Main work area of the organization is the field of disability in entire Madhya Pradesh. The work area of the institution is in the entire Bhopal and Raisen district and the institution MR. MD. CP. And Autism Along with working at the Gharounda Kendra for MR. The operation of this is also going on. From time to time, the organization organizes awareness camps, awareness programs, to make the society aware of the disability, as well as the National Trust's various schemes, making full efforts to provide information and benefits to reach out to people with disabilities and rehabilitation. MR CP , Autism and MD (PWDS) of the most deprived areas of economically marginalized and disadvantaged society.

Our aim is to create an inclusive society where people with disabilities are accepted into mainstream society - a culture and ecosystem where they can earn, live and maintain with dignity and respect. Bhopal District consists of 7 blocks and it is a urban area. The main work of people here is agriculture.

Therefore that staff had started the help of other hendicappedpeople who,s suffring from that time.Staff went to hendicapped peoples home and asking his/ her problem and according tha problem they provided the help just like Ration, Medisin, Senetiser and mask also. It's note a one time proses they had do it again and again in the whole year in 2020. Something 34 other handicapped goat the benefit.

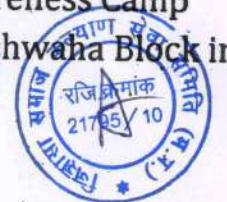


Awareness Camp

On 5 August 2020, We explained the 21 types of disabilities to the families of Disabled People in Raisen . All the families had many misunderstandings which were cleared by Director Mr. Mukesh Thakur. In Awareness Camp the Parshad of the Raisen Mr. Jamuna Sen was also present. By Distributing Pamphlets and Poster, Families were made aware. Upto 40 families Participated in our Awareness Camp. Most of the disabled from Raisen were suffering from Mental Retardation and MD, MR, Autism, Cerebral Palsy.

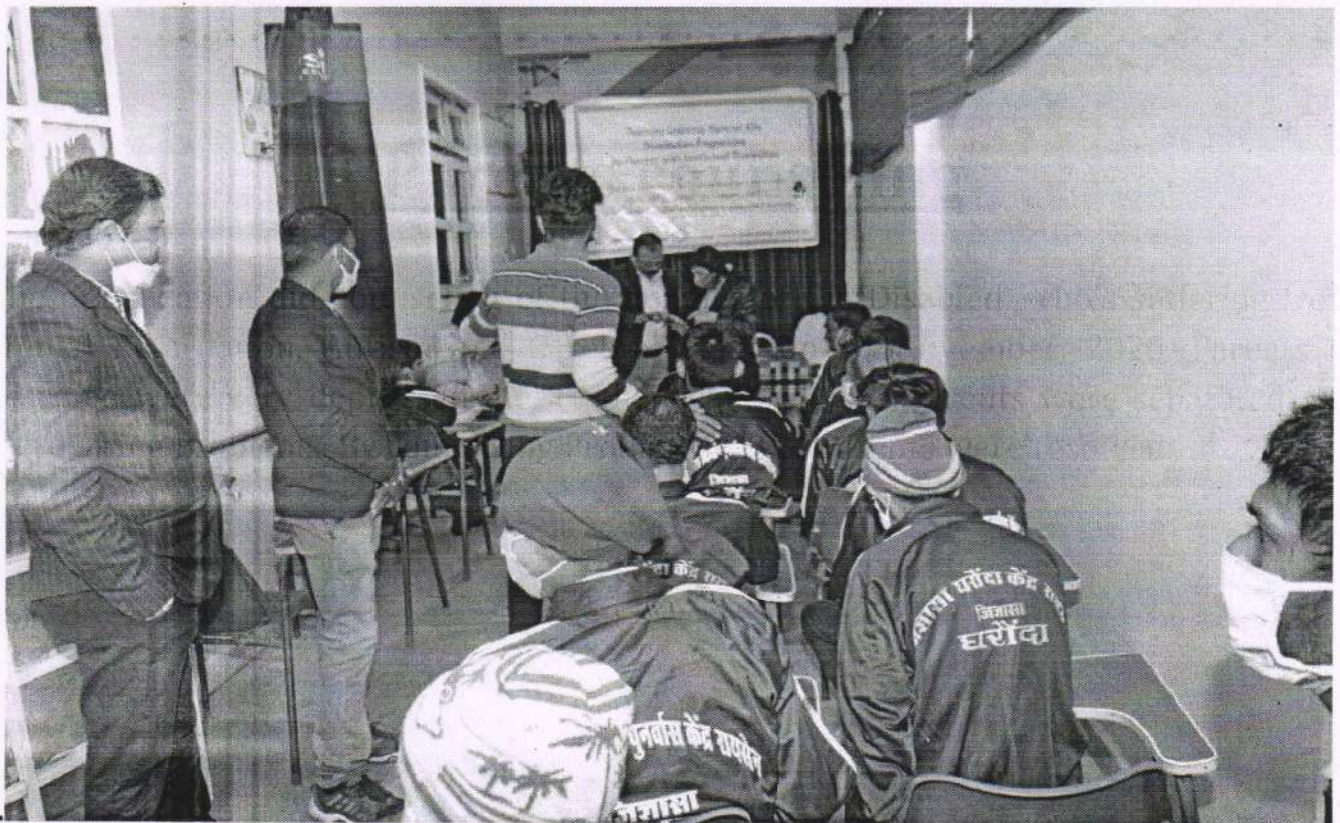

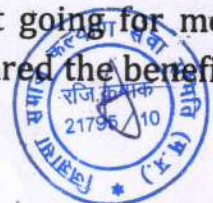
Parents counseling

The organization did counseling of the families of the Disabled, who's suffering from Mental Retardation, Autism and Cerebral Palsy on 14 November, 2020. Parents of Disabled were very depressed due to their children; the Parents were separated and were facing Problems. By counseling Problems of the parents were resolved

Health Checkup Camp

Jigyasa Samaj Kalyan Sewa samiti organized a Health Checkup Camp for special disabled person in Raisen, On 21 December 2020 in which 49 disabled with their families were given Free Checkups and Also Free medicaments were distributed. Every Disable's Blood, Sugar, BP, Covid19, Hemoglobin and other test was done.



Doctors Examining Disabled and their Families

1. Dr. M.L. Ahirwar (MBBS, MD) And Dr. Nidhi Singh Chauhan (sociologist) of District Hospital was present in the health camp.
1. 49 Disabled (Mentally Retarded, Autism and cerebral Palsy) participated in this camp.
2. In which his blood pressure, hemoglobin, sugar were tested.
3. During the health checkup, it was found that most of the people were suffering from chest pain and weakness.
4. They were treated according to illness.
5. Those hospitalized with critical illness were referred to a medical hospital.



A Special visit :- On 1 January, 2021, Disabled were taken to Satdhara by Bus for visit of Stupas. Organization Volunteers and Director Mukesh Thakur also went along 21 disabled with Multiple Disabilities. We gave them information about Bus, All the children became very happy and some were travelling in the Bus for the first time. Disabled were taken to nearby Garden and Stupas in Satdhara for. Every year organization schedules 2 visits for disables.

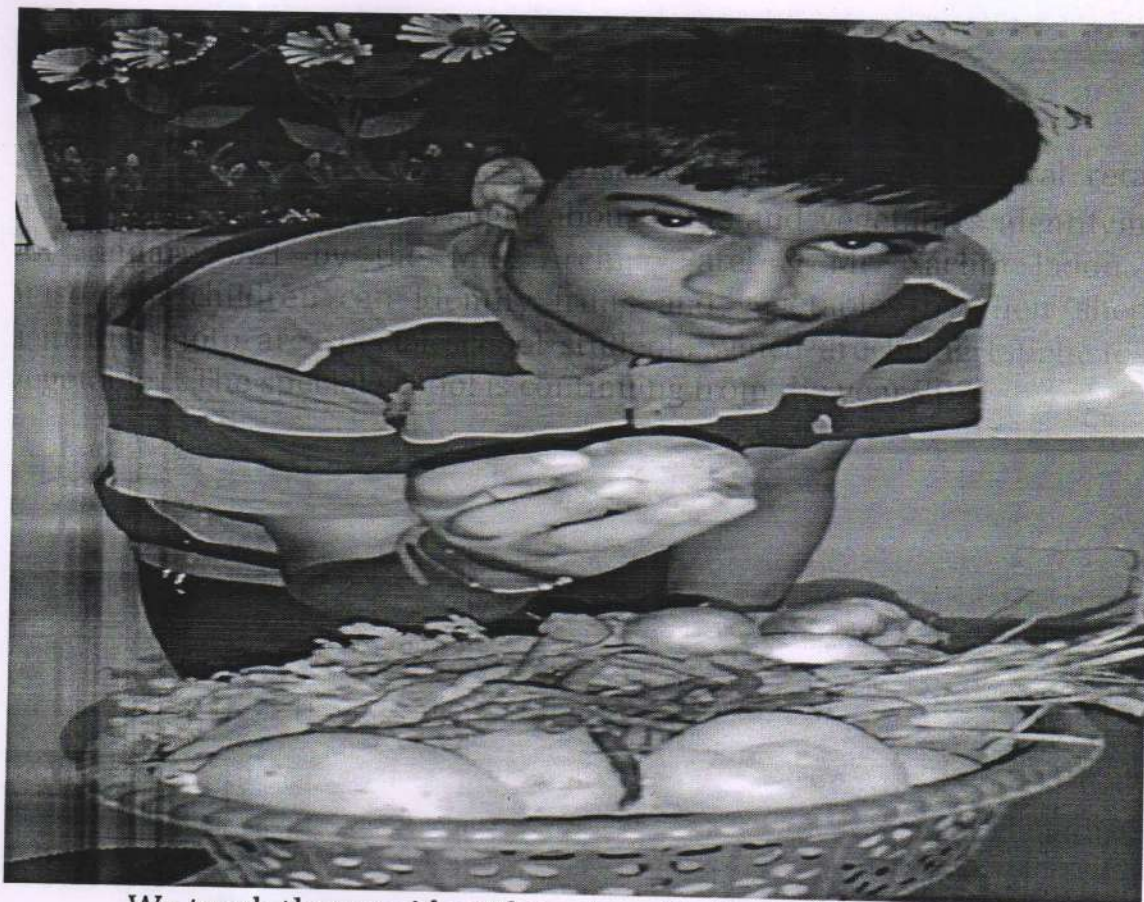


Time to trip

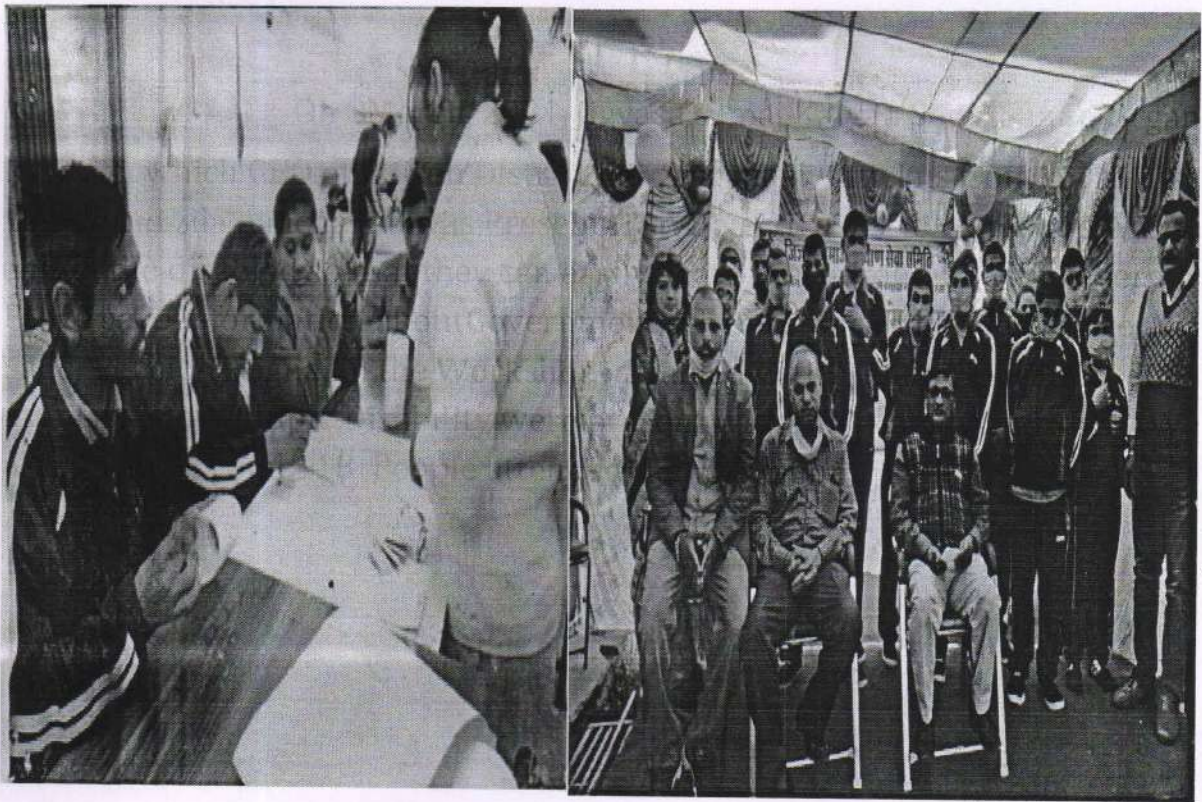
- All children are in the category of cerebral palsy, autism, mental retardation and multiple disabilities and are above 18 years of age.
