Activities showing involvement with the four disabilities covering under the National Trust

Shri.B.D.Tatti(A) Memorial Charitable Trst-Laxmeshwar started Community Based Rehabilitation program from 2007 . Under the CBR program BDT identified 9000 disables from 0 to death in mundaragi taluka and Shirahatti Taluka,Gadag,Mundragi. In 2013 BDT started Early Intervention and Inclusive Education Program for disabilities like Cerebral Palsy, Multiple Disability, Mental Retardation, Autism, Locomoter Disabilities, Low vision and Hearing Impaired children . BDT has Rehabilitation Center in the Campus . We have physio and speech therapy center at Mundaragi, Hebbal,Laxmeshwar, Bellatti, Shirahatti and Suranag,Gadag,Mulgund,Koganur,Balehosur. We are providing therapy services to all disables according to therapy center.

BDT identified children with Disables by screening in Anganawadi centers, Primary Health Center and under Polio Program . After that therapist will assess them and suggest them to therapy, surgery and appliance according to disability. We are providing nutrition food for malnutrition disable children to avoid secondary problem of disability. BDT conducted programs and trainings to ASHA, Anganawadi teachers, SSA teachers and CWD's parents regarding screening, importance of physio therapy, speech therapy, importance of appliance and

wheelchair etc. Till today BDT distributed Aids and Appliances to the disables.

Under Inclusive Education program BDT organized 10 days education camp for school going children with disables to motivate and support them for mainstream education. We are conducting awareness program like rally, peer group and children club for school going children.

PART 1

About Us:

Established in 1994, Shri B D Tatti (Annnavaru) Memorial Charitable Trust works for the welfare and development of persons with disabilities in Karnataka. The founders of the Trust began its work by working for children with speech and hearing impairment. Over the years, the Trust rapidly expanded its work and has reached out to about 9000 persons with disabilities, including children, youth and adults in 11 Districts of Karnataka till date.

Objectives:

- To ensure early identification of children with disability, assess their needs, and accordingly facilitate the process to provide them with the relevant service.
- To prepare children with disability to mainstream in regular Educational Institutions.
- To identify youth and adults with disability, and assess their needs.
- To support youth with disability to pursue higher education, facilitate or provide vocational training, and income generation opportunities through placement or self-employment.
- To provide appropriate mobility aids and appliances to the needy
- To promote and establish networks to assist persons with disability at the family, institution and community level.
- To provide therapy services (physio and speech) to persons with disability
- To create a technology friendly environment to the disabled community

PART 2

Institutional Based Programmes

A. 1. Sushravya Pre-Primary School for Deaf(Mother Care Center)

Started in 2007-08 -the only center in North Karnataka to provide oral deaf language training to hearing impaired children and their mothers. Children with hearing impairment, who are as young as six months to five years old, are enrolled in the school along with their mothers.

Children with hearing impaired and their mothers learn the basics of oral deaf language and begin to communicate with each other in batches from three years. The mothers often interact with the children of other women as it not only expands the scope of communication but also improves the overall morale and confidence. The capacities of the mothers as resource persons also get developed in the process.

Apart from this, the children and mothers have opportunities for orientation & exposure to various to places like offices, shops, local events, fairs, functions, and scenic places. This helps them to develop observation power and enriches the understanding in the children about daily life. During this year, the children visited a vessels shop, a tailor shop, and a grocery store. They also visited places of worship of different religions such as Dargahs, Churches and Temples. A visit to the local bakery was of great interest. They were also explained about the construction of a road in the city.

Such exposure visits enthuse the children, and instills a positive energy and confidence in both mother and children.



A. 2. Shri B D Tatti Residential School for Children with Hearing Impairment

The B D Tatti Residential School for Children with Hearing Impairment provides education from 1st Standard to 10th Standard, and teaches all the subjects. The school is affiliated to Department of Women and Child Welfare, Government of Karnataka. The teachers' training skills are upgraded regularly to improve the teaching methodologies to children with speech and hearing impairment. The school follows the Nali Kali method of teaching which is appropriate to teach students, especially those with Hearing Impairment at an early age which was introduced.



Academics:

164 students with hearing impairment studied in BDT Residential School for the academic year 2019-20. 17 students appeared for the SSLC finals exams and secured 88.23 % results. The student who scored the highest got 77.18% marks.



Sports:

The children are regularly participating in yoga and various sports in the campus. At the crack of the dawn, children play and practice running on the large field. They also do 'Yoga' & an intense but quick practice session on the Mallakamba ensures that the expertise of the children is developed day after day. The positive impact of play, sports and yoga is evident as the children are now less immune to illness, have a healthy appetite, and have healthy growth indicators. Mallakamba helps to build confidence, courage and skill enhancement among children. Mallakhamba, also known as pole gymnastics, is a traditional Indian sport in which a gymnast performs feats and poses with a vertical wooden pole or rope. Mallakhamba derives from the terms 'Malla' which means a wrestler and 'Kamba' means pole.



PART 3

Community based Rehabilitation Program (CBR)

Introduction:

Shri B D Tatti (Annvaru) Memorial Charitable Trust implementing its community based rehabilitation programs in Shirahatti Taluk, Mundargi Taluk and Laxmeshwar Taluk, Mulgund Taluk and Gadag Taluk of Gadag District

The need for timely identification of persons with disabilities, providing them with the range of services required and expanding the reach of service to direct and indirect beneficiaries.. These programmes provided the scope to involve and engage with various stakeholders, care givers, Government Departments and NGOs in the service of persons with disabilities.

- Early Intervention and Early Education • Livelihood

Key programmes:

Early Intervention and Early Education Program

Shri B D Tatti strengthened the Early Intervention and Early Education Programme in Laxmeshwar with the support of APPI (Azim Premji Philanthropic Initiatives) in April 2016 which was facilitated by APD, organized capacity building program to all the project staff along with the field follow support work . Covering 92 villages in Shirahatti Taluka, this is a 5 years project reaching out to 300 children end of 2020.

Goal: “To strengthen the ecosystem for PWD and relevant stake holders as resource support for the organization”

Key Milestone for this year.

- 5 Sub centres has been established.
- SPG-Model children identification at Mulagunda. Assessment.
- 260 stake holder (Asha, Aganwadi, Parents, VRW, MRW, RBSK) training has been done in the Early Intervention and Early Education
- Sensitization program for SPG Model.
- 2 Surgery done for CWD's.
- Medical diagnosis and treatment giving with the support of government.
- Gadag EI centre has been Established

Success Stories :

Muttu C Lamani At- Suvarnagiri Post:-
Suranagi Tq-Shirahatti District Gadag

The child enrolled to BDT at the age of 5 years & was diagnosed with Developmental Delay. One of BDT staff had identified him during the home visit and assessed. he was completely dependent on others for all his needs. He was not able to sit and stand properly. It was observed that he had no social skills, self-care, attention and interest in her activities. As per the plan & guidance, BDT staff visited weekly twice to provide service at his home. The child fitted with appliances provided by BDT. Now he is able to use Standing frame, B/L Gaiters and B/L AFO's with MAS and has developed the activities like feeding, toileting, playing with other children, identifying the parts of body, identifying family members, friends etc and started socializing with others. Play- Imitates and copies people, Intelligence and Learning- Copies simple actions. Now parents are putting efforts to improve his communication skill. His parents are so happy with his developmental stages and becoming less dependency in his daily activities



Livelihood

Livelihood program is for the adults with the age of 18+ & the program is supported by Enable India, Bangalore. It is a centre where we connect with companies and the differently able people to create opportunities for livelihood. Where we provide skills to differently able people and place them job to the companies. It is a pilot project where BDT needs to learn and experiment more in this space. SWASHAKTI aims at providing rural livelihoods for Persons with Disability (PwDs) in the state of Karnataka. This campaign fosters ownership and collaboration among disability NGOs and other stakeholders working at a grass-root level promoting further collaborations to ensure growth and sustainability. The district saturation model helps to deepen the work in reaching out to people with different disabilities in that region based on the results in this and the next year. The finalized model can be future ready to replicate to other regions in the state/country. This year, the program will continue with awareness and outreach activities and introduce livelihood programs like Government Job Training and EDP training. Awareness workshops and Committee meetings: This involves sourcing of participants (avg of 30 people), coordinating and finalizing a date and location, making logistical arrangements - food and AV systems, file a report after the event, and any post event coordination/follow-up. Approx. duration - 7 to 10 days Govt. Job and EDP Trainings and Follow-up: Starts with sourcing for initial screening workshop, followed by finalizing the source for training program, coordinate and identify accessible location for training and boarding/lodging, finalize training dates, be involved during the training (10 days of EDP, 45 days of Govt. Job training), ensure all risks/problems during training are resolved, and ongoing post training follow-up. Approx. duration - 4 to 6 months.
