1. WOMEN & ADOLESCENT DEVELOPMENT & EMPOWERMENT

Dantan Manav Kalyan Kendra puts a special emphasis on development and empowerment of women so that they become able to exercise full control over their own actions. DMKK wants to create an environment where women would have the equal access in participation and decision making. Keeping these in mind, DMKK has organized a series of programmes for social, psychological and economic empowerment of women. Total 385 Self Help Groups have been promoted through us & 359 groups have been credit linked with different banks.

E-Shakti (SHG Dizitisation) Programme:

DMKK in collaboration with NABARD has been working as partner under E-Shakti Programme. E-Shakti is the digitization programme of SHGs. DMKK engaged 54 animators to digitized 1516 SHGs exist in Dantan-I, Mohonpur, Binpur-I, Pingla, Dantan-II & Narayangarh block under Paschim Medinipur District. 54 animators have been given mobile set to upload data on daily basis. Average percentage of uploading live data using mobile is above 95%. Side by side through this programme DMKK motivated the group members to avail social security schemes of Bank such as PMSBY, PMJJBY & Atal Pension Yojana etc.



Skill Development Training for unemployed youth :

DMKK in collaboration with District SHG & SE Office, Jhargram conducted 04 training programmes in Sankrail & Gopiballavpur-I block respectively. Agrarbati Making, Mushroom & soft toys making training for unemployed youths and Muktidhara SHG members were held in Sankrail block. 30 participants took part in each training; each training continued for 20 days. Soft toys making training programme was held in Gopiballavpur-I block. 30 participants took part in the training programme and the training continued for 20 days. Each participants was given certificate after completion the training programme. Most of the trainees have started micro enterprise after completion the training.



Poultry Shed Programme:

DMKK in collaboration with West Bengal Swarojgar Corporation Ltd. has constructed 65 poultry sheds in Dantan I and Mohanpur Block. Dantan Manav Kalyan Kendra has been providing technical support to the beneficiaries for rearing of chicks continuously.

SAG-KP Convergence Programme :

DMKK has started Scheme for Adolescent Girls and Kanyashree Prakalpa(SAG-KP) observance programme in 05 blocks i.e. Dantan-I, Dantan-II, Mohonpur, Keshiary & Narayangarh in Paschim Medinipur district. Concern CDPOs monitor the programme. There are 05 Project Coordinators and 12 field facilitators (FF) for implementation of the programme with the support of Angan Wadi Workers(AWWs). The CDPOs of Dantan-II, Mohonpur & Narayangarh issued work orders to conduct programmes

All children along with staff of DMKK and guests pay garland and flower to the statue of Pt Jaharlal Nehru. The children performed Dance, recitation and Yoga to celebrate the day.

Independence day celebration:



DMKK celebrated 73rd Independence Day with pomp and grandeur at the office premises of Dantan Manav Kalyan Kendra. All special children of Jamuna Balika Abas & Niyoti Day Care Centre, parents of students, staffs, Board members of DMKK & the others renowned person of the locality and from district participated in the programme. cultural programme has been arranged by the students of Niyoti Day Care Centre and the inmates of Jamuna Balika Abas at the office meeting hall.

International Disabled Day Celebration

The beneficiaries and children under Niyoti Day Care Centre & Jamuna Balika Abas celebrated International Disabled Day gorgeously in Dantan –I Block. All special children of Jamuna Balika Abas, Niyoti Day Care Centre & other disabled persons of the locality, parents of beneficiaries, staffs, Board members of DMKK & the respectable persons of the locality participated in the programme. A rally show has been arranged from office premises to Dantan Sarai Bazar bus stand covering Dantan town. About 200 people participated in the rally show. A sports competition for the special children arranged after the rally. Prizes were given to 1st, 2nd and 3rd position holders of every event. In the prize distribution ceremony IC of Dantan Police Station and some eminent persons remained present and encouraged all the special children.



Gandhi Jayanti & Rabindra Jayanti Celebration:

The beneficiaries and children under Niyoti Day Care Centre & Jamuna Balika Abas celebrated Bapuji's birth day on 2nd October and the birth day of Rabi Thakur on 9th May at the meeting hall of Dantan Manav Kalyan Kendra. The special children of Jamuna Balika Abas, Niyoti Day Care Centre & staffs of DMKK participated in the programme. After giving tribute and garland to them we discussed them all the day.

Holi and Rakhi Bandhan Utsav

The Children & beneficiaries under Jamuna Balika Abash & Niyati Day Care Centre and all the staffs celebrated Holi, the festival of Colour and the Rakhi Bandhan Utsav at Dantan Manav Kalyan Kendra. The special children of Jamuna Balika Abas & Niyati Day Care Centre visited different Govt. offices and they share their joy with other office personnel giving them colours and beding Rakhis in the hand of officers and office staff. The rakhis made by the special children of Jamuna Balika Abash & Niyoti Day Care Centre.

Teacher's Day Celebration:

The Children & beneficiaries under Jamuna Balika Abash & Niyati Day Care Centre celebrated the special day at the meeting hall of Dantan Manav Kalyan Kendra. The special children of Jamuna Balika Abas & Niyati Day Care Centre and the teaching & non-teaching staffs participated in the programme. The teachers were gifted by the students.

International Women's Day Observation:

54 Animators of E Shakti Programme took part in the programme. This day was celebrated to show respect to women. Some guests were also invited to take part in the programme and deliver speech to encourage women. Some of the participants shared their experience and how they are working to empower women.

Martibandana Utsab

Similar to the previous year this year on Mahapanchami all the staffs of DMKK celebrated Martibandana being encouraged by the secretary of the Organization. All the staffs purchased new Sharee for their mothers and through a programme where all mothers were there, we dedicate our gifts to them before Durgapuja. This is a innovative programme through which we worship our mother along with our Goddess Devi Durga.

3.HEALTH PROJECT

DMKK all the year round in collaboration with different philanthropic agencies has been conducting several health related programmes totally free of cost including Health Check up Camp, Eye Camp, Cataract operation camp, Cleft lip & Palate surgery, Tuberculosis Eradication Programme and facilitating a Rogi sahayata Kendra.

Eye Camp & Cataract Operation:

Dantan Manav Kalyan Kendra in collaboration with Rotary Eye Hospital, Midnapur conducted 3 eye camps in Dantan-I block. Eyes of 212 persons have been checked and 39 people have been selected for cataract operation. Cataract operations were done at Rotary Eye hospital, Midnapur. All the operations were done free of cost. After successful operation spectacles and medicine were given to the patients.

Rogi Sahayata Kendra:

DMKK in collaboration with Dantan Rural Hospital has been running a Rogi Sahayata Kendra at Dantan Rural Hospital. Two rogi sahayaks are engaged to provide services & information to the patients & their relatives. The Rogi Sahayata Kendra is being run under Swastha Sathi Scheme. Many people got the facilities of it and they got the primary information then and there.

Axshaya Project:

DMKK in collaboration with CBCI-CARD jointly work in five blocks i.e. Dantan-I, Datan-II, Keshiyari and Narayangarh Block under Paschim Medinipur district to support the National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme. Total ten volunteers are there and give their effort to eradicate TB. Total 6052 house hold visited, 436 sputum collection & test done, 138 X-Ray done and 34 positive case identified by the volunteers. Side by side two health check up camps were done in Dantan-I & in Dantan-II Block.

Tuberculosis Elimination Programme:

DMKK in collaboration with Health & Family Welfare Samity, Paschim Medinipur has been running a programme to 'control TB in Urban Slum' at Kharagpur Municipality. 04 volunteers have been engaged. We are working on 20000 population covering 06 wards in Kharagpur Municipality.

Blood Donation Camp:

DMKK in collaboration with Krishnapur Unprivileged Service Society organized a blood donation camp at the office of Dantan Manav Kalyan Kendra. 32 donors donated blood voluntarily. Kharagpur Blood bank collected blood from the camp.



4. WORKSHOP, SEMINAR, FAIR & AWARENESS PROGRAMME

Ek Bharat Srestha Bharat Programme:

DMKK in collaboration with Nehru Yuva Kendra, Paschim Medinipur organized a camp named Swachh Bharat Summer Internship Camp for two months in Dantan –I Block in Paschim Medinipur. This is a campaign in India which aims to clean up the alleys, streets, roads, drains in the Rural & town areas. Dantan Manav Kalyan Kendra along with its members engages itself in the said campaigns in Dantan 1/8, Chackismailpur, Angua & Monoharpur GP and the surrounds area of Dantan town.



Through this campaign we focus on the objective of Swachh Bharat i.e. eliminating open defecation through the construction of household-owned and community owned toilets to achieve an open Defecation Free India. We conducted 5 awareness meetings with the member of SHGs, youth leaders of different youth clubs & farmers, rally, poster, wall painting, Slide Show, street and drain cleaning programme and door to door visit. DMKK is selected as second prize winning team in paschim Medinipur.

Workshop on Child Sexual Abuse:

Volunteers of IIT, Kharagpur under Bal Raksha Project of CRY organized a workshop on child sexual abuse at the office premises of Dantan Manav Kalyan Kendra. The children under CWSN girls home and beneficiaries under Niyati day care centre participated in the workshop. The volunteers discussed about the topic using PPT and role play. They made the participants to understand how to say 'NO' and how they will protect themselves from sexual abuse.

Workshop to promote DED Scheme:

Dairy Entrepreneurship Development Programme is one of the subsidy oriented schemes of NABARD. DMKK conducted a workshop on DED Scheme. DDM, NABARD, Paschim Medinipur, Dy. Director (ARD), Paschim Medinipur, BLDO, Dantan-I, Branch Manager, United Bank of India, Dantan Branch, Branch Manager-State Bank of India, Dantan Branch discussed about the scheme. 65 women from SHGs took part in the workshop. Bankers promised that they would process the loan application.

5.COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES

Dr Asha Das Memorial Library:

In memory of Late Dr. Asha Das, and with the financial help from her sister Mrs. Bina Das, DMKK has been running a rural library at its own premises located at Krishnapur. Apart from story books, the library also hosts text books for students. Daily newspaper and monthly magazines are also subscribed. Library remains open from 3 p.m. to 8 p.m. every day (except Sunday). On an average 22-25 readers come to library every day.

New Clothes Distribution among Distressed Children before Durga Puja:

Some students and some teachers of The Heritage School, Kolkata visited DMKK office in the eve of Durga Puja. They brought new dresses for the inmates of Jamuna Balika Abash & Niyoti Day Care Centre. They also gifted us some dresses for distribution among children in

distressed. DMKK has distributed such dresses among the children belong to vulnerable families before Durga Puja.

COVID 19 Response Work:

The SHG members under EShakti programme made face masks. DMKK supplied clothe to the SHG members and gave making charges to them. 14267 nos face masks made by DMKK and distributed to medicine shopkeeper, vegetable seller, grocery shopkeeper and frontline workers of COVID-19 i.e. ASHA workers, police personnel, civic volunteers etc. DMKK also distributed dry ration and nutritious food to the pregnant women belong to vulnerable families under Dantan-I block. 472 such pregnant mothers have been provided supplementary food to meet-up nutritional deficiency during lock down due to COVID-19.

Work Camp:

DMKK in collaboration with Nehru Yuva Kendra, Paschim Medinipur conducted work camp. 30 youths of our locality devoted voluntary labour in construction of platform of 03 nos tube wells. DMKK also dug a pond on its own land to conserve rain water as a part of work camp activity. Mrs Swathi Roy-District Youth Coordinator, Nehru Yuva Kendra, Paschim Medinipur along with Nandita Bhattacharya-Dy. Director, Nehru Yuva Kendra visited the work camp activity and applauded the youth who served works.



Quilt distribution to the inmates of CWSN Home:

DMKK requested Church's Auxiliary for Social Action(CASA), Eastern Regional office to sanction quilt to the special children of our home. The authority of CASA approved quilts for all the special children residing at our home. Quilts were distributed among the special children in a programme held on 14th November 2019.

6. AGRICULTURE & ANIMAL HUSBANDARY

Producer Organization Promoting Institution (POPI) Project:

DMKK In collaboration with NABARD has been working as a Producer Organization Promoting Institution (POPI) in Paschim Medinipur District. Being a Producer Organization Promoting institution (POPI), DMKK had promoted seven POs and developing sound organizational structure, effective capacity building & providing hand holdings with the active support of District Development Manager, NABARD, Paschim Medinipur. The objective of the POs is to ensure sustainable better income realization to its members who are producers through aggregation and if feasible, value addition. Sharing of profit among members is another objective of the POs. All the producer organizations are farm based and registered under Company registration act . The Joyguru FPC Ltd. has purchased a combined harvester & Aromatic Rice processing machine. The Tilottama Krishi Seba Company Ltd. is cultivating Black gram in large scale from foundation seed to certified seed. The Sukundiha Bandhu Gosthi company Ltd. is producing vermin compost in business manner in large scale. VRD company Ltd. is making paper plates & involve in contact farming i.e. banana. Shilpashree is producing Black rice & Denkhi rice through SHG members. Jhargram Producer Company is cultivating oil seeds and involve contact farming i.e. Maringa and Banana and Progressive Handicraft Unit company Ltd. is manufacturing variety products of mat in large scale & export them.

7. DISABILITY PROJECT

Prosthetic Aids and Appliances distribution:

DMKK in collaboration with National Institute Locomotor Disabilities(NILD), Kolkata conducted disability evaluation and assessment camp at Dantan-II and Keshiary block in Paschim Medinipur district. After the evaluation and assessment camp a list has been prepared for giving the prosthetic aids and appliances among the identified disabled persons. 11 Nos Tri Cycles, 21 nos Wheel Chairs, 23 Nos cruches, 13 nos hearing aids and one walking stick were distributed among the identified beneficiaries in Dantan-II block. 26 Nos Tri Cycles, 33 nos Wheel Chairs, 20 Nos cruches, 08 nos hearing aids and to walking stick were distributed among the identified beneficiaries in Keshiary block in Paschim Medinipur district.



Niyoti Day Care Centre:

DMKK started a day care centre for Mental Retarded, Autism, Cerebral Palsy and Multiple Disabled persons under Disha cum Vikaas scheme of National Trust. PwDs having age above 10 years may be admitted in the centre. 39 PwDs from different locations come to the centre. 2 Special Educator, 3 Care givers, one physiotherapist, one speech therapist, two ayas, one cook are engaged to provide service to 39 PwDs. Among 39 PwDs, 30 belong to BPL families, 4 LIG category and rest 5 from Non LIG category. Two cars are there to pick-up and get down the beneficiaries from their home to centre and centre to their home. Birth day of each and every beneficiaries are celebrated to give special emphasis to the beneficiaries. Health check-up camps by the doctors of Dantan Rural Hospital as well as specialist doctors are conducted. The centre remains open from 10:00am to 4:00pm of every week except Sunday and Govt. Holidays. Lunch is provided to all beneficiaries during lunch time.

Students' Birth Day Celebration

DMKK celebrates birth month of the children whose birth falls in that particular month. All special children of Niyoti Day Care Centre, Staffs, and others members remained present during the programme held in every month and wish a happy birth day for them. This is a very innovative programme.

Jamuna Balika Abash:

DMKK has been running a CWSN home, named Jamuna Balika Abash for Children (girls) With Special Needs (CWSN) below 18 years of age under JJ Act 2015 in association with Women and Child Development and Social Welfare Department, Govt. of West Bengal under ICPS programme of Women and Child Development Dept, Govt of India. 20 special children reside there. Out of 20 children, 18 children have been admitted general schools i.e. Dantan Bhagbat Charan High School, Dantan Binapani Girls School(HS) & Chaulia MSK in different classes. They children go to school 3 days in a week. They attended day care centre in another 3 days. Besides general education they are given special training on

drawing, dancing, Yoga and vocational courses. Some the children participate in different competitions and stand position.

Rakhi Making Greetings card making by the Special children:

The special children under Jamuna Balika Abash and Niyoti Day Care Centre were given special training on Rakhi Making and greetings card making. The children visited different offices and bend rakhi in the hand of officers i.e. DM, ADM, SP, SDO, DSWO, DPO, BDO, IC, CDPO etc office staff, The children also made greetings card and visited different offices and wishes the officers in the eve of Happy New year 2020.

Niramoy Health Insurance

DMKK, as a partner agency of National Trust run a Health Insurance Plan for the Mental Retarded, Autism, Cerebral Palsy and Multiple Disabled persons in Paschim Medinipur district. Total 17 students of Niyati Day Centre are enrolled under this scheme. They get the benefits of it regularly.
