On this holy day I am going to present the annual report of the institution.

The school for cerebral palsy (Sambhav C.P School) is being managed by the organization from 1st April, 2017 in a rented house where 30nos. of students are enrolled. 4nos. of teachers are appointed for purpose & 5nos. of non- teaching staffs are also providing all sorts of necessary service to team. A physiotherapist has also been engaged to treat the children on regular basis. Students are imparted training in games & sports, dance, yoga, activities of daily living with regular education. This year students visited chandipur sea beach twice. The application for permission to this school by the state government is under consideration now. We are hopeful that this year the school will get permission from the government.

The students of the school also participating in sports competitions organized by the district administration on the occasion of International Disabled Day received 46 nos. of awards. Students from different districts are very much interested to study in this school due to successfully providing higher education, with special care and for its excellent track record, practicality and the real picture. For this the institution is very much grateful to the Department of SSEPD, Government of Odisha and to the district administration.

Achievement of Our Students of School for the Blind in a nutshell

The International Competition 'Sambhav -2019' meant for Children with disabilities was held at New Delhi and was organized by ALPANA Society where participants from 17 Countries i.e. Australia, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Iran, Kenya, Mauritius, Mongolia, Myanmar, Nepal, Philippines, Russia, Sri Lanka, Tajikistan, U.K., Uzbekistan, Vietnam, took part. The students Gurubari Banara, Basanti Hansda, Sasmita Mishra, Rashmita Sasmal, Phula Soren, and Padmini Tudu, of this school performing a stage show in dance programme based on the song 'Beti Bachao & Beti Padhao' brought success to their school and the district had been appreciated highly by the audience.

Singrai Majhi, a student of Class- X of the school have been selected in the Odisha Cricket team for the Blind for his around performance drawing the attention of the selectors. He has succeed before in many National Level Cricket Tournaments. Recently participating in a match at Goa he brought Victory for Odisha.

Five girls students of the school namely Basanti Hansda, Gurubari Banara, Phula Soren, Maina Naik, & Padmini Tudu had been selected in the Odisha Blind Cricket team for women formed for the first time. Basanti Hansda was given the opportunity in the team as Vice- Captain. The team has owned the trophy in a triangular Cricket series played at Dehradun. During the series and in the very first match Basanti Hansda scored 49 runs against Uttarakhand and also in the Semi- final & Final match against delhi she scored 57 & 51 not out and received the man of the match, man of the series award. Phula Soren too has proved her ability in bowling.

Three students Rudranarayan Mahanta, Dambarudhar Hembram & Dillip Tudu of the school for the Blind representing Odisha have got lots of success in the racing competition held at Tyagraj Sports Complex, New Delhi. Sasmita Mishra & Sulochana Rout of the School performing in a dance competition at the State Level Mega Final organized by Shantidham foundation got the first position and second position respectively.

The school & school hostel is running in a rented house. So, for education purpose of the Visual Impaired as well as for C.P children students we have requested the District administration for a land and that is under consideration. Unlike general schools all kinds of festival are observed and all sorts

of programmes are organized here. Students are impaired trained on dance, craft, drawing, orientation & mobility with academic education.
