BY HIS GRACE, Akshya Pratisthan’s school project which began in the slums of Dakshinpur with 40 children, under three tents, has come a long way since its inception in 1987. Extending benefits to children with disabilities in different aspects of day to day life through a holistic approach of inclusive education, medical care, vocational training and co-curricular activities. Today, the school has 350 children and is one of the premier institution in New Delhi, advocating the practice of integrated education.

Ashley Brooke Robbins rightly said, “Chase your dreams, even if you trip”. We provide all students with the most appropriate environment and opportunities by training them so that they can sustain themselves in society with dignity.

The performance of our students in the academic year 2019-20 has been successful in scholastic and co-scholastic areas, though the Annual exam was cancelled due to COVID-19 lockdown.

This year it was proud moment when Akshya Pratisthan students with hearing impairment performed the National Anthem in sign language at the Parliament House in the presence of the President, Vice-President, Prime Minister, and other dignitaries. On the occasion of the 150th Birth centenary of Mahatma Gandhi Akshya Pratisthan School children participated in a Bhajan programme at the Gandhi Smriti in the presence of the Honorable Prime Minister.

Gudiya a child with hearing impairment from class VII, received an award at India International Center for

essay competition in Sign Language, on the occasion of International Day of Sign Language.

Sujal Chandalaya of class VII won a prize for writing an essay on ‘Save the Environment’ which was organized by Indian Center for Plastics.

I am glad to share that in the National Astronomy Science Olympiad (NASO), International Mathematics Olympiad (IMO), National Cyber Olympiad (NCO), and Hindi Olympiad the students made us proud by winning 24 gold, 6 silver, and 6 bronze medals.

Akshya Pratisthan in collaboration ‘Room to Read India Trust’ introduced a Pustakalya where the students till class V are encouraged to read Hindi story books. This novel idea has also been covered by Delhi Doordarshan.

It was an honour when a team from the Chattisgarh Education Department visited our school to get a holistic idea of inclusive education.

I extend warm gratitude to our supporters, volunteers, and Akshya Pratisthan school team who always have been the pillars of our institution. Their positive attitude, hard work, sustained efforts, and innovative ideas encouraged us to walk further to maintain the growth and excellence of this prestigious organization.

THE SCHOOL

The holistic view of Akshya Pratisthan helps to nurture abled and differently-abled children from nursery to class 8 with love, affection, care, and competence without any discrimination. Approximately 350 children from the underprivileged strata of society and children with intellectual challenge, hearing impairment, locomotor impairment, cerebral palsy and multiple disabilities grow together under the same roof.

They are provided with free education, uniforms, books, and midday meals. The transportation facility for the differently-abled children is provided gratuitously. Akshya Pratisthan provides therapeutic and medical care to children with special needs services like medical checkups, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy, and counseling are offered at no cost.

From scholastic to co-curricular, all facets of a child are explored according to their potential for uniform and unique development; and also to make them self-reliant. The current education policy points towards the skill development programs along with scholastic activities. Akshya Pratisthan has been practicing the same for long. Class VI onwards we offer various skill development programs like Beauty Culture, Tailoring, Electrical, Block Printing, etc. Professionals advise the children to pursue skill development programs as per their aptitude. That is how we are different from other regular schools.

Akshya Pratisthan has also study center for NIOS and IGNOU, here we encourage flexible learning. If a child is facing some problems for regular curricular or co-curricular activities, he/she can continue those through distance learning. This increases the radius and opportunities for the learning of an individual.

Akshya Pratisthan is also an RCI-registered center for D.Ed (HI) where professionals are made to serve the HI population. To remain abreast of newer advancement, our professionals regularly attend workshops and conferences. Parent-Teacher meetings are regularly organized to keep parents informed of their ward's progress. Workshops and lectures are also arranged at AP to keep parents updated.

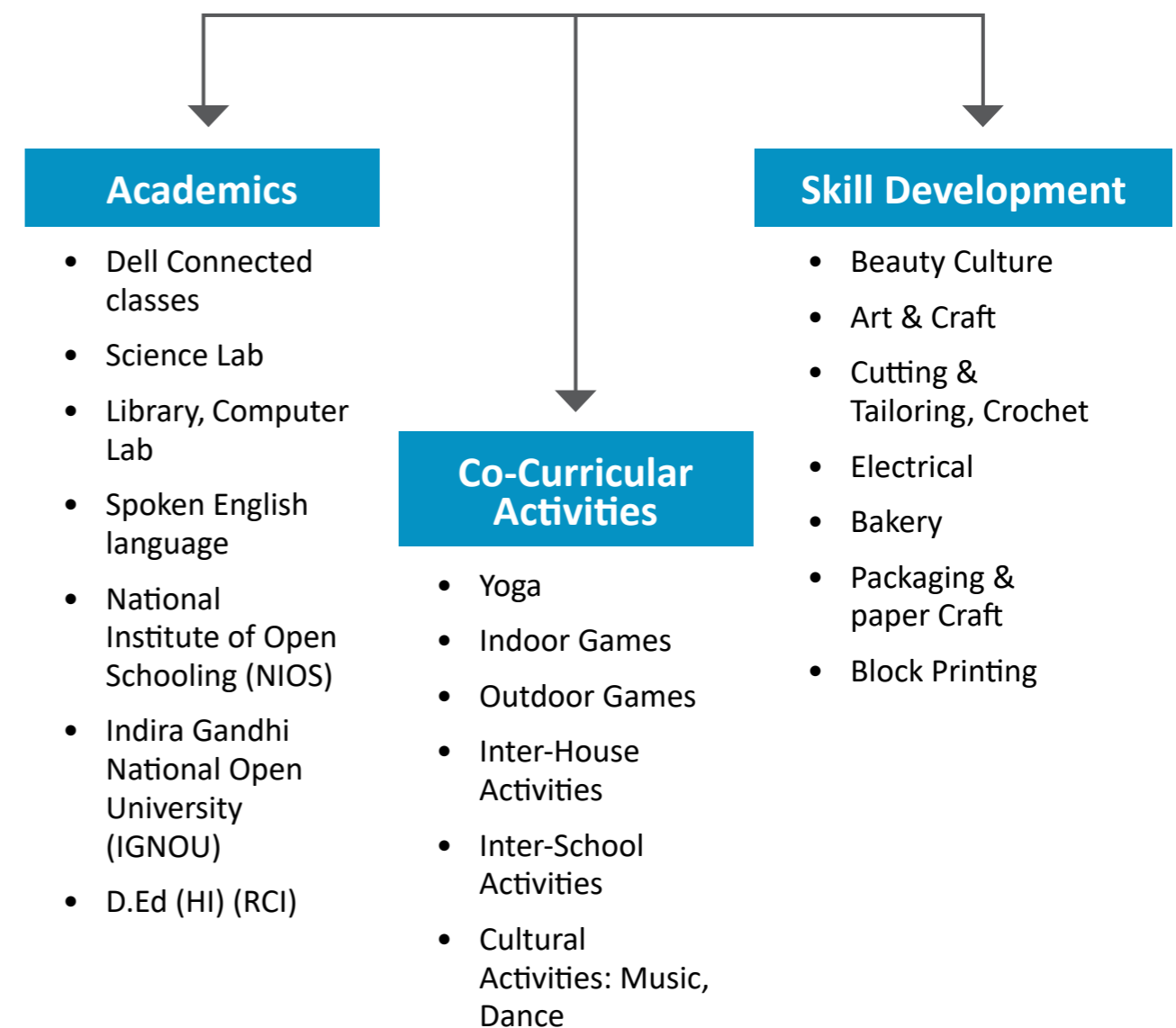

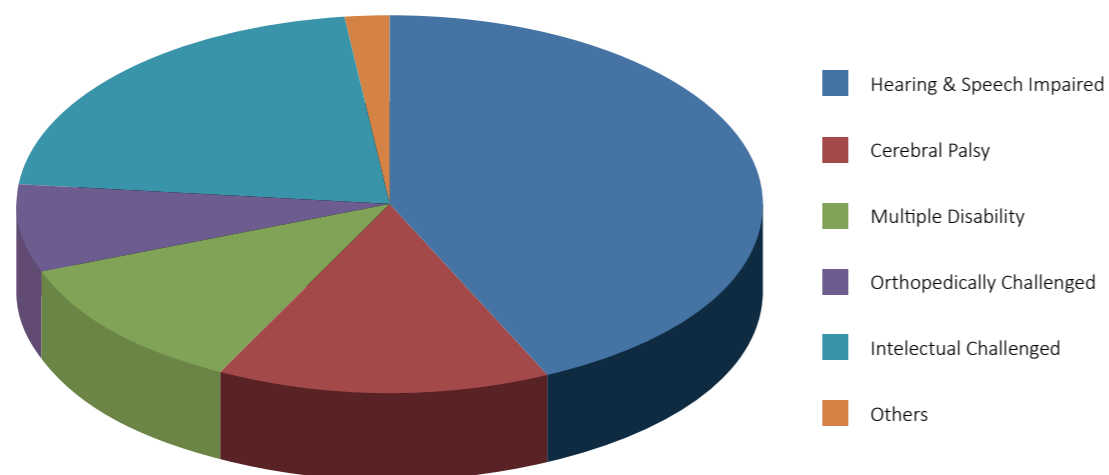

SPEECH THERAPY UNIT

Speech therapy unit aims to help children with hearing impairment, develop their speech and language skills. This department is functioning successfully and the achievement rate is satisfactory.



Success Story

Ankit, a student of class I diagnosed with hearing impairment. He came to Akshya Pratisthan in 2017 when he just had cochlear implant.

After the implant he used to hear various sounds, which he was not used to. So, he was initially made aware of the various sounds in the environment.

Presently, he is able to respond to his name and can speak a few words.

His improvement is very satisfying and the parents are happy too.

PHYSIOTHERAPY UNIT

The Physiotherapy unit of Akshya Pratisthan has the best of infrastructure with latest equipments, well trained and experienced Physiotherapists every year we serve nearly 650-700 patients. Daily 20-25 beneficiaries come for the therapy here and they are provided individual physiotherapy sessions as well as group sessions. The parents of these students are also invited from time to time so that, they can continue to impart therapy at home.

The unit also deals with few out patients as social service and imparts therapy to the children under the early intervention program.

Success Story

Gaurav is a nine year old boy with cerebral Palsy (Spastic). Initially he could not walk due to hypertonic legs. He could not bear weight on legs with and without support, also he could not shift himself from wheel chair to bed and vice-versa.

In Akshya Pratisthan this boy was getting regular Physiotherapy like mat activities, stretching, strengthening protocol of lower limb, balance training, gait training on parallel bars etc. After receiving therapy in Akshya Pratisthan for last two years, Gaurav has shown tremendous improvement. Presently he is under a home based program and regular physiotherapy as well.



OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY DEPARTMENT

The occupational therapy unit of Akshya Pratisthan is one of the key contributors of the rehabilitation team. The professionals of this department do the assessment and intervention needed to develop, recover and maintain the meaningful activities of students with special needs. They help students overcome difficulties and participate in daily living activities. The therapist gives all the support to the child to become a fulfilled individual. After proper therapy, the child is able to perform basic tasks at school or home. He/ She also learn to use assistive devices (if any). Therapists mainly focus on the child's strengths and then design and implement to improve the child's accessibility and ability. They mainly work on achieving selfcare skills or activities of daily livings, including eating, dressing- undressing, mobility etc to make them independent.

CASE STUDY (OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY)

Anuraga 12 year old boy, diagnosed with cerebral palsy. At the time of admission he had difficulties in walking, climbing stairs and co-ordinating hand or shoulder movements. These activities were most essential for day to day living as well as carrying out academic activities similarly he also had difficulties in self feeding, dressing-undressing, speaking etc.

After having regular therapy sessions in this occupational therapy department of Akshya Pratisthan, he has shown remarkable improvement. At present, he is able to walk with proper rhythmic coordination of upper and lower extremities. He can also eat, read and write on his own. His speech has become clear. Possibly all these together made him more confident in social interaction. Now, he interacts with friends and teachers with confidence.



EARLY INTERVENTION (0-6 YEARS): DISHA SCHEME UNDER NATIONAL TRUST

Akshya Pratisthan running Disha Scheme under National Trust since 1st April, 2016. Under this scheme various disabilities like intellectually challenged, cerebral palsy, autism and multiple disabilities are adequately addressed by our efficient rehabilitation team. The supports and services of physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy and counseling are available to the young children with development delays and disability.

We regularly conduct awareness programs and our team of expert identify and provide support to these young children, who are risk of poor outcome. Professionals also make the family member understand the unique needs of the child and how to enhance the child's development.

The results have been extremely encouraging and satisfying, as the effective early intervention helped them tackle and prevent the problems before they worsen. Our early intervention services helped children to learn many key skills to catch up on their basic development.

CASE STUDY (EARLY INTERVENTION)

Nilesh is diagnosed with Autism Spectrum disorder along with some sensory issues. He is a five year old boy with very aggressive behavior. When he joined Akshya Pratisthan he used to bite, spit, scream, run around and hit others. He never used to make any eye contact neither interacted with other children or therapists.

After continuous therapy sessions presently he can sit in a place for some time, makes eye contacts, smiles and shows interest in few activities or group games. He has shown remarkable improvement in emotional stability.

SOCIAL WORK DEPARTMENT

Social work department is an integral part of Akshya Pratisthan which believes in changing lives of students and others who need help. This vital link between the school and community provides support and intervention to all the needy children at the right time, in the right way and with the right result.

The main activities of Social work department includes-

- Individual and group counseling of the students, as well as to the parents.
- To do home visits of students, specially the long absentees.
- To organise camps and awareness programs to find the child with disability from the local areas.

- To give training to those who come to Akshya Praristhan for internship from other colleges and universities and also to offer and supervise their field work.
- To participate in awareness walk.
- To conduct awareness workshop in Akshya Pratisthan.

- This year 23 interns from IGNOU and JamiaMilia were trained here.

Akshya Pratisthan has continued to support NIOS in the endeavor to provide quality vocational training and academic support and flexible learning to those who need a platform to learn. Akshya has also become a nodal center this year among the 24 centers in Delhi. This makes Akshya a center for conduction of examination, administrative tasks and counseling sessions. Akshya continues its work by trying to maximize student participation, evaluating completed course work and helping students prepare for the year end examination. This year 830 students were enrolled in X/XII course and 1438 students appeared in the examination.

The special study centre-0789D of Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) aims to provide higher education to all sections of the society. The centre strives to motivate, co-ordinate and help learners from the neighborhood. The centre provides administrative and academic support to the students. Throughout the year counselling sessions are conducted every Sunday and the students are encouraged to attend these sessions regularly to get a better understanding of the subject and submit Tutor marked Assignments (TMA) on line.

Akshya Pratisthan celebrated Deaf Day in the month of September 2019 with the aim to draw attention of general public, politician and development authorities towards the achievements of the hearing impaired

people as well as to the community at large.

It has also celebrated Disability Week in the month of December with range of activities like games, play, awareness rally in Vasant Kunj and nearby areas.

CRE(Continuous Rehabilitation Education) program was arranged on the topic of Individual Educational Program for three consecutive days from 28th May 2019.

On 11-13 January 2020, another CRE was organised on topic Communication options for children with Hearing impairment.

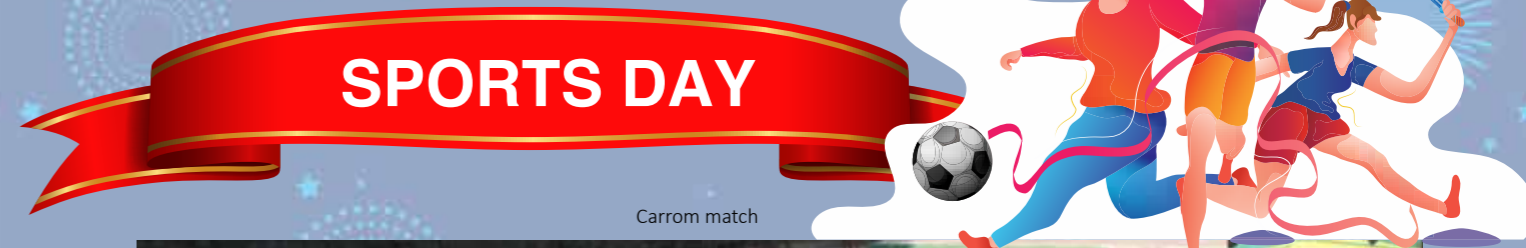
