It has been observed that during summer vacation for 40 days most of the special children sit idle in their home without any activities which make them dull and their behaviours problems also develop. Looking to their problems our organisation decided to have summer camp for these children for over all development and at the same time they will be active and will learn many new things.

Activities which are planned to be held are :

1. Sensory activities like walking in sand, bricks standing in zero gitti stones, feeling the texture of grass, velvet, woollen clothes etc.
2. Prevocational activities: button stitching, press clothes, cut vegetables, cooking, sweeping, moping, making diyas, Rakhis.
3. Sports activities: dance, music, dram, songs, action songs students were trained.

ENVIRONMENTAL DAY

On Hariyali day 5th July we organised planning day for children. We arranged to take children to garden and told them about the importance of plants in our environment. How we all need fresh air and pure environment for our existence. They enjoyed their ride and played in garden. In our school garden we bought sapling and by modelling we taught them to plant the sapling in pots. Even staff were also planted small plants in pots.

To celebrate this day our aim was to make them understand the importance of free and greenery around us.

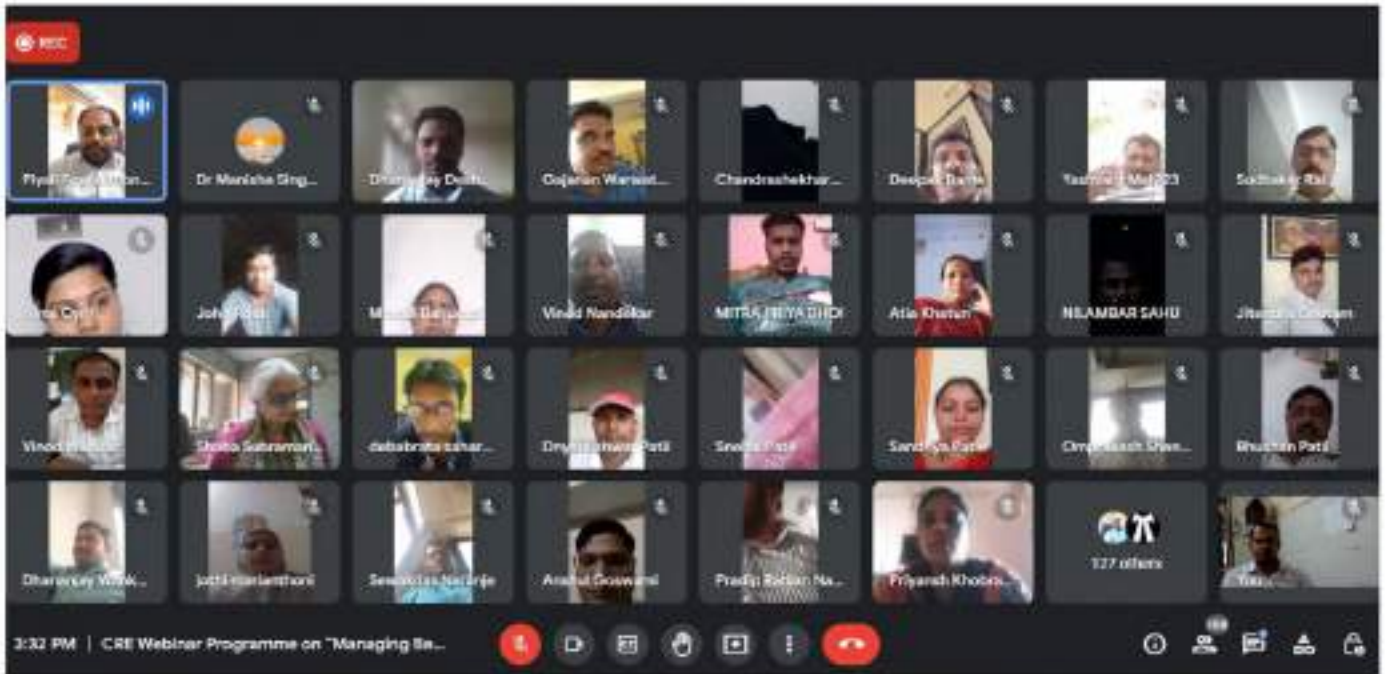


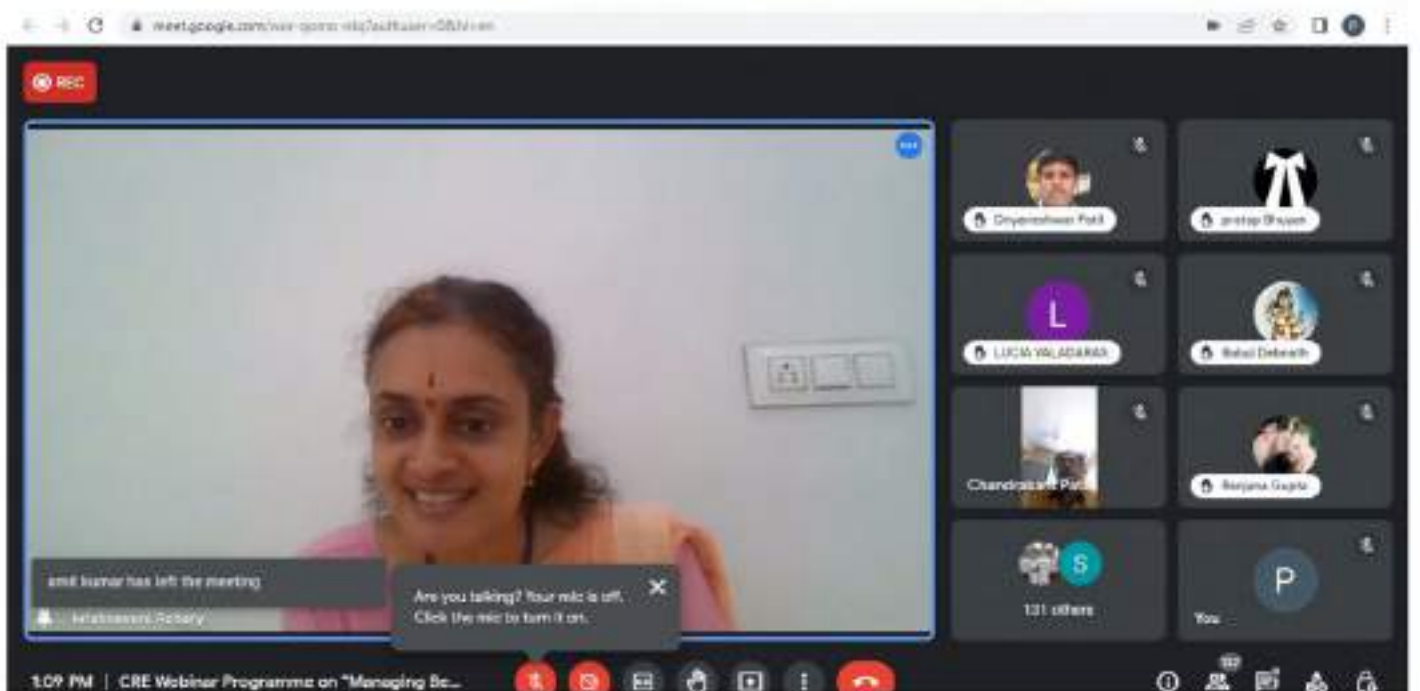
WEBINAR ON Managing Behaviour in classroom and Home''

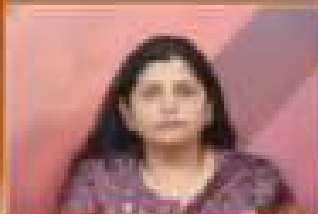
