A disability is any condition that makes it more difficult for a person to perform certain activities or interact effectively with the world around them (socially or physically). Loss caused by disability may be present from birth or may be acquired during a person's lifetime. Often, people with disabilities are "unnecessarily isolated and excluded from full participation in society. As a result of disabilities, people with disabilities may experience disabilities from birth, or may be labeled as disabled in their lifetime. Our organization provides monthly pension to disabled people who are above 18 years of age, and belong to 40% poverty line, for the prosperity of their lives.



Education Program For Beggar Child

Senior Citizen Health Camp organized by **“SWAMI VIVEKA NAND EDUCATION TRUST”** at **Samba** district in **Jammu & Kashmir** state. The objective of this program is to provide financial assistance to child beggars and children of beggars to study at pre and post matriculation or post-secondary level to enable them to complete their education. These scholarships are only available to children of beggars and children of beggars to study in India and are awarded from where the applicant is studying.

1. On 7th May, 2021:

An awareness camp was organised by SVET at Chak Salar for people suffering from M.R. certificate. Sarpal thanks to Sh. President SVET for providing information and assistance made their disabilities certificate.



2. On 16th June 2021: Medical facility i.e. Physiotherapy provided by SWAMI VIVEKANAND EDUCATIONAL TRUST for four children. Dr. Nitin Sharma, a Physiotherapist gave Therapy session to the children. Their names with disabilities are

- (a) Shaswat - M.R. & C.P.
- (b) Nitish Kumar - M.R. & C.P.
- (c) Rasanpreet Kour - C. P.
- (d) Chandni Devi - Down Syndrome & M.R.



3. On 19th July 2021:

Transport facility provided by SWAMI VIVEKANAND EDUCATIONAL TRUST to 5 yrs old boy namely **Sehaj** from Rahva to Medical Board Samba for making disability certificate.



4. On 25th Oct. 2021:

A wheel chair is provided by SWAMI VIVEKANAND EDUCATIONAL TRUST to 9 yrs old bed ridden C.P. & M.R. girl.



5. On Nov. 2021;

In the month of Nov. Govt. of India conduct assessment camps in Samba dist. For PWDs under ADIP Scheme & for Senior Citizen under RVY scheme.



An awareness drive is conducted by SVET village to village for registration of the eligible candidates who are suffering from M.R., C.P. & multiple disabilities can register themselves in these camps.

6. On 2nd Feb., 2022:

One month identification drive is started by SWAMI VIVEKANAND EDUCATIONAL TRUST to identify the person who has no disability certificate.



7. On 19th March 2022:

SWAMI VIVEKANAND EDUCATIONAL TRUST team visited to village Panthal of dist. Rajouri. There were 3 children namely Shameem, Shammi & Mohd. Yavar in a family, who was suffering from Cerebral Palsy & had been in bed ridden.

Their father was not even in a position to give them any facility.

- On 21st March 2022: Transport facility provided to especially abled children to Medical Board Samba for their disability (Somanya, Vansh Digra, Vanshika & Jarun Kumar).

9. On 31st March 2022:

Disability certificate distributed among 4 children Jarun Kumar, Vansh Sharma, Somanya and Vanshika.



10. Visit to Village Painthal Dist.- Reasi
