Secretary's Report

Our journey began in the year 1985 with FREE supply of artificial limbs to a few beneficiaries which today stands at 277669 beneficiaries being served as compared to 243939 beneficiaries last year, an increase of 33730 for the year 2018-19.

Artificial Limbs, Calipers, Hands etc.



As has been our aims & objectives for the last 34 years, we regularly provide artificial legs, hands, calipers, moulded shoes etc to the physically challenged from our state of art workshop and apart from these, regular camps are organized at our Sadan for free supply of the above, such camps being sponsored by various social philanthropic organizations, corporates as well as individuals. I convey my thanks to Shri R K Tenani, Goutam Roy & other technical staff who has been handling our workshop very efficiently. Foreign visitors, visiting MSS, have also shown keen interest in the work done by us in the field of disability, thus generating goodwill for MSS in their countries.

Out Station Camps :

We take pleasure in announcing that during the year 2018-19, MSS has organised 22 out station camps within West Bengal as well as in other states throughout India & abroad. Camps were held at Podhari & Birgunj in Nepal, Amravati, Chirkunda, Visakhapatnam, Bhatinda, Sikar, Sujangarh and other places where a total of 2713 prosthetics were delivered to the physically challenged. I thank our Executive Committee member Shri Srikrishna Tulsianji for his responsibility in overseeing the smooth running of the outstation camps as Camp Convener.

<u>C P Children Unit</u> :



It is a known fact that there's no cure for cerebral palsy but resources and therapies can help kids grow and develop to their greatest potential. Keeping this in mind the Sadan started a Free Cerebral Palsy Children Welfare Unit in the year May 2013. The unit is handled by qualified Occupational Therapist, Physiotherapist, Counselor, Speech Therapist and Special Educator. As results of rehabilitation of these C P Children far exceeded our expectations, a conscious decision to expand this free service to a larger scale was made. MSS has therefore decided to open its

Dream Project named as "Cerebral Palsy Rehabilitation & Research Centre" near IIM Joka.

I would like to thank E C Member Shri Vinay Sethia, Smt Amrao Devi Sethiya, Smt Lata Nevatia and Smt Srikanwari Choraria for undertaking the responsibility of overseeing the unit's functioning which they are doing with utmost care.

<u>Eye Care Unit</u> :



Our eye unit, with the latest eye testing machines, remains open twice a week every Sundays and Wednesdays. The unit has attained good popularity on account of free cataract surgery done to the poor & needy. Free spectacles are also distributed to our needy beneficiaries. I thank Shri Girdharilalji Sultania for sponsoring these surgeries at M P Birla Eye Clinic. Since last July, MSS has introduced a "Mobile Eye Care Van" to carry out eye testing, free distribution of spectacles and medicines and arranging free cataract surgery at reputed eye hospitals. Our van travels to all parts of the country to conduct such camps. The year

2018-19 witnessed 17 camps being held where more than 10000 patients were benefitted. I thank Shri Abhay ji Firodia Chairman of Force Motors for donating the Mobile Eye Care Van and Arham Enterprise, Shri Beharilal Jain Charitable Trust, Shanti Devi Goel Charitable Trust, Sanwarmullji Shroff Gayatri Devi Shroff & Jamnadhar Shroff Charitable Trust and Indravati Devi Bagrodia Charitable Trust for sponsoring major camps. I also thank Shri Amit Jain & his team & Dr Haresh Shah for successfully implementing the project & taking responsibility in overseeing its functioning despite their busy schedules.

Physiotherapy Unit :



Quality-based care is a hallmark of physical therapy. Treatment effectiveness must be evident to patients that specify the minimum acceptable standard of practice. Our Physiotherapy Unit has been responsible for ensuring that and the therapy given is consistent with accepted National guidelines and responsive to patient and societal health needs. The unit having latest machinery & equipments is managed by Dr P S Das with his highly qualified team of therapists under the able supervision of our Joint Secretary Shri K L Banthiaji & has been able to provide top class treatment. It has been able to identify and maximize quality of life, movement

potential and rehabilitation of the patients. Our physically challenged beneficiaries who are in need of treatment, have been fully taken care of free of cost.

MSS Bansal Medical Diagnostic Centre :



Our diagnostic centre having the modern updated machines for the convenience of the general public as well as for our beneficiaries has been extending quality service at reasonable cost. Free diagnostic services are being extended to the physically challenged and at concessional rates to all our members as well as staff. MSS Bansal Medical Diagnostic Centre has a scheme for persons from the weaker section of society where he can avail 50% discount on diagnostic facilities provided the person has been recommended by a member of MSS. A Free Annual Checkup Service was held by them for members of MSS and their spouse, every Saturday & Sunday from 15th January to 15th February. All this would not have been possible without the able guidance of Shri M L Nahataji, Shri V S Chorariaji & Shri Vinod Goyalji to whom I extend my heartiest thanks. I also thank Shri S K Bansalji & his professional team for the success of the diagnostic centre and the services extended to the members and beneficiaries of MSS.

Homeopathy Unit :



Consultation & medicine is free for all at MSS Homeopathy Clinic. It has been giving an admirable service to all those who come to avail the same and has become very popular among the masses especially the poor & needy. The Clinic has proved to be a blessing since consultation fees and cost of medicines for other forms of treatment is enormous these days. I thank Dr Gopal Chourasia, Dr (Mrs) Prema Chourasia, Dr (Mrs) Anita Sancheti & especially our Joint Secretary Shri H M Sethiyaji, for his guidance in the success of the clinic. I thanks Shri Amit Kochar & his family for donating the entire supply of medicines throughout the year to MSS.

Polio Corrective Surgery :

Like every year, this year too we have conducted free corrective surgery on polio patients. As always, this year too these operations were successfully carried under the guidance of our Medical Director, Dr V K Nevatia & Dr Rajesh Kushwaha. These Polio Surgeries are sponsored by Rotary Club of Calcutta Metropolitan for which I am thankful.

<u>Dental Care Unit</u> :
