We are a charitable trust started by a group of friends in July 2010 rendering free services to children suffering from Autism/Mental retardant/Cerebral Palsy/Landau Kleffner Syndrome and Delayed Development coming from very poor families.

Ours institution is registered under the trust act with the Sub Registrar Mysore (South) vide Document No. 273 dated 24.10.2009, National Trust Act vide registration No.KAAS16511999727, 290918221988043/MR/CP/AUTISM MD dated 21.07.2016 Department of Women & Child Development, Government of Karnataka, Mysore District vide registration Certification No.DDMy/DDW/03/2019-20/169 dated 23.07.2019 and granted Income Tax Exemption under section 12A.R.W section 12AA (1) (b) (i) of the Income Tax Act-1961 vide order F.NO.A-109/80G /CIT/MYS/2010-11.

The institution was set up at a rented premise at #22 KEB colony 5th Cross mahadevapura road udayagiri Mysuru-570019 and has now been shifted to #520 Old mahadevapura extension, udayagiri 2nd stage Mysuru-570017, as the area is close to children coming from poor economic backgrounds.

At the institute the required training is provided by qualified teachers along with Speech therapy and physiotherapy .All other medical facilitates are also provided.

All services at the institute are provided as per the advice and guidance from All India Institute of Speech and Hearing and are completely <u>FREE OF CHARGE</u>.

The institution is being financed by Philanthropists, well-wishers, friends and relatives.

Currently the institute is being run at a rented residential premise and we find that it is not adequate to accommodate the present **35** children who are being provided the facilities at the institute.
