Introduction

Universal Disabled CareTaker Social Welfare Society (Prabh Aasra - Unified Family), located in village Padiala, Kurali, Tehsil Kharar, S.A.S Nagar (Mohali), with its main Ashram at village Padiala and branches in village Jhanjeri, Landran, Distt- SAS Nagar (Mohali), and village Pherurian, Raikot, Distt. Ludhiana, extends its services to unclaimed individuals with mental or physical challenges, orphans, the elderly, ailing, abandoned, needy persons, widows, and missing destitute who are brought to our organization for assistance in dilapidated conditions. We offer shelter, care, treatment, and rehabilitation to those who lack these opportunities.

Our fourth branch, Prabh Aasra Charitable Medical Sewa Center, Chanalon (Kurali), Tehsil- Kharar, Distt- SAS Nagar (Mohali), PB, has initiated a charitable 50-bedded super specialty hospital to cater to the needs of our residents and the underprivileged citizens.

With the grace of God, we strive to play a pioneering role in making a lasting difference in their lives by providing medical treatment, nutritional support, education, skill development, as well as opportunities in sports and the arts.

Legal status: Society is registered under Societies Registration Act 1957; Under Section 12AA of the Income Tax Act 1961, Under Sub Section 3 of Section 34 of Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children Act 2000) and Society is also registered under P.W.D. Act 1995, CSR, Niti Ayog and also registered under National Trust. The donations given to the Society are exempted under section 80G of the Income Tax Act 1961. The foreign donations reach Society through FCRA account. The members and volunteers of the Society are esteemed Academicians, Social Workers, high profile retired IAS and IRS Officers, Army/Central Government officers and eminent Philanthropists. Society has its own Prabh Aasra logo and name registered as a trademark.

Our Projects:

Care and Rehabilitations:

Rehabilitation practice changes the perception of mental illness. The goal of the society is to help mentally challenged/PWD and other residents admitted in our society to develop their emotional, social and intellectual skills needed to live, learn and work in the community with the least support of others. Since the inception of Society in 2004, a total of **2125 inhabitants**, who were devoid of opportunities of care, medical facilities, rehabilitation and shelter, were admitted to the Society for care, shelter, education and treatment. Out of which, after reviving their mental and physical health, **1382 have been reunited over** to their families in 22 states and as on date **449 inhabitants** are residing in the Society. They are engaged in skill programs and extracurricular activities which shift their focus from illness to a model of functional disability.

New Admission Details

During the reporting period, 94 new admissions were made to the Society for care and treatment. These individuals were brought in for admission by various Government Agencies, including the District Child Protection Officer, District Social Security Officer, SDM Panchayats, Municipal Committees, Police Personnel, Hospital Authorities, and few were rescued in critical conditions by Society Volunteers either from home or road sides. The admissions consisted of 40 males, 43 females, 6 male children, and 5 female children. Of all the inhabitants admitted, 23 suffer from intellectual disabilities, with the majority experiencing mental instability due to stress or depression.

Mission Millap:

One of the aims of the Society is to reunite missing persons with their families. The process for carrying out the reuniting of missing persons with their families has been named '**Mission Milaap.**' Individuals received in the Ashrams of the Society were either Intellectually disabled, ill, physically handicapped, or a combination of these conditions. With proper care, and when there was an improvement in their health, they disclosed their identity or provided information about their residential addresses, villages, or towns. The Society then contacted the relevant Police Authorities by telephone to seek their assistance in tracing their family members and handing them over.

After recovery, a total of **1382** individuals have been reunited with their invited families on campus, while others were taken to their respective homes and states for reunion, such as Himachal Pradesh, West Bengal, Bihar, Tamil Nadu, Orissa, Rajasthan, Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra, Assam, Karnataka and Uttar Pradesh. Up until now, inhabitants from more than 23 states have been successfully reunited.

Medical Treatment of Inhabitants

Along with shelter the inhabitants receive transportation to hospitals via Society's ambulances for routine checkups, follow-up appointments, laboratory tests, X-rays, and ultrasounds. Adherence to prescribed treatments is strictly maintained to enhance their health.

A Physiotherapy department has been established at the Padiala Ashram, staffed with three physiotherapists appointed by the Society. They provide physiotherapy sessions on-site for inhabitants suffering from cerebral palsy, paralysis, or multiple disabilities.

Clinical psychologists and social workers offer regular counseling sessions to mentally challenged and mentally ill patients. Each year, the Society provides medicines worth over Rs 18 lakh for their treatment, excluding emergency surgeries.

Various specialists in medicine, ENT, ophthalmology, dentistry, and psychiatry conduct regular checkups on inmates, either daily or weekly, ensuring they receive optimal treatment and care.

Charitable Medical Sewa Center (50 bedded hospital)



During the Covid-19 pandemic, Prabh Aasra felt an urgent need to start the hospital to fulfill the needs of our inhabitants and needy citizens. In Feb 2021 the first phase of this project was started as **Prabh Aasra Charitable Medical Sewa Center**, where **32 specialist and super specialist doctors** provide their services, along with the diagnostic center, 24 hours emergency services to provide the immediate required medical relief to helpless destitute, to save the life of citizen in case of emergency and charitable medical services for the



under privileged who couldn't hope for the treatment & diagnosis, in the hour of need, it works on non profit basis. Along with a 50

bedded charitable hospital, “Prabh Aasra Medicose” (Charitable Pharmacy) shop is working for 24/7 emergencies.



OPD's ,General medicine, Cardiology department, Neurology department, Gynecology department, Orthopedics, Psychiatric, Dental, Ophthalmic ,Dermatology, Dental department, Pediatric department, ENT and Physiotherapy department have been set up.

Diagnosis departments include Pathology Lab, Ultrasound /Echo /X-ray/Tmt , Ecg , along with Pharmacy all working on a non-profit basis have been set up in Prabh Aasra charitable medical Sewa center,(chanalon).



The Operation Theaters (OTs) specialize in General surgeries (Laparoscopy), Orthopedic procedures (with C-Arm), Gynecology, Urology, Eye, Ortho, and Dental treatments. Needy or underprivileged individuals from the general public are provided medical care





at charitable rates, while destitute or inhabitants of Prabh Aasra receive treatment free of cost.

Regularly, free medicine, first aid/ Medical camps, Blood donation camps and Emergency services, including free ambulance services, are extended to the general public in need.



Throughout the year, free medicines amounting to approximately Rs 4 lakh were distributed to those in need.

20th March 2024	Rajinder Kaur (Founder/Member) was appointed as an affiliated member of Cerebral Palsy Sports Society of Punjab for the term 2024-2025 with Registration No. CPSSP/am/i/2022-23-1
23-26 Mar ,2024	(Prabh Aasra Unified Family hosted a FREE medical camp at Sri Anandpur Sahib during Hola Mohalla. Co-founder Madam Rajinder Kaur spearheaded the initiative. Needy individuals received complimentary checkups and treatments from Prabh Aasra's doctors and paramedical staff, along with free medications. Additionally, ambulance services were provided, ensuring round-the-clock medical assistance.
March 2024	The Election Commission of Punjab requested the District Special Olympics Association (DSOA) of Mohali to recommend a special person as an icon of Punjab. Ms. Poonam recommended the name of our special inhabitant, Ms. Vishnu, who has achieved remarkable success in dance. Ms. Vishnu has won gold three times, two silver medals, and many bronzes at the national level. She has also been a gold medalist for three consecutive years at the state level as a solo dancer.

Children Activities:

Children from the Society have been enrolled in various schools within the town to receive education. Additionally, the Society has hired two specialized teachers dedicated to educating children with special needs

at the Children's Home. For mentally challenged students, those with multiple disabilities, and cerebral palsy, the Society has engaged specialized coaches. These coaches provide training in games, co-curricular activities, and vocational skills, preparing them for independent living. Through consistent training, they are groomed to participate in cultural and athletic competitions at both the State and National levels. Notably, inmates of the Society have showcased their talents in competitions at these levels, achieving commendable positions. On January 26, 2023 (Thursday), at 4:00 pm, **Angad Singh, Ekam, and Vishnu**, accompanied by Navjot Kaur (staff), attended the event at Punjab Bhawan, Chandigarh.

Additionally, the Society has employed teachers and volunteers to provide tuition to regular students, aiding them in their studies and school assignments. With



boundless aspirations, the Society aims to empower these children to leave a lasting impact on society, fostering pride as responsible citizens. Currently, the Society supports 43 abandoned or orphaned children, providing education and facilitating their enrollment in surrounding schools. The **PSEB declared results for 10th grade**. It is a proud moment for **Prabh Aasra Unified Family**, that our four students of 10th board exam have passed with more than 80 % to 93 % marks. **Gurleen Kaur, Prabh Aasra Child Inhabitant) is one of the toppers among first fifteen (15) toppers of Punjab**. Meera Kumari scored second position in her school.

Vocational Training

The Society has employed two vocational teachers to instruct mentally challenged, mentally ill, and physically handicapped inmates in various crafts. These individuals, who have shown improvement in health, engage in crafting activities such as candle making, toy crafting, tapestry creation, keychain production, and painting. Additionally, they undertake tailoring, embroidery, crochet, and tie-and-dye projects. The items crafted by these individuals are showcased in exhibitions hosted by different institutions.

Skilled Development Courses: Prabh Aasra has established a skill development institute to benefit residents, particularly the underprivileged individuals who may face challenges affording high-cost skill development courses.



We offer three-month courses in G.D.A./Caretaker, Basic Computer Courses, and Stitching. Additionally, we have introduced new short-term courses in Food Processing (Bakery).

We are pleased to announce the successful completion of our Two batches. This accomplishment reflects our commitment to providing quality education and empowering individuals with practical skills.





Transport:

School Van Facility: The society owns three school buses exclusively dedicated to transporting students. These buses are utilized for the safe and efficient pick-up and drop-off of school-going children, ensuring a reliable and secure means of transportation to and from the educational institution.



Ambulance Facility

The society has **Nine ambulances** along with **one ambulance cum Mortuary Van** which was recently modified. These ambulances are generally used for transportation of inmates to various hospitals for medical check up and medical tests. These are also provided to poor families “free of cost” for shifting of their serious patients to hospitals as and when such requests are received in any of the centers of society. They are always kept in readiness for any eventuality or accidents. Whenever some unfortunate event takes place on the road the ambulances are rushed to the accident spot in the shortest possible time to shift victims to nearby hospitals to



save precious lives. From **Last year Prabh Aasra** society has helped (**approx. 190 outsider patients**) with free ambulance services.

Other Help

Prabh Aasra has extended its support through various initiatives, exemplifying its commitment to making a positive impact. The following outlines additional forms of assistance provided during the periods under report by Prabh Aasra:

- **Distribution of Blankets/Quilts/woolen Clothes:-**



helped two girls for her marriage with **14 blankets, 14 suits, 14 pants and 14 shirts** each.

The society generously donated essential medical equipment and other Assistive aids: including **48** wheelchairs, 25 hospital beds, 4 air mattresses, 16 walkers, and 19 oxygen concentrators. Additionally,

The society distributed **2100 Blankets, 30 pc slippers, 100 pc turbans, 125 pairs shirt & pants, 100 (pairs) shoes, 212 pc suits, 255 Sweaters, 50 Lohies, 107 Quilts, 50 Mattress, 57 (pairs) Woolen suits,**to the needy and underprivileged. Also



vital devices like 1 suction machine, 1 nebulizer, and 2 ECG machines were provided, along with 6 toilet trolley vans, supporting those in need during lancers, medical camps, and civic functions.

Enhancing Community Services: Dedicated **Mortuary** Infrastructure and Preservation Units: "Four body preservation units have been strategically placed in Padiala campus, with an additional unit allocated to both Jhanjeri and Ludhiana campuses for the respectful preservation of deceased individuals. In response to the community's needs, a mortuary van has also been made available. Local residents reached out to our society seeking assistance in preserving the departed for a day or as needed. In response to the public's request, we granted permission 63 times for individuals to use these preservation units either at home or within our campus premises, catering to the specific exigencies of grieving families."

Legal Aid Support

The legal aid services started by Punjab Legal Service Authority in the premises of the Society are continuing. The Citizens are mostly provided aid and are made aware regarding their rights through calls or personal meetings. The cases referred by the Society for legal aid are being pursued by the Legal Aid Service Authority. The President of the Society had several meetings with them for legal help to the inmates or other needy citizens.



Environmental Activity

Till now more than 1100 saplings were purchased and planted. Taking care and watering the plants and removing weeds work from time to time.



Awareness campaign:
