

### **Activities Report -**

The main thrust of the organization is "Rural Upliftment, Health Care and Development of Persons With Disabilities". The MTSS has been implementing a variety of activities in an integrated approach. The following activities are carried out during the year 2020 - 21.

# 1. Tilottama Devi Residential Special School for Hearing Impaired(H.I.):

Tilottama Devi Special School for the Hearing Impaired (H.I.) managed by Mother Teresa Seva Sangha and aided by the Department of Social Security and Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities , Govt. of Odisha . Total 71 numbers of students are enrolled in this school and 15 numbers of staff are engaged for providing services to the hearing impaired students. This school has been running from pre-primary to class-VIII. All types of facilities i.e. speech therapy and hearing aid ,health checkup and vocational education have been provided.

# 2. Prahallad Residential Special School for Mentally Retarded (M.R.):

Prahallad Special School for Mentally Retarded(M.R.) managed by Mother Teresa Seva Sangha and aided by the Department of Social Security and Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities , Govt. of Odisha. Total 51 numbers of students and 16 numbers of staff engaged for providing special education to the mentally retarded students. All types of facilities i.e. speech therapy, psychological assessment and psychiatric treatment, occupational therapy, health checkup and skill development services have been provided . The aids/appliances and TLMs have been provided for better education.

# 3. Residential Special School for V.I., C.P. & Autism

Besides two govt. aided schools Mother Teresa Seva Sangha also running Special Schools for Visually Impaired(V.I.), Cerebral Palsy(C.P.) and Autism Spectrum Disorder students since 2002. All types of facilities and skill development trainings are provided by the trained Professionals . The organisation has been created a home environment for the free and better achievement of the disabled students.

# 4. Rehabilitation and Therapeutic Services to The Physically and Mentally Challenged Socially Disadvantaged Persons.

Mother Teresa Seva Sangha has been implemented the project Rehabilitation and Therapeutic Services to the physically and mentally challenged socially disadvantaged persons from the year 2016 with support of the Department of Social Security and Empowerment of persons with disabilities, Govt. of Odisha. This programme is becoming popular in the rural area of Baliapal Block. Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Psychological Assessment and psychiatric treatment have been provided to make success of the programme. Total 40 beneficiaries have been benefited by this programme. The Vocational Training also provided to them. This is great achievement of the organization.

#### 5. SHG For Disabled:-

Mother Teresa Seva Sangha has been formed the Self Help Groups for the Disabled in the Balasore and Mayurbhanj District. The organization has been created awareness among the adult disabled persons that minimum five persons can form a SHG for their self development. The organization has been created awareness about many schemes which are available in the government for the SHG.

#### 6. Library and Reading Room:-

The organization has an ideal library and reading room with magazines, journals, news papers and other books. Ten and hundred readers come and study in the reading rooms. It serves as a torch bearer in the dark night of the rural readers.

# 7. Senior Citizen Welfare Programme:-

MTSS has been started a welfare programme for the senior citizen. The organization has made the survey and found that most of the senior citizens are staying in a sorrowful situation. So the organization has been decided to start a recreation centre for them. The religious books are recited regularly for their happiness. Therapeutic services have been provided to them.

## 8. Skill Development Programmes:-

MTSS has been developed a skill development programme for the youths. The organization has been provided vocational training by tailoring and scientific way of agriculture. We have created awareness for the Mushrom production which is a profitable production. The Coir work training also provided to them.

# 9. Awareness Programme for COVID-19:-

Mother Teresa Seva Sangha has been created awareness among the rural people about the precautions for COVID- 19 and distributed Masks, Sanitizers, Soaps & Dry Foods among the poor disabled persons & senior citizens.
