Association of Parents of the Retarded (APR), as denoted by the name, was an association formed by a group of parents of persons with mental retardation, autism, multiple disabilities etc.,

Registered under the Travancore Kochin Literacy and Charitable Societies Act, the association has been operating at Venjaramoodu in Thiruvananthapuram. At present, there are 47 members who are actively involved in running the institution.



The objectives include the rehabilitation of individuals with mental retardation, autism, multiple disabilities etc., and the conduct of social awareness programs on these issues.



Aasraya, owned by the Association, is a rehabilitation center with all the resources that are necessary to provide lifelong care to persons with the abovementioned disabilities and also a school for day-time activities. The school functions everyday from 9.30 am to 4 pm from Monday to Saturday. All entertainment activities such as indoor sports, musical program etc., are held on every Sunday.



AASRAYA: a unique dwelling park for the intellectually challenged persons, is located at APR Nagar, Aliyadu village in the midst of its serene greenery and calmness. It is 10 minutes (drive) away from Venjaramoodu town in Thiruvanathpuram District.

Aasraya, a life-long rehabilitation center for the mentally challenged persons functioning under the direct control of Association of Parents of the Retarded, is located at Venjaramoodu, Thiruvananthapuram. The center takes care of persons above 18 years of age with multiple disorder, mental retardation, autism etc., for their entire life and is open throughout the year.



The inmates are from different parts of Kerala and other states as well. During the year 2022-23, the total inmates in Aasraya is 35. Thiruvananthapuram Govt. dental medical college conduct medical camp for inamtes. Pirappancode higher secondary school NSS unit conduct one day interactive session with our inmates.


