OBJECTIVE AND HISTORY OF BAL BHAVAN:

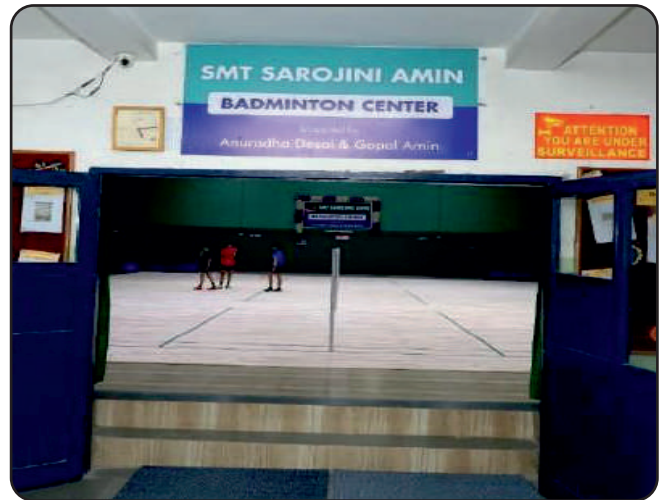
