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MESSAGE FROM DIRECTOR



Thanks to all and would like to take this opportunity, to put in writing, my heartfelt gratitude to all of you for giving us the strength, support, spirit and motivation to overcome all obstacles, improve in our work and achieve goals. While exploring on internet, we understood your organisation and ability to support. Presently, we are able to move on our own and this has paved the way for us to extend a helping hand to those suffering from similar physical disability and trauma like us in supporting them to achieve personal mobility & physical rehabilitation.

I should know. As a person with spinal cord injuries (SCI), I am painfully aware of the life-altering impact of SCI. Fourteen years ago, I, Dilip Patro, a software specialist, founded *The Ability People*, after a near-fatal road crash rendered me paralysed, waist down. *The Ability People* is a Non-Governmental, Not for profit and Disable People's organization for promoting 3Rs i.e. Road safety, Right to emergency care & Rehabilitation of crash victims.

Ability Rehabilitation Center (ARC), a post-hospital rehabilitation center, provides services for active rehabilitation for persons with spinal cord injuries (prime focus) along with other forms of disabling conditions like amputees, post-polio residual paralysis (PPRP), muscular dystrophy, children with cerebral palsy, spina bifida, adults with strokes and other neurological disorders and others.

Realising the tremendous scope for developing a comprehensive center that could cater to the basic rehabilitation needs of the PwD's in the coastal districts, of Andhra Pradesh, India. We strengthened ourselves by the support of some of our friends who in turn uplifted us www.theabilitypeople.com from then nothing was in our diaries except to make suffering lives shine in our sun and take opportunity to change many wrecked destinies who lost their physical ability due to SCI.

The Ability People endeavours to provide rehabilitation, support and resources not only to persons with SCI, to help them regain their independence and realise their potential but also to provides all possible rehabilitation support to PwDs affected with other disabling conditions.

The Ability People mandates to provide free, affordable or heavily subsidized treatment and active rehabilitation for the needy for both community-based and institutional-based rehabilitation for PwDs, CwSN and other orthopaedic conditions including elderly persons.

In 2015, we initiated the Ability Rehabilitation Centre (ARC) to cater to the needs of persons with disabilities in the coastal districts of Andhra Pradesh. The ARC clinical staff, certified by ISPO & RCI, provide services to all persons with mobility disabilities in a bid to empower and rehabilitate them.

In 2019, the organization launched its community-based rehabilitation (CBR) programme in the tribal areas of Andhra Pradesh to respond to the outstanding demand for mobility and assistive devices; prosthetists and orthotists devices; developmental aids; and appliances. The organization also runs education and livelihood opportunity programmes in tribal and remote areas. It aims to promote inclusive development for persons with disabilities. We work closely with key stakeholders of the government's Gram Volunteers, Samagra Shiksha Resource Personnel, Anganwadi Teachers, Urban Community Development officers, Asha workers, PHC nurses, etc.

- Lack of adequate trained personnel to provide rehabilitation services. Situation in the grass root level is more concerning.

- Lack of awareness among communities on disability, rehabilitation and assistive technology leading to significant

gaps in the availability of assistive devices. This is significant in low and middle income countries like India (<https://doi.org/10.1186/s12955-019-1116-y>)



- Quality of the available service are highly compromised and no follow up services available.



- Charity model of service provision is predominant in camp approach and assistive devices mostly not appropriate. The rejection rate of such assistive devices are high, a huge loss of resources.

- Access to employment opportunities, economic independence initiatives are very limited for youth with disabilities.

- Access to education for children with disabilities in less resource settings are not guaranteed fully.

- The front line resources like PHC staff, anganwadi workers, teachers, parents groups, DPOs, SHG members, pws lack capacities to deal with various situations related to disabling conditions leading to secondary complications.

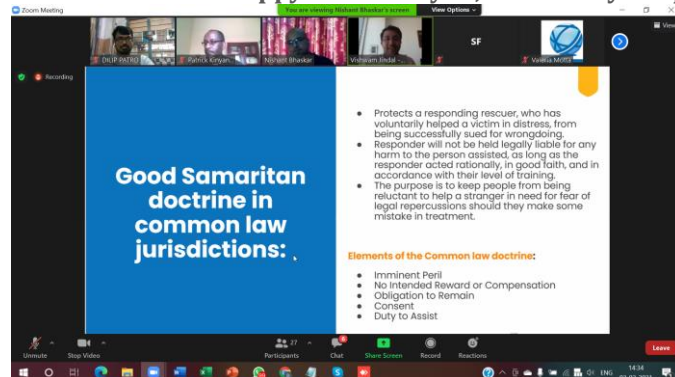

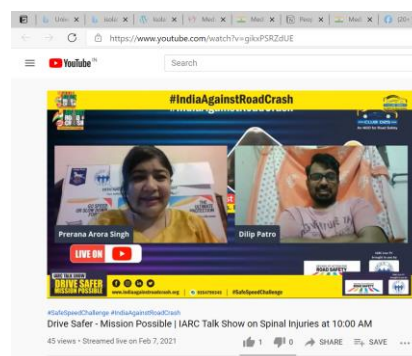

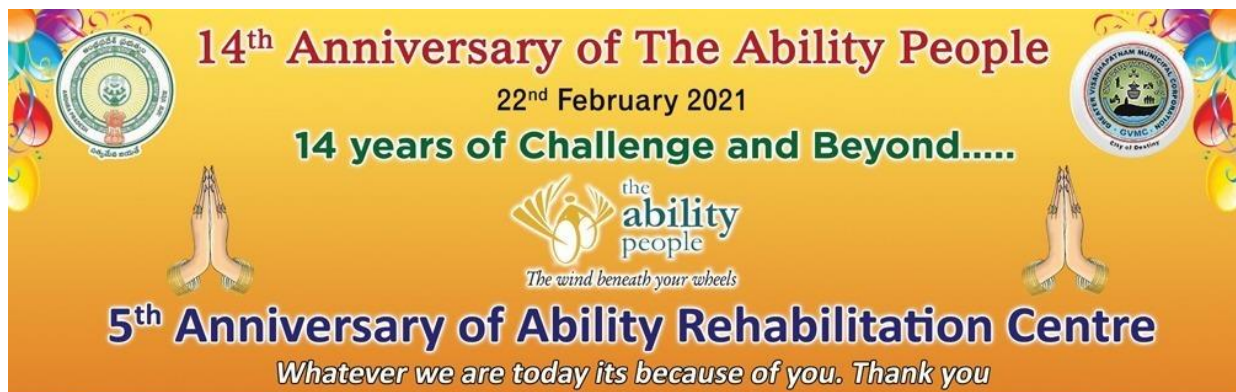

Rehabilitation of these serious injuries can take upto 1 to two years in post hospitalisation & there is lack of comprehensive rehabilitation centre. I myself suffered and due to lack of proper rehabilitation services in A.P, I lost my entire recovery and able to manage with little assistant for my daily living. I lost almost 12 years due to lack of rehab services.

Future Activities: We are also looking for future focus on CSR partners for construction of ARRRRTC. As a personal experience especially SCI, I have bitter experience of not having appropriate facilities in the entire region of Andhra Pradesh.

Ability Rehabilitation Centre with support GVMC, Visakhapatnam, MPLADS FUND & MIBLOU, Switzerland as a pilot project in the year 2015, since we have offered services to 2643 beneficiaries as on date.

Large centres comparable to world class facilities abroad are only 2 in India. ISIC, Indian Spinal Injury Centre by Major. HPS Ahluwalia in New Delhi and CMC Rehab facility in Vellore set up the late Dr. Mary Verghese. Incidentally both with spinal injury. Both the centres beyond reach of the common man, TAP has secured the land for ARRC & is looking for support for construction in phases. Cater to the need from ORISSA, AP & TELANGANA.

From West Bengal to Rameshwaram in the southern province of India the total distance is 2265 kms. If we actually talk of the existence of some facilities or options for rehabilitation nearest to Ability Rehabilitation Centre for Spinal Cord Injury & Traumatic Brain Injury, there are few private & govt. centres.

It could be considered that TAP is the only centre for professional rehabilitation services in the entire region after Indian Spinal Injury Centre, Delhi, SVNIRTAR in Orissa and CMC, Vellore in Tamil Nadu. TAP is strategically located in Vizag city which is well connected and could reach out to either direction. The focus is purely on the individual and his/her impairment. Provision of technology is not client oriented and does not take into consumer's empowerment in terms of social and economic domains.

Present status- TAP has identified the land to build up the RRC over a 10,000 square feet area very close to the national highways.

TAP and Mobility India help the five-year-old realise her dream

The smile on the little girl's face and the sparkle in her eyes when she was able to stand up on her legs said it all. She will no longer have to depend on others to walk. The joy of her parents also knew no bounds. This was made possible by the joint efforts of The Ability People (TAP), Visakhapatnam, and Mobility India, Bengaluru. Saba, the 5-year-old girl of Visakhapatnam, was born without her right leg, hip down. Her father works as a tailor and the family depends on his meagre income. They had no idea that an artificial limb (prosthesis) could give mobility to their child. Mobility India (MI) has been working for a decade with TAP, a Disabled People's Organisation, started by Dilip Patro, who has been rendering yeoman services to the disabled despite his personal experience of disabilities. Saba was brought to the rehabilitation centre to provide her with a hip disarticulation prosthesis. In the COVID-19 situation, under the prevailing

was guided and monitored and several iterations made before Saba was fitted with the trial prosthesis," Mr. Dilip said.

"It was left on the technical expertise and skills of Sankar Ghosh Moudic, clinical Prosthetist and Orthotist, Associate Director, Technical & Quality Systems of MI, to work remotely with the team in Visakhapatnam to complete the process of fabrication. The necessary components were couriered by MI to TAP."

"The entire process of fabrication was demonstrated to the prosthetist over the virtual platform from MI office to the TAP centre. Every stage was guided and monitored and several iterations made before Saba was fitted with trial prostheses. The results encouraged us to take it to the next level of advanced fittings, which required meticulous planning and perfection," he said.

Murthy, a Rotarian, promised to support Saba, for her schooling.

During lockdown, The Ability People continues to work towards reduction of Spine Injuries and provides rehabilitation to those unfortunate who suffer traumatic injuries. We are able to perform various activities undertaken by the ability of people in this difficult period. We couldn't have achieved all this without your overwhelming support and the guidance of our partners & supporters.

In 2020, the organization launched its community-based rehabilitation (CBR) programme in the tribal areas of Andhra Pradesh to respond to the outstanding demand for the need of Rehab aids & therapy services. Fortunately, during the pandemic, it has been a huge opportunity in our efforts to enlarge the scope of our work especially in PR & AT services both on-site & online. Notwithstanding, TAP has been able to find new ways to provide help to the needy through distribution of medical & Hygienic kits to Para and Quadriplegics so that they can meet basic daily hygiene requirements, Nutrition & dry ration kits, door to door delivery of assistive & mobility devices, teleconsulting & tele counselling, online guidance and online awareness workshops. Our Staff at the Centres don full PPE Gear for safety and these are being procured from your donations.

Several charitable organisations have been forced to halt operations or even close down to the pandemic. However, TAP has been blessed with committed and dedicated staff, partners, Volunteers and donors and we have been able to continue with great momentum and build on our activities despite the quarantine period.

Adversity is a way of life for us at The Ability People. Perhaps because our lockdown is more or less permanent, we have easily adapted to the present challenges and continued all our activities and efforts to enable our beneficiaries.

Not only have we survived, the current scenario has provided new avenues for us to thrive, with remote access and digital participation becoming the norm, resolving mobility issues. Also, the pandemic brought focus on the atmosphere of fear, highlighting the tremendous difficulties caused by forced social isolation, exclusion and denial of access. We trust that it will bring people closer together and encourage us to unitedly work for a more open, inclusive society.

For the first time ever, TAP has just completed a dry ration, medical & hygienic kits Drive. We have succeeded in providing the following to those who have been struggling for survival due to dire financial circumstances, with permanent paralysis and pressure sores.

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During our CBR programs, we realised skill development linking with economic independent programmes, Seed Funding for Entrepreneurship, Community Building and Networking & Independent living programme needs. We are in the process of connecting eligible PwDs to other local NGOs to initiate education and livelihood opportunity programmes in tribal and remote areas. It aims to promote inclusive development for persons with disabilities.

We work closely with key stakeholders of the government's Gram Volunteers, Samagra Shiksha Resource Personnel, Anganwadi Teachers, Urban Community Development officers, Asha workers, PHC nurses, etc.

Last year alone, *The Ability People* has touched the lives of persons with disabilities and their families. Impact Numbers:
