About Organization

Gram Jan Shikshan Sansthan is a non-profit, non-political, and non-religious society registered under the Madhya Pradesh Society Registration Act 1973. The organization is committed to working for the rehabilitation and welfare of persons with disabilities (PwDs), women empowerment, drug addiction recovery, and the overall development of youth and children under various state and central government schemes. In the year 2022-2023, the organization continued its services and successfully completed 10 years of dedicated service.

Vision:

The organization's vision is to enhance the quality of life of all types of PwDs, women, children, and other citizens in the community, enabling them to live independently to the maximum extent possible.


Mission:

The mission of Gram Jan Shikshan Sansthan is to empower individuals through holistic development, with a special focus on children and women, providing them with livelihood opportunities and ensuring a better quality of life.

Objectives:

The organization has specific objectives, including:

- Rehabilitation and development of persons with disabilities, such as intellectual disabilities/mental retardation, blindness, visual impairment, cerebral palsy, autism, deafness, hearing impairment, learning disabilities, speech and language disabilities. This is achieved through community-based rehabilitation, establishment of homes, day care centers, special schools, vocational training centers, and rehabilitation institutes.
- o Promotion of rural sports at the grassroots level.
- Empowerment of PwDs by enhancing their abilities and sharpening their capabilities.
- o Provision of mobile health services in rural, tribal, and other areas.
- Creation of environmental awareness among people regarding civic sense and social relationships.



- Implementation of programs for the overall development of Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Other Backward Classes (OBC), minorities, youth, and adolescents from all sections of society.
- Awareness campaigns on AIDS/HIV and de-addiction, along with the implementation of rehabilitation programs for addicts and HIV-positive individuals.
- Promoting better health, hygiene, and sanitation practices to build a healthy nation. Motivating people to protect the environment and revive traditional values of agriculture and rural development.

10th Annual General Meeting:

The annual general meeting of Gram Jan Shikshan Sansthan was held on 15th October 2023, with the presence of all society members. The meeting commenced with the chairman taking the chair, followed by the secretary welcoming all the members, workers, and guests.

Financial Overview:

During the year ending on 31st March 2023, the organization spent a total of Rs. 260,490.00 on various social welfare activities. The Receipt & Payment Account, Income & Expenditure Account, and Balance Sheet were presented, read out, and approved by the members.

Achievements and Programs:

The organization achieved significant milestones during the reporting year through the successful implementation of various programs and activities. Some notable projects and activities conducted in 2022-2023 include:

Special School cum Day Care Center: The organization operates a special school for blind children and PwDs, providing special education, activities of daily living (ADL) training, medical and therapeutic facilities, cultural activities, and sports. Benefits under various state and central government schemes are also provided.



`Early Intervention Center: The organization offers early intervention services, including early identification, screening and assessment, counseling and guidance, ADL training, academics, physiotherapy, speech and communication therapy, behavior modification, fun games, recreation, and preparation for mainstreaming into regular schools.

Parents Meeting and Training: Regular meetings and training sessions are conducted for parents to provide them with guidance and support in understanding and addressing the needs of their children.





Awareness Programs & Medical Camps: Various awareness programs and medical camps are organized to disseminate information and provide medical services to the community.

Dance & Music Classes for PwIDD's: Special dance and music classes are conducted for persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities (PwIDDs) to promote their artistic talents and overall development.

Survey and Field Work for Identification of PwIDD's: Extensive surveys and fieldwork are carried out to identify and reach out to persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities in need of support and rehabilitation.

Niramaya Insurance Help Line: The organization provides assistance and guidance regarding Niramaya Insurance, a health insurance scheme for persons with disabilities.

Drug Addiction Program: The organization arranges programs and seminars to create awareness about drug addiction and advises people against any form of substance abuse. Pamphlets and handouts are distributed to raise awareness.

Gram Vikas Programmes:

As part of Gram Vikas (village development) programs, the organization worked towards improving the living conditions of villagers. Social responsibility awareness programs and yoga training sessions were conducted to promote a healthy lifestyle without any cost or side effects of medicines. Nukkad Natak (street plays) were performed to bring joy to the faces of villagers while imparting good values through the theme of the play.

Provision of safe and accessible building Provision RO drinking water.


Open areas for outdoor games and recreation.
