Global Trust since its inception strongly believes that the participatory development approach is an effective tool for reaching project goals in better way because it basically involves all the stakeholders in one platform and engage them towards achievement of the project. On this way during the FY 2019-2020 we have implemented flagship programmes for the betterment of Persons with Disabilities, Children and Women through rehabilitation intervention and development activities.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

We got an wonderful opportunity to bring out many tangible improvements among the project beneficiaries through the support of both Central and State governments as well as partnering institutions. During the FY 2019-2020 we extended our support to 175 beneficiaries of Persons with Intellectually disabled under Institutionalized care and support services. Of them 135 Children with Special Needs between the age group of 06 to 18 years have enrolled in **Global Special School and Global Samarth centre** (detailed report in page no. 8 -12) for life skills development through special education and vocational training. They were provided free cost of multimodal therapy intervention along with life skill development training to reduce their dependency on their daily life.

Yet another achievement is to Children with Autism Spectrum Disorders (CwASD). Focused rehabilitation intervention was given for building positive changes among the CwASD through proper assessment tools and therapy services. The centre is engaged professionally well trained service providers to ensure better rehabilitation service and fruitful outcome. During the FY 2019-2020 there were 20 ASD children enrolled in **Global Autism centre** (detailed report in page no.13-14) for multifaceted trainings. The imparted trainings have given tangible outcomes and enhanced children's mental health and their positive behavioural changes. The all over development have ensured through proper assessment and Evaluation.

Global Adult Home for Girls (MR) (detailed report in page no.15) is a new special programme started in December 2019. In this home 40 adult girls from the age group of above 14 years were enrolled for their rehabilitation and Vocational Training. The basic aim of this programme is to provide intensive care and support to adult girls with Intellectually Disabled . Action has taken for improving their health condition, maintain good mental health through Psychological support and ensured safety life. Vocational training facility based on the need assessment has also given to improve their technical skill and help them to involve self and supported employment.

Under Nai-Roshni scheme Leadership Development training was given to 125 Women who have participated from minority communities (detailed report in page no.16-17) and they were given training on Decision making, Education, Health and Hygiene, Legal rights, Financial literacy, Digital Literacy, Swaach Bharat, Life Skills development and Advocacy for Behavioural changes. The main aim of this training is to empower minority communities women at various levels to bringing out positive changes at society as well as family levels. The trained women have also given financial linkage opportunity through post training support and they are involved in various livelihood activities.

On part of livelihood promotion effort opportunity given to 20 young adults with Special Needs to receive Vocational skill development training on Paper bag making, Artificial Jewelry making and handy craft works. The training plan was designed based on the ability of the individual and all the 20 trained persons have been involved in income generation activity through supported employment at Global Vocational Training cum Production unit.

In addition, During the FY 2019-2020 our project beneficiaries have also participated in various programmes to show their talents and skills. Among them World Yoga Day, World Disabled Day, World Autism Day, World Women's Day, Indian Independence and Republic Days are some of the events where they have showed their synergized talent with great appreciation.

Furthermore we have also involved into create awareness on national and international important events besides of our development activities. This is an opportunity to encourage general public, parents and community members to become a partnership with us for good initiatives. And we have also attended many of national and international level training programmes/ Conference/ workshops which were conducted by both government and non government institutions.



At first we have decided to create awareness among the general public about the pandemic and its impacts . A awareness rally was organized jointly with **Periyar Arts College**, Cuddalore by which the rally was participated by college students and Global Special School Children. The programme was inaugurated by JD Health of Cuddalore District Head Quarter Hospital and Principal of Periyar Arts College .

In next We involved to support the needy people through relief packages. This was purely joint venture assisting through District Administration of Cuddalore. Along with DDAWO we have reached nearly 5000 + families with the package of gray food grains ,Medicine and other relief materials. We have also supported people who have seeking our help from other districts.

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Marching with Visionary... CBR - a tool for effective Participation& Intervention Intervention

Global Trust strongly believes since its inception that CBR is a strategy within the community development for the rehabilitation, equalization of opportunities, and social inclusion of PwDs. CBR entails holistic, social and participatory approaches in the field of Community Development Programme and it enables PwDs to contribute to development activities. To reach the unreached segment especially Persons with Disabilities we make regular visit to villages and involved in awareness building activities among PwDs, parents/ guardians and general public about the importance of Early Intervention for disability identification , Institutionalization of Children with Special Needs-and the importance of Special Education . During the FY 2019-2020 we have visited for 50 villages across Cuddalore district to create awareness building and rehabilitation activities.

PROJECT ACTIVITY - Highlights of the FY 2019-2020

GLOBAL SPECIAL SCHOOL FOR INTELLECTUALLY DISABLED

The scheme is recognized and supported by the Govt. of TamilNadu. During the FY 2019-20 100 CwSNs were enrolled in the scheme and provided them residential care and support.

The teaching learning method is based on VAKT modal

(Visual, Auditory, Kinesthetic-Tactile) which is more effective and adaptive in nature to Children with diversified learners. The following activities are taken up for early intervention and to enhance the ability of CwSNs. Mainly Life skills oriented training s have been imparted to ensure independent life style.

The intension of the training is to identify technical skills of young adults and equip them with specialized vocational training to become a part of productive member of our society.

Basically the enrolled young adults have been done need assessment for identification of their skills to feed them some technical skills which will help them to learn employable skills. our vocational training unit is a combination of trainer with trainees where the trainers are being part and parcel of trainees to encourage them to get involved tirelessly.

Based on this strategy focus is also given to train youths of cross cutting disabilities. We offered trainings on Home appliances training, Cellophane service, Tailoring, Paper Bag making, Artificial Jewelry making, Handy crafts and Phenol making

 Multimodal therapy intervention has helped children to have enhanced physical functions, sensory skills and to have good mental health.






GLOBAL SAMARTH CENTRE- RESPITE CARE HOME

During the FY 2019-20 35 special children were enrolled and they provided residential care and support including parents who have needed our assistance.

GLOBAL AUTISM CENTRE - MULTIMODAL THERAPY SERVICE Global Special School as a empanelled institution approved for running Autism centre under TamilNadu Chief Minister Comprehensive Health Insurance Programme (CMCHITN). The main aim of the centre is to provide free cost of multimodal therapy service to Children with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD) . The following facilities are available in the centre such as pre and post assessment, Psychological counseling service, Special Education , Speech therapy, Occupational therapy, Music therapy , Sensory therapy. A team of technical professionals like Psychiatric Doctor, Clinical Psychologist, Multimodal therapists and special educators have been engaged for assessment and therapy intervention. During this FY 2019 – 2020 there were 20 Children with ASD enrolled and they were provided therapeutically intervention based on the training plan. This is an special initiative programme to benefit Children with ASD in Cuddalore District.










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GLOBAL ADULT HOME FOR GIRLS (MR)

The scheme is sanctioned and supported by the Govt. of TamilNadu. The main aim of the scheme is to provide intensive residential care and multi-faceted rehabilitation support to Adult Girls with Mentally Challenged age group of above 14 years old.

During the FY 2019-20 there were 40 Adult Girls enrolled and provided training to enhance their life skills. A designed vocational trainings on paper bag making, artificial jewelry making were also imparted to them.

The home is a place for learning with experience , life skills enhancement, Attitudinal changes, and Psychological support. Our sincere thanks to the State Commissioner, State Commissionerate for the welfare of Differently Abled, Chennai , the District Collector of Cuddalore and DDAWO, Cuddalore for representing us to run this scheme.





WOMEN LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME-

Nai-Roshni an exclusive training programme for Leadership development of Minority Women sanctioned by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt of India. Global Trust as Project implementing Agency (PIA) for 2017-2020 has taken up adequate steps to implement this programme successfully. The main objective of the programme is to empower and instill confidence in Women by providing knowledge, tools and techniques for interacting with Government systems, banks intermediaries at all levels. A week long training programme will be given broadly covering the areas of issues relating to women viz. Leadership of Women through participation in decision making, Educational programmes for women, Health and Hygiene Legal rights of women, Financial Literacy, Digital Literacy, Swachch Bharat, Life Skills and Advocacy for Social and Behavioral Change. Besides of this the hand holding support will also been given for one year. During the FY 2019-20 hand holding supports have been given to 125 Women who were trained in 2018-19.

Training conducted areas are:

- So far handholding meetings have conducted 60 times (12x5) for all 5 patches and during this meetings matters have taken up for discussion and to action relating to their economic development, health and hygienic management and disaster management techniques.
- Linkage facility with government departments and banks have been made to all eligible group members for receiving welfare schemes and livelihood loan.
- Local level Disaster management task group with monitoring tool has been formed comprising with trainees and local members.
- Arranged for skill training on selective trades to support trainees to start livelihood activities at their localities.
- Trainees have been encouraged to participate in events to show their talents and also to ensure their participation in decision making activities.
- All trainees have encouraged to access PHCs for maintaining well being of them as well as their family members.
- All members have given adequate awareness on communicable and Non communicable diseases and the way for accessing medical assistance.


IMPORTANT EVENTS & ACHIEVEMENTS






YOGA DAY






We are taking adequate steps to prove the talents of our special children in sports. Accordingly our children have been undergoing training to participate sports and games including Para-Olympics.

Medical Camp



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


UDID CAMP


