Introduction

Life Line Service Society is a non-profit organization of Sagar Madhya Pradesh. The organization was formed on 04 January 2001. The work area of the institution is in the entire Sagar district and the institution MR. MD. CP. And Autism Along with working at the Day Care Social School for MR. The operation of this is also going on. From time to time, the organization organizes awareness camps, awareness programs, to make the society aware of the disability, as well as the National Trust's various schemes, making full efforts to provide information and benefits to reach out to people with disabilities and rehabilitation. MD CP and MD (PWD) of the most deprived areas of economically marginalized and disadvantaged society.

Our aim is to create an inclusive society where people with disabilities are accepted into mainstream society - a culture and ecosystem where they can earn, live and maintain with dignity and respect.

The Organization is working for the homeless, helpless, hopeless, destitute persons generally found in very harsh and painful condition on roadsides, railway stations, bus stands, religious and other public places. Having been neglected by society, without food, water, and clothing, the generally go towards lingering death. Without proper treatment and wound care, they are frequently found infested with maggots. The organization run residential home by the name of Gharaunda Ashram where all the facilities like treatment, food, clothing, personal care, and medical treatments are provided free of cost, with support and generosity of the society.

Most of the Disabled brought to the Ashram are suffering from different types of ailments. Hence Medical Treatment plays a significant part in the services we offer them. Most of the Treatments are treated in our Ashram only but for urgent and critical conditions there is an arrangement with local hospitals where medical investigations and treatments are provided.
