OFFER has been serving children who are severely under privileged in the city of Kolkata and semi urban areas of West Bengal. Providing institutional specialized healthcare, psycho – social support to the children with HIV/AIDS, mentally challenged children and other 5000 children in need.

Apanjan, a project of OFFER (An integrated development project for mentally challenged children) It has two Units are in the residential unit and other is a non-residential units. Namely residential unit for boys and girls. It also has community support service and vocational training centre. In residential unit children are taught activity of daily living like toileting, brushing, dressing, bathing etc. which is very important for their self independency through trained care given under the guidance of special educators. They are also given good nutritional, clinical, and psychological support. For recreational purpose there are many outdoor and indoor games to play with they also watch cartoons and children movies on television sets. All staff and children of Apanjan lives together in a family atmosphere. Actually a home away from home.

Day Care centre starts from 11.00 A.M. to 4.00 P.M. everyday except Saturday and Sunday. There is a mixed group of residential and non-residential students coming to social for their growth and development in all the areas like personal, social, academic, occupational and recreational areas, through special educators. Need based therapy are given to all children like speech therapy, physiotherapy, psychological therapy for their betterment in the respective area.

In the vocational training centre children above the age of 18 years are engaged here children are trained here to make cakes, bread, buns etc. for their own consumption, ultimately they will acquire skills for their self independency Parents training programme are also organised that only for their development of their children but also promoting awareness among communities.

Nearly all festivals are celebrated at Apanjan campus like Durga Puja, Saraswati Puja, Lakshmi Puja, Holi Utsav etc. with lots of enjoyment, ultimately it will help them in their social integration.

Finally all sorts of therapy and amenities are provided to the children for their Holistic development under the roof of Apanjan.
