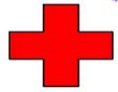

Physiotherapy Treatments for Children with CP /Autism

Indian Red Cross Society runs program the developmental delays could possibly affect the children's gross and fine motor skills. The goals of physiotherapy to gather information from parents, clinical physicians and other multi-disciplinary team members. The role of the physiotherapist is to take care of autistic children with motor impairments in the body (for instance; issues with respiratory control and coordination level, improvement in posture, and addressing misalignment in the musculoskeletal system including chest wall deformities as well as foot and ankle misalignment issues.

Normally, the assessments and treatments can take place in various settings (for examples: home, day care, community centers, clinics, hospitals, rehabilitation centers and fitness centers.) Physiotherapists are also involve with rehabilitation after injuries where a child maybe injured from a fractured leg and required rehabilitation treatments. However, the physiotherapists must take the diagnosis of autism into consideration when designing treatments sessions. This is due to the fact that many of the physiotherapy sessions are very structured in nature. Teaching them to be comfortable and competent in their bodies is an essential part of the treatment.



Special Education Services



In the Indian Red Cross Society Children with autism have behavioral problems, hyperactivity, their sitting tolerance is affected, speech deficits and repetitive behavioral issues. All these problems affect their learning, understanding, perception and comprehension. Not all children with

autism have mental retardation or learning disability but many a times their autistic traits hinder learning.

Hence it is very important that to cater to their special needs they undergo special education. Children over the age of three receive assistance through school-based programs. As with early intervention, special education services



are tailored to your child's individual needs. Children with autism spectrum disorders are often placed with other developmentally-delayed kids in small groups where they can receive more individual attention and specialized instruction. However, depending on their abilities, they may also spend at least part of the school day in a regular classroom. The goal is to place kids in the least restrictive environment possible where they are still able to learn.
