- f) Develop an information base on youth work, child and women development work, environment, social legal aids, Non-formal Education, Health Management Information System etc. for Development workers / activist groups., Promote Professional competence in human service management and development through Training, Research Work and Publish mattes collected or obtained from these forms as well as from national or international resources.

- g) Provide support to the Projects / Program / Associations sponsored or funded by NGOS. Trusts / Government / Semi-Government Organization in project planning, monitoring and evaluation and follow-up programmers.
- h) To affiliate and take support with other societies. Institutions organizations, national or international, in the pursuit of all any of the above objectives.

- To open, found, establish, promote setup, run maintain, assist, support and / or help the various charitable, educational, technical / nontechnical, vocational, agricultural and community development programs for all.
- m) To open, found, establish, promote setup, run maintain, assist, support and / or help the various community development programs / activities and also construct and develop the community halls, marriage homes, pio, Dharmshala, night shelters, shochalay, libraries, old age homes, Orphanage, health care centers, charitable dispensaries, hospitals, reading rooms, play grounds, stadiums (both open and indoor), yoga training centers, gymnasiums, music and dance training centers, aganwari, balwari, mahila ashram, studios, drama state and other buildings / institutions for use of general public and for welfare of the general public.

- n) To give, provide and / or render monetary and / or other help and assistance for the relief of persons and animals affected by natural and other calamities such as flood, fire, famine, cyclone, earthquake, storm, accident, drought, epidemic, unbearable cost of living etc.
- o) To educate the people and organize various kinds of awareness programmes / activities regarding Consumer Protection laws and rights of the public in this connection.

The area lacks in basic amenities such as public toilet, roads, drainage system, drinking water etc. The people are illiterate in different slums and unauthorized colonies and have no sensitization towards their own problems. Infect food and shelter is primary for them and health becomes the secondary issue. One can also observe the cases of Drug abuse in the area. Though the few area is better of in the area but over the entire scenario needs an urgent attention on health and education needs of the community.

The population of these particular areas is living here migrantly, for longer period of time but population of these particular areas also is living here permanently, for longer period of time they are staying with their families and without family. They are basically laborers, rickshaw puller, Maid servant, and factory worker, saleswomen, knitting, tailoring, selling saris and seasonal work like making kite, packing of different items etc. They are migratory in nature and come under our area of preview.

The various diseases like fever, diarrhea, and pain in abdomen, cold cough, and sexual problems are quite common in the area and consider being routine in nature. The people have limited knowledge of the STI/RTI & HIV problems.

The population of the target area mainly comprises of Hindus, Muslims, Sikhs and they are basically from Bihar, U.P., Bengal, Haryana, Punjab, M.P., Nepal and Jammu & Kashmir.

All the colonies in the area are well connected main roads. Shahstri Park and Seelampur is closed to Metro station. As such every community has got its separate boundaries. There are many places for mass gathering.

- Education Program:- Dr. R Chandra Kalyankari Sanstha is Registered with Department of Social Welfare, Govt. of National Capital Territory Delhi under the Rights of Person with Disabilities Act, 2016.
 - Early Intervention Programme:- Organization is provide early intervention programme for children to develop the skills they need to live happy, healthy and successful lives.
 - Organization functions full time from 2 to 4 PM. Our team are
 - 1. Speech Therapist
 - 2. Occupational Therapist
 - 3. Special Educator
 - 4. Counselor
 - 5. Social Worker
 - The Speech Therapist attend the center thrice a week students from the center are taken in group of 4 to 5 to develop communication & vocabulary & Oro-motor exercises are demonstrated to the parents.
 - The Occupational Therapist takes student for therapy & held a session for teachers and demonstrated fine motor activities for finger movements, using clay which can be carried out in the classroom.
 - The Special educator guided parents for activities of daily living program is suggested to the parents as per their individual needs.
 - Full time Counselor is appointed to co-ordinate for this center & they are guided for intervention scheme for disabled & Case history of students is taken & group counseling sessions.
