The SEED is a Non-Governmental Organization formed for the upliftment of the poor downtrodden weaker section people whose Socio Education Economic, cultural and Health condition are still in backward. It is a secular, Social Service organization its service lifts the people irrespective of caste, colour and religion.

The organization has been registered under Trust Act. Its registration number is 38/1999. Since its inception we have been working in Thanjavur and Pudukkottai Districts.

The Administrative Office is located at No.168/2A. Srinivasa Nagar, Ayyampettai, Papanasam Taluk, Thanjavur District Our office bearers are having much experience about the community and this will help to implement ever programmed successfully.

SEED launched its various programmes to develop the community namely: Community Development Programme for women, awareness programmes on differently abled persons rights, conducting health camps, in the target areas

ACTIVITIES

SPECIAL EDUCATION / TRAINING

Social History, Family History, Birth History, Health History, Behavioral History and Performance History are collected from the Parents / Guardian of Students as we did for the made to stay in the institute for one or two days to see the relevance of information about the children, given by them, and to make them aware of the basic knowledge on mental disability. After the admission children are observed for 15 days and assisted by special educators in various areas such as known and unknowns, likes and dislikes ability and disability, desirable and undesirable behaviors using BASIC-MR assessment scale.

Based on the Assessment the children are categorized in the three different groups. After categorized, syllabus is framed by setting long term, Annual and Short term goals individually, which is followed by task analysis, ie. Simplifying the goals in to various steps. Training materials and prepared by deciding training methods. The children are trained in seven areas. Motor, Activities of Daily Living (ADL), Receptive Language & expressive Language, Reading & Writing, Number & Time, Domestic & Social and Pre-vocational & Money, Need based Vocational Training simultaneously. Even though if it is , the first preference is given to activities of daily living, as this is the basic need for further training in academics and other activities. In this contact Special Educator and care givers play on important role to train to train the children is activities of daily living and behavior modification.

When the child attains 50% independency in activities of daily living the next preference is given for teaching academics and extra-curricular activities such as play yoga, drawing, craft, exposures and cultural programmes. After learning the need based academics the child is subjected to vocational training base on his interest, talent, parents concern and applicability of the training in his environment. Job placement, financial assistance and vocational guidance are given to children who achieved more than in their vocational training.

Children who have impaired speech, delayed motor development are given special therapies namely occupational, speech, physio and dance by the respective therapist.

Some children should be given one to one attention as they have more problematic behaviors.

Training should be given as early of possible to the children with mental disability and parents. Parents meeting are conducted once in two weeks.

METHODOLOGY OF TRAINING TO PARENTS GUARDIAN:

Trainees are selected after discussion and confirming about the guardianship and they are observed by the trainers to picturise their level. Initially they are given basic information such as causes. Preventive measures conditions of intellectually challenged. The syllabus framed for their respective children is simplified according to the educational level ability of the trainee, which becomes syllabus for this training. After fixing the time table training is given parents are given exposure to various institutions to get more cooperation, evaluation of this training is done based on the improvement of children in the absence of special educator.

HEALTH CARE:

Environment cleanliness and personal hygiene of the children are supervised to prevent diseased like diarrhea scabies etc., Menu Chart is prepared after observing the health status of the children and consulting dietician. Balanced diet is provided to all. According to the physicians prescription vitamin tablets are provided to all. Children since, it is effective then providing vitamin enriched food. All the children are weighed once a month to know the effect of providing nutritional food and to know the health status of the children.
