We request everyone to kindly stay at home and take the necessary precautions. As masks are imperative in this fight of corona virus.


We urge everyone in the slum areas to use masks whenever they step out.

They are guided to the path of spiritualism through educational talks.


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ACADEMIC SESSION (ONLINE): 3rd MAY,2020

Now, they just need to open their devices and sign in at the scheduled time to join the class. This has also improved the attendance of students.





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COST OF EDUCATION IS REDUCED:

All our abled and differently abled students joined hands together, with great zeal to make the event a memorable one also evoking the blessings of the goddess of knowledge to have a successful academic Growth.





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

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SPECIAL PARENT TEACHER MEETING PHYSICALLY AT SCHOOL:






Parents to be physically present at schools for the special parentteacher meeting, it will be very important for every parent to come to school because children are now studying at home instead of studying in school.

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covid-19 lockdown. The competition that aimed to channelise the students' talent and energy amid the lockdown was supervised by Children "Though they have been confined to their homes .






Meanwhile, students of JINGLE BELLS ACADEMY (INCLUSIVE SCHOOL) made awareness posters on the ongoing pandemic.
