

INTRODUCTION

The Congregation of the SISTERS OF CHARITY OF JESUS & MARY (SCJM), a religious organization founded by Rev. Fr. Peter Joseph Triest in Belgium in the year 1803 and established in Dalhousie (H.P.) in 1901 is commissioned to reveal that God is love. The sisters value the ministry of education, of helping individuals to discover their dignity as human persons and children of God and of bringing about a society based on love, justice and peace, to be an important expression of their mission.

Special Education for the Mentally Challenged children occupies a unique place in the larger vision and mission of the congregation. Following the footsteps of their founder, Fr. Triest, who had a special concern for the mentally challenged children of his time, the SCJMs continue to respond to the needs of the mentally challenged and multiple handicapped children with a total commitment and devotion.

Prem Ashram is a model school for children with mental retardation and multiple disabilities with residential facilities, situated in the district town of Una, Himachal Pradesh. It was started in the year 1971on a 2.5 acre leased land given by Baba Sahib Singh Bedi, a renowned religious leader of the time, the 11th descendent of Guru Nanak.

The sisters began the work with a lone child, who was the grandson of the donor of the land. In the year 1973 another building was erected with the help of MEMISA of Holland to cater for more children. Later on, with the help of many donors and financial assistance from the Generalate, we were able to put up the present building. With this setup, we are able to respond to more children.

Aims and Objectives:

- To enable and empower mentally challenged children to live as independently and fully as possible.
- Empowerment of parents of children with disability. Work in the community for awareness, screening, identification and prevention of disabilities.
- To facilitate rehabilitation of such children through education, training and counseling.
- To develop the intellectual, motor and sensory facilities of the special child, as for as possible, and thus enabling them to interact with other children and adults.
- Outreach programmes through Home Based Training.
- Human resources development.
- To provide early intervention services for children with developmental delay.
- To provide vocational training.

Human Resource Development: -

A 2-years Diploma in Special Education (Mental Retardation) is being run since August 2005. It is affiliated to NIEPMD and is recognized by Rehabilitation Council of India. The exams are conducted by NIEPMD. Good number of students have passed out from this institute belonging to H.P., Punjab, Haryana, U.P. 95 % of the them are well placed and earning good salary.

<u> Staff: -</u>

The most valuable resource that any school can have been its staff. The school collectively has an enthusiastic and dedicated team of 18 Teachers in the Pre-Primary, Primary, Secondary, Pre-Vocational, Vocational sections. Therapists and in addition, we have Non-Teaching and Support staff. Their coordination with each other is what enables the school to function smoothly and grow with new perspectives.

Academic Activities

Academic activities and classes have started after the Pandemic. Different activities are conducted at classroom level, school level. School was reopened on 1st feb.2020. To begin again it took lot of time because children had forgotten everything even though they were having online classes.

On 12th December 2021 Prem ashram conducted the exam for the children and everyone was made to sit the hall. Children followed the rules and the regulations of the exam and did well according to their ability.

Achievements

Naman Prit Singh our student is good at in studies. After long years of teaching and training in Prem Ashram we have taken the admission in Mount Shivalik Public School. It is an English medium school. And he is doing well in his academic activities. He stood first in the 3rd std. At present he is in 4th Std. Proud moment for the parents of Naman Prit Singh and Prem Ashram staff.

Parents' and Teachers' Association:

After the lockdown we have started our normal schedule. The General Body Meeting of parents is held on a regular basis and new members of the PTA were nominated for the year 2021. Since then, PTA meetings have been arranged periodically, the PTA members of our school are closely involved in most academic activities. Achievements
