### **RAKSHA SOCIETY FOR THE CARE OF CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS**

#### **Report April 2020 – 2021 based on the Online activities conducted**

Raksha Society runs a Special School, Vocational Training and Rehabilitation Centre and an Institute, serving special need persons in the community, for the last 35 years.

Raksha Special and Vocational Training Centre remained closed since 10<sup>th</sup> March 2020 in the wake of Covid 19 Pandemic, as per Government instructions.

While foreseeing the gravity of the situation, Raksha convened a parents meeting just before the school closed, on 4<sup>th</sup> of March 2020, largely to spread awareness on the pandemic that was spreading swiftly across the globe. Our medical consultant (Pediatrician) Dr. Jayanthi Menon, conducted awareness class for the parents, on managing special children in the wake of Covid 19 pandemic based on WHO guidelines. (Presented the official awareness video by WHO) The importance of keeping hygiene especially hand washing was demonstrated by the help of the video clipping.

Though we have declared holidays for the students on March 10, 2019, the teachers were reporting for work till the Government officially declared lockdown for the whole state. A general instructions were given to the teachers to closely follow up the health of the children during the lockdown. Soon some of our staff were making masks and freely supporting their neighbors, some were actively involved in Community Kitchens in Town hall, Fort Kochi. Tele counseling for our kids and their families were carried out by our teachers unfailingly.

During the month of April teachers called each child once/twice a week and enquired about their training and their activities at home. Parents of two children conveyed their difficulty in procuring medicine for their children. We managed to arrange medicines for two months and delivered to their home. Meanwhile, as many of our children's family located in coastal area, and belonged to BPL group, Society was felt the need to support them with food supplies, Complying to the Government rules and regulations, we managed to provide food supplies to the needy families throughout the difficult periods, since April 2020 to April 2021.

By May, as the lock down was extended and the number of cases was on the rise, possibility of reopening Vocatioonal Unit seemed a distant reality. We then sought to alternate methods of connecting with our children. Teachers identified videos in YouTube which were useful for the children and started sending it to the parents for the children to view. Our survey to find out the accessibility to a smart phone or computer at home showed a few children had access to it at home in the initial days. We then encouraged them to use it as a medium for this period and they this was taken in its true spirit .

By mid week of June a viable method was introduced to streamline the classes to all children in different projects under the organization. Separate whatsapp group was formed for parents in Early Intervention, Special School, Vocational Training Centre and Day home.

### **Training Groups**

We have divided the 82 students above 18 years of age into 4 groups to make easier for the teachers to send the training material and to keep in touch with the students through online or by telephone.

Group 1 – These students were just above 18 years and got admission in the year 2020.

Group 2 - The students in this group came under moderate and severe physical or mental difficulty under the age of 21 years

Group 3 – The students who are already under going the vocational training

Group 4 – Students with moderate and sever physical and mental difficulties above the age of 21 years

## **Documentation**

The classes were given either as a video or activity description to the parents through whatsapp. Along with the Curricular videos, co-curricular videos are also prepared by the respective instructors. Videos were prepared by the Music, Yoga and Art teacher. These were also sent to the students. The parents send back the videos of students performing each goal back to the teacher.

Based on the activity given teachers wrote individual reports about each child. Besides the teacher called each student twice, every week and found out the status of the children. This was also recorded in the report.

Since no single app or programme is not fully satisfying the diverse needs of the children, our training is a combination of teachers videos made in our organization, Victors Channel, Thaenkode and also by selecting You Tube videos apt for each child's need.

Besides the Special Education inputs, training was also given in enhancing speech. Exercises were shown to the parents through video sessions. Exercises were explained and parents were encouraged to record the video of sessions at home for further guidance. The Physiotherapist has taken special interest to demonstrate the physical exercises to parents of children, especially those attending the early intervention.

## **Curriculum Training**

The training was mostly concentrated on Life Skills. Based on our observations of the students performance in the training unit, we have decided to give more Life skill training through online. Besides the life skills, activities which will enhance the fine motor skills was also planned. roup

### **A. Activities under Basic Academics:**

- Functional reading
- Simple arithmetic
- Basic money exchange

All the teaching method under this skills was presented in relation to daily activities, like naming and counting vegetables, reading own address, names of places, etc

### **B. Activities under Life Skills:**

- Folding clothes,
- Cleaning work spaces
- Washing own clothes

- Making bed
- Basic potting mixture, potting and sowing seeds. Students posted pictures of the plants they have grown in the group.
- Basic steps in making microgreens

### **C. Activities under fine motor skills:**

We have observed students have difficulty in doing vocational skills that require fine motor skills. To minimize the the difficulties we have introduced activities which required rolling paper, pasting, cutting, glueing etc.

- Simple home decors like wall hanging, weaving paper baskets
- Bottle art
- Making greeting cards
- Different craft works

### **D. Activities under skill training:**

- Simple stitches
- Button holes
- Simple embroidery
- Sandpapering furniture
- Making simple dishes and healthy drinks (sandwich, different juices, making aal dosa, rasam etc). Children were encouraged to make dishes of their own choice. Few students have made complete meals.
- Training in MS Word and Excel few students
- Paper bag
- Raksha has organized an awareness video for student above 18 years regarding the Voting Rights and Method of voting before the Local elections. Participants from many schools participated along with our students. The Resource Person Mr. Joseph Antony Hurtis explained the voting methods clearly with the help of videos.

### **Courses conducted under Jan Shikshan Sansthan**

Raksha Vocational Students attended training curriculum developed by JANSHIKSHAN SANSAN, Ministry skill development and Entrepreneurship, Government Of India.

- Assistant Carpenter – Wooden Furniture
- Paper Bag Making and Paper Mache

20 students were enrolled in both the courses. The courses were of 6 months duration. After the course written examination, practical and viva was conducted under the supervision of JSS officials.

### **Other Activities related to Vocational Training**

Besides the training, we were also able to carry out paper bag orders to different establishments mainly hotels.

Raksha Bakery unit received orders for Plum and Marble cakes, and some with extended to 10 kg cakes, every week to cater to some corporate houses. Raksha bakery unit has been supplying bakes, every week for corporate houses. We supply Raksha bakes as ‘*Gift with a cause*’, thus our bakery could be a revenue stream.

After the complete lock down procedures we involved some students in the paper bag unit. We home delivered the raw materials and the finished product was taken back for delivering.

**‘QUILT INDIA Sammaan Project’**- Raksha Tailoring Unit has been stitching Mommy kits for poor babies of war torn places in Syria and Yemen, made of unsold stock of Handloom weavers of Chennamangalam, under the banner of, ‘QUILT INDIA- SAMMAN’ a Lakshmi Menon ( Chekkutty Pava fame) initiative.

Tele counseling sessions include training in enhancing self-confidence, self-esteem and social skills training. Each child gets this training at least once in two weeks. Furthermore, we are providing guidance to more than 300 beneficiaries who apply for guardianship and Niraamaya under the National Trust Act through the Local Level Committee. Raksha is the present NGO member, in the Local Level Committee of Ernakulam district.

## **Entertainment Activities**

One aspect all the parents reported, when contacted, is that of the difficulties children face when they are restricted to home without any entertainments. As we pondered on how to introduce some activities, an NGO based in UK invited us to be a part of schools in Kochi for a Zoomatic Circus programme. This programme was organized in UK with the help of few circus professionals. They performed some acts and aired it through Zoom platform. The students immensely enjoyed the programme.

We also conducted an online Onam programme involving all the children in the different projects. Dance, song and performance videos were made based on themes and is collaged together and presented in the Zoom platform.

Children have send heartwarming messages and videos on Teachers Day.

Raksha children diligently took part in '*Marivil 2020*', *all Kerala Special School virtual Kalolsavam*, organized by Special School Employees Union and Humanity Charitable Trust , from 25<sup>th</sup> October 2020 and culminated on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2020, inaugurated by Shri V.S. Sunil Kumar, Hon. Minister for Agriculture ,Government of Kerala. Raksha children won 2 prizes in state level competition viz Muhammad HashimShereef K S, won third prize in Junior boy's Light Music, and Mary Jiya , third in Senior Girls Light Music. Besides our students participated in competitions under Chilamboli,Mohammed Hashim won first prize I at the district level competition for Light Music and Mary Archana Second prize in Elocution under Chilamboli.

Christmas and New Year celebrations were made colorful and entertaining by involving the children in different activities based on different themes. Making of seasons card making, Santa clauses in cute dresses, Christmas theme Fancy dress made the videos lively and we were amazed at the enthusiasm children shown to get dressed and recorded.

## **Distribution of Food Kit**

Our constant survey has shown that there were families who had financial difficulties related to lockdown and subsequent restrictions imposed in different areas. Especially single mothers had to face lot of hardships during this time. This led us to look for sponsorships for food kits which could be distributed to identified needy families. Lot of people came forward to sponsor kits, and especially remember Ms.RuksanaThacharakkal, from Thalaseery ,who enthusiastically helped us to acquire food kits since April 2020 tillApril 2021, to our most affected families. Herself a person afflicted with cerebral palsy she found out people who was very much willing to

participate in this drive, to ensure that all the festivals throughout this year, is never a period of pain.

### **Administration**

Raksha Managing Committee stayed connected and met through virtual platforms to steer the various programs of the society. The Annual General Body meeting was conducted 30th September 2020, via video conferencing. Government Inspections were also conducted towards receiving Grant in aid from Government agencies. Furthermore, we are providing guidance to more than 300 beneficiaries who apply for Guardianship and Niraamaya under the National Trust Act through Local Level Committee of Ernakulum district. Raksha resumed our office with 30% staff initially, as per Government instruction in May, then to 50% strength, twice/thrice a week, accordingly, towards accomplishing administrative work and online teaching.

Though the pandemic has thrown almost everything into a callous domicile, especially in disability sector, we have strived our best to face the challenge with courage, and deem that we have succeeded in a modest way, we look forward to the government for more concrete support, in this segment.

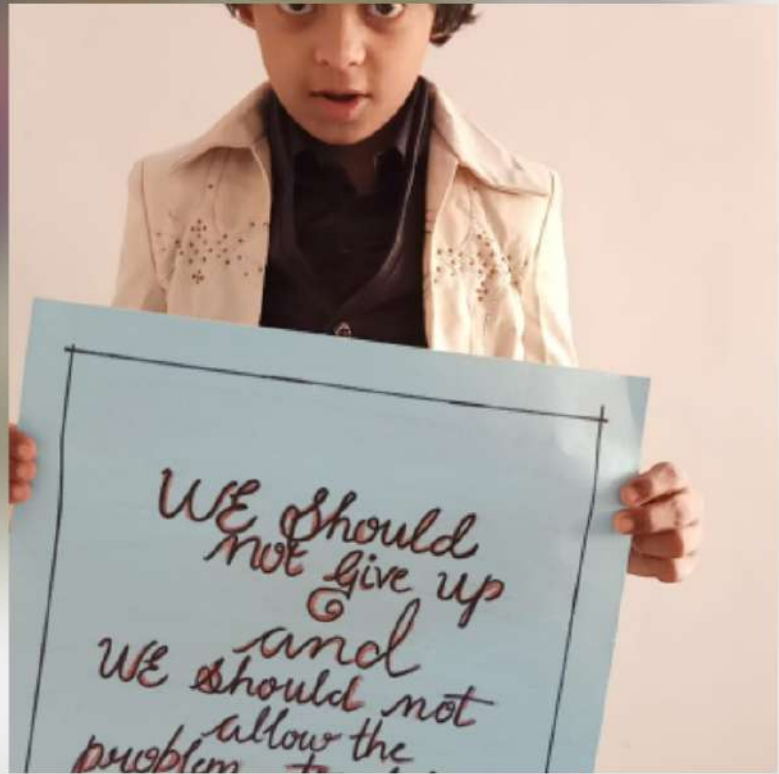
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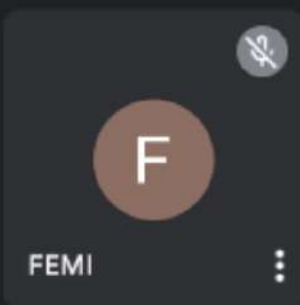
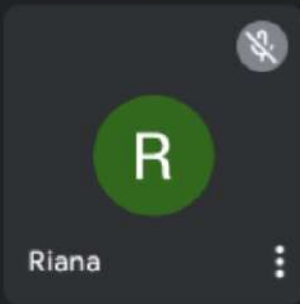
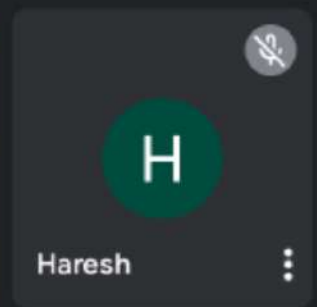
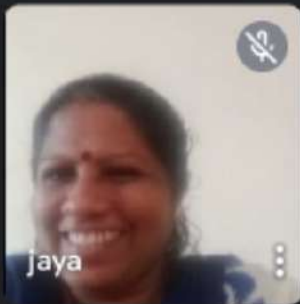
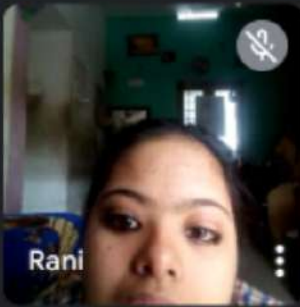


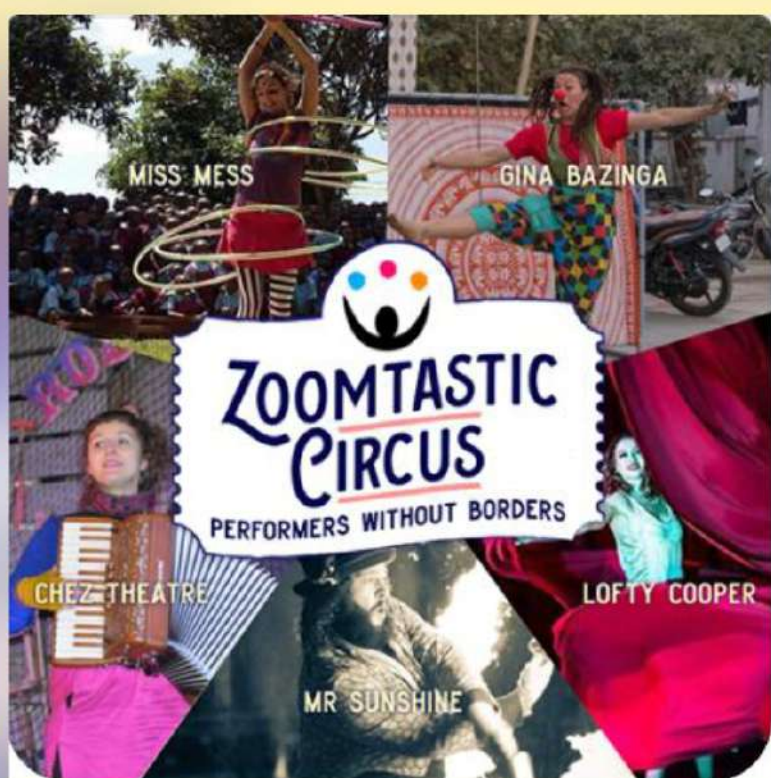
