#### We have very limited space and services are in different places in the Delhi:

Approx. 2500 sq meter working area in Manovikas HQ Radhey Puri-I Delhi

Approx. 1200 sq meter area in Manolaya Hostel

Approx. 6000 sq meter area in Manvik-LBIIHM (free)

Approx. 150 sq meter area in Saath-Saath QoL project

For all above places we are paying rent of Rs.36 lakhs i.e. about USD\$47K per year

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

### SAVE Manovikas we are in Funding Crisis for:

#### RENT

Rs.15.5 Lakhs/USD\$20K are due in last 5 months

### SERVICE

Manovikas is paying educational, medical, residential care and other expenses of about 100 students with special needs will stop their rehabilitation, education and last twenty years efforts of Manovikas will crash.

#### **SALARY**

Teachers, and staff, are hoping for salary total Rs.38.2 Lakhs/USD\$40K in 4 months

#### **SEWA**

This biggest loss we can see for those 40 severely and profoundly disabled persons who recovered and living in the community through the quality of life and now they will be back on the street.
