2. Impact of COVID – 19 and the Special Children

Due to the onslaught of COVID – 19 we could not conduct our Special School for the Mentally Retarded Children. This has prevented us by providing our regular therapeutic programmes. But our special educators and the other staff made regular home visits and provided the needed therapies at their door step. This services could be mentioned as counseling, physiotherapy, awareness to parents etc. During the lockdown period staff had contacted to the parents and children through online. Due to the impact of COVID – 19 the parents could not go for their daily work; consequently their income was affected very much. RUCODE INDIA made a special drive in providing relief materials to about 60 families. The materials that were provided were rice, groceries, mask and sanitizer.







3. GOVT. SCHEMES

Out staff members have taken efforts in the promotion of Govt. Schemes like Maintenance Grant, maintenance grant verification work, distribution of UDID to the beneficiaries and providing mobility devices like three wheeler bike and crutches and wheel chairs. Those who were eligible for Niramaya Health Insurance were linked with the National Trust and encourage to get insurance coverage.





4. Promotion of 100% participation in the Assembly Election:

During this year the Assembly Election for Tamilnadu was conducted on 6th April 2021. The department of Differently Abled had encouraged all the PWDs to participate in the election and made them cast their vote 100%. To achieve this we had conducted webinar sessions for the Differently Abled with the Govt. officials and there were special classes for them to make use of the special aids and appliances during the election time.





5. PARTICIPATION IN GOVT. OF INDIA PROGRAMMES

RUCODE INDIA has been appointed SNAC of Tamilnadu for the second term. This additional responsibility comes under the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India. With this RUCODE INDIA has been assigned to look after the services of children with MR, CP, Autism and MD. Registered Organisation of Tamilnadu state are guided and monitored by SNAC – TN for improve the quality of their programme which come under National Trust.

During this year we had conducted one virtual meeting involving officers from the State Commissionerate, all the Registered Organisation and District Differently Abled Welfare Officers, National Trust officers, and other stakeholders regarding the schemes and programmes of the National Trust.
