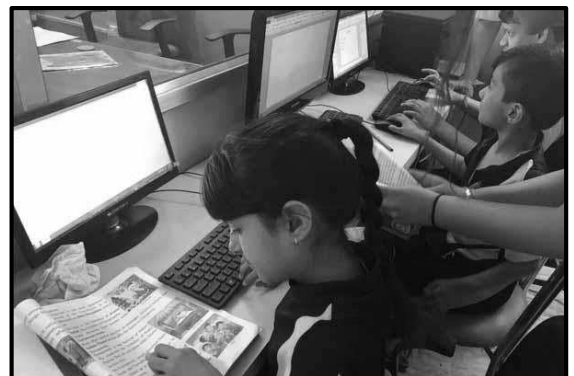


# 8. Visit of Modern Convent School
