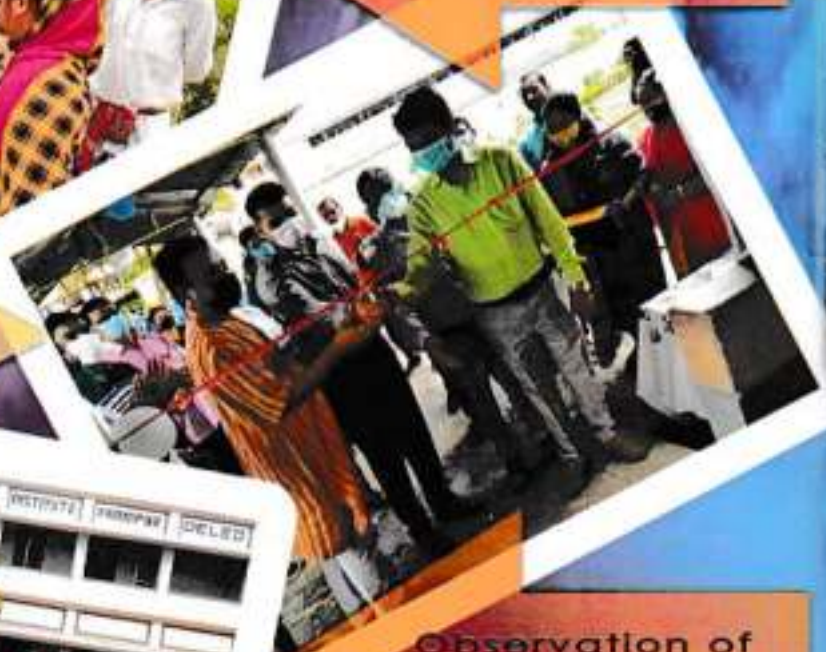

This is the valiant voice vociferated by Swami Vivekananda, the great Indian philosopher and our ideal as well as idol to unite specially the young generation for rural reconstruction and development.

Inspired with the ideals of this lion-hearted saint some sensible young people of our locality assembled under a saffron umbrella christened as Akhil Bharat Vivekananda Yuba Mahamondal, an organization which lays emphasis on both physical and mental development of the youth and on relieving the sufferings of mankind. Mr. Braja Gopal Sahoo, the Ex General Secretary of the organization, along with a group of youngsters became member of that Mahamondal at their teens and nurtured the idea of setting up an independent organization similar to that in the locality in the year 1974. Mr. Mrinal Adhya, a Govt. employee inspired them.

With a tireless striving stretching towards the goal, Vivekananda Loksiksha Niketan saw the light of the day as a non - governmental organization (NGO) for informal social reconstruction and change, being established in the year 1982. Slowly but steadily various milestones in its perilous journey towards the service of mankind have gradually been crossed.

In the beginning the organization purchased 63 decimals of land at Faridpur at a low rate of price. Then it acquired further land at Faridpur, Contai town & Digha Tourist Spot and now possesses the total land of 5.86 acres on which several project buildings have been made erected.

Another historical landmark glorifying the organization is that it has already crossed the significant milestone of the struggled journey of 39 years. During the year 2007-08, it celebrated the Silver Jubilee festival to commemorate its significant success which will flash upon the future years.

**From the desk of the General Secretary**

My respected President,  
Members, Invitees & Guests,

I pay warm thanks and congratulations to all of you assembled in this Annual General Meeting held on date about one year after the last AGM on 13.06.2021.

The activities of this organization during the year under report are furnished hereunder for your information, knowledge & acceptance after proper discussion in the house.

The details are given below serially.

At the very beginning, whenever we had no projects of our own, the District Council for Child Welfare, Midnapore at Nandakumar graced us allotting one of their units of Early Childhood Education Centre (ECE) at this organization which continued for a few years here. Such introduction inspired us to proceed on the themes of care, protection, education and development of children, in future.

**Concept of Human Resource and Rural Development**

According to the ideals of Swami Vivekananda man is the focal point of all developments. We also believe that human being is the most important creature in this world. So, the development of Human Resource is our prime object. We have tried our best to achieve the preliminary development of that resource from childhood to old age step by step and simultaneously.

Following the doctrine of Dr. Amartya Sen, the Nobel Laureate, who observed that the best investment of any developing country is the investment in health, nutrition and education of children, we try our best to reach every aspect of human life from the cradle to the last, as shortly stated ahead.

## Handloom Production Unit

Running since 1987

For self-employment of rural women, we started a production unit for weaving under financial assistance of the CAPART in 1987 at Vivekananda Complex of the organization at Faridpur. More than three decades have passed and we are glad that the unit is still being continued & 15 needy women are engaged there for their part-time earnings beyond their regular domestic work. In accordance with engagement of time the women earn some amount of money per month. One skilled trainer is engaged here on part-time basis.

Now the unit runs at our own financial enterprise. Quality goods are being produced to sell in the market.

## National Creche Scheme

It is a scheme of Central Social Welfare Board. We got sanction of 2 creche centers out of which one in 1986 and the other in 1987. It is a noble and effective scheme both for babies and their mothers. The babies, particularly of working & ailing mothers, face various problems of existence & development owing to absence of proper maternal care. To mitigate the problems partially, the organization has been operating these centers in Contai-II Block, one at village Dakshin Paikbar and the other at village Paschim Bamunia. Babies in the age group from 0-5 years are being provided there with maternal care, supplementary nutrition & pre-school education. 25 babies at each unit are being benefitted. Mid-day meal is provided to babies from 9 am to 5 pm. As per Govt. order the centres have remained closed during the pandemic COVID-19. As per verbal order by the CDPO, Contai -II (Deshapran Block) the food articles & sanitizer kits have been sent to the babies through the concerned guardians upto the 31st March, 2022. Though we have not received any grant-in-aid since April, 2019, we have been continuing the centres by personal loans.

## Integrated Child Development Service (ICDS) Programme

Running since 1999

(Office shifted to Purba Mukundapur, Basantia since 29.07.2016)

ICDS is a unique programme meant for all round development of the children up to 6 years of age. We were allotted to run this project by the **Department of Women and Child Development & Social Welfare, Govt. of W.B.** It is a national programme of our country under the Ministry of Women & Child Development, Govt. of India. It serves a major role for upliftment and all round integrated development of mothers & children concerned. The scheme launched in our country on the second day of October, 1975. We started the scheme for

implementation throughout the entire jurisdiction of Contai II (Deshapran) Block in the district of Purba Medinipur in 1999 and have been continuing in 214 centers in the Block area of 8 (eight) Gram Panchayats. Phone No. -03220-253589. The office has been shifted to Purba Mukundapur, Basantia on 29.07.2016.

G.P. compilation meetings are regularly held once in the 4th week at G.P. headquarters incorporating ICDS supervisors, Health Workers (ANM), Gram Pradhan & all GP members, along with some other officials of several Govt. Departments related to Gram Panchayat level activities.

Besides the above, another GP meeting is held once a month where ICDS Supervisors and all Anganwadi Workers attend specially to discuss on the agenda of Child Development Affairs. Moreover one monthly Block Level Meeting is held at the new office premises

As per Govt. order the centres remained closed during the pandemic COVID-19. The food articles (HR) have been sent to the baby through the concerned guardians upto the month of January, 2022. Since the last few days of February, 2022 the centres have been running the usual way.

Retirement benefit of Rs.3 Lakh at a time for Anganwadi Workers & Helpers has been declared by the Govt. to be paid after retirement with effect from September, 2020.

### **Kheya Senior Citizens' Home**

Owing to abolition of joint family system, old men & women in the family are being neglected. Sufferings of old women in the society, especially in poverty stricken rural families have reached extreme level. Considering the sufferings of neglected helpless old women, VLN started Senior Citizens' Home for women (25 head capacity) on 01.03.1994. Now the Home is at NIBEDITA COMPLEX, Faridpur under financial assistance from the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India. Contact No. 9434943246.

## **Family Counseling Centre (FCC)**

Contact No. 7718752097

It is a noble programme of the Central Social Welfare Board, New Delhi. The centre started operation on 10.07.2000. Women are not only in vulnerable and difficult situation outside their homes but also in their homes where they get victimized with both physical & mental tortures. The women have to get rid of it either escaping from the family or having amicable & respectful settlement with the family members, especially with husband. Such sufferers or victimized women get help from this centre after appealing to appropriate authority i.e. counselors. After receipt of complaints the counselor in charge calls on the husband or in-laws for discussion between both the parties to dispose of the disputes through settlements, to provide legal assistance or arrange rehabilitation for the victimized women. In case of failure, the counselor refers the case to the Sub-Divisional Court. Total Registered Cases during the year -76. No. of cases closed -101, Cases solved amicably-43, No of total benificersies -1360.

The centre has been visited by Mr. Subhas Azad, Welfare Officer, WBSWB & Mrs. Samita Dey Sarkar, Protection Officer, Purba Medinipur on 13.12.2021.

## **WORKING WOMEN'S HOSTEL**

Women are confronted with a variety of problems both within and outside their homes. Such problems are manifested when the women come out of their homes in search of employment. The problems further aggravate in care and safty in the places of employment if far away from their homes. To mitigate the problems of such women, the Organization constructed the Hostel in the heart of Contai town at Mouza-Purba Kumorepur (School Bazar) with financial assistance from the Ministry of Women & Child Development, Govt. of India. It started on 10.01.1999. The Hostel presently consists of 52 resident capacity and provides comfortable living and balanced food along with total security. Present No. of boarders-25. They are happy to stay there.



## SONAR TOREE SWADHAR GREH

(A Home for protection of Women in distress)

It runs at NIVEDITA COMPLEX, Faridpur with sanction by the Ministry of Women & Child Development, Govt. of India. It is a scheme for protection of women with their minor children in difficult circumstances. Widows deserted by their families or relatives become victims of exploitation, women prisoners released from the jail and without any family support, women survivors of natural disaster left without shelters or any social & economic support, trafficked girls or women rescued or runaway from brothels or other places or such victims of sexual crimes disowned by the respective families do not want to go back to their own places for various reasons.

Mentally Challenged women who are without any support from their respective families or such other women fallen in some difficult circumstances are taken as residents in this Home with 30 resident capacity. In the beginning of the financial year total residents -26 (Woman-24, Children - 02) New admission -11 woman, 1 children, discharge -12 women, 2 children, woman. Now Total 25 residents (Women -24, child- 01) existed as on 31.03.2022. Contact No.- 6295870461.

## Bodhodaya Children's Home

Since 16.01.2008 we have been running this Child Care Institution (CCI under JJ Act.) for 50 MR boys within the age group from 6 to 18 years under the Deptt. of Child Rights & Trafficking, Govt. of West Bengal and Ministry of WCD, Govt. of India. It is at our NETAJI COMPLEX, Faridpur. The residents are provided with free food, lodging, education and

such other facilities. The helpless, poor, neglected CWSN boys, who have actually none to provide them with care & protection, are admitted into this Home as per norms or orders of the government following the provisions of Juvenile Justice Act.

## Cradle Baby Receiving Centre



We have opened 2 centres for receiving the surrendered fondling babies ( new born and early stage of age) - one at School Bazar, Contai near our Working Women's Hostel and the other at Faridpur near SAA. On receiving the baby will be placed before CWC for having order of admission into SAA or for health care & treatment at Hospital .

### Disability Welfare

Certain people are born with a variety of disabilities but otherwise they are equal or even more capable than normal human beings. However, they may require some assistance initially to overcome their disabilities. But we remember that they demand only empathy, not sympathy from able -bodied people. For the purpose the Government of India enacted two specific legislations, namely :

- 1) Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016
- 2) The Legal Guardianship and National Trust Act, 1999.

VLN has got registration under both the acts.

It has an ardent duty of the Civil Society Organisations like **Vivekananda Lokshiksha Niketan** to make people in general and also those in power aware of such problems and contribute their might for rehabilitation of such people in the society with dignity and convert these human resources from the present day status of parasites and liabilities to productive factors for the respective families, It is also reported here that we have been included in the Zilla Committee to reach the above noted goal at the earliest. This year some applications are still in the blink of scrutiny for having legal guardianship. Efforts are on greater dimension to create awareness through out our district and in the meantime some MR Children have got their legal gaurdians after scrutiny in presence of our DM.

#### L.L.C. Membership

We have registration from National Trust and our NGO has been nominated as the member of L.L.C., Purba Medinipur with Special post of NGO convener. Sri Mrinal Kanti Praharaj, Joint Secretary of the Organization, has been working as the authorized representative of VLN there.



## Special School for the VH & MR

To provide special education to the especially able children who are not capable of having formal education in normal schools, we started the special school for visually and mentally challenged children with only 18 pupils with effect from May 2, 1998. Initially, the project was financed by local contributions.

Gradually, the initiative gathered momentum and reached a landmark on February 1, 2001 when the school got **recognition** of the Mass Education Extension Department of the Government of West Bengal. During the same year, VLN got itself registered under the Persons with Disabilities Act, 1995. The school got **sponsorship** on 01.12.2005 from the Dept. of Mass Education Extension, Govt. of West Bengal. Though there is sanction for 89 pupils, we have 94 (upto Class V) in total. Out of them VH-37 & MR-57. As in the previous year 2020, in 2021 also owing to pandemic COVID-19 our school remained closed as per order by the Govt. As a result the pupils suffered a great loss. Yet our teachers tried their best to impart education to the pupils whose families possess smartphones. They did it through talkings, story-telling, etc. at the pupils' convenient time. The pupils were distributed rice, dal, potatoes, etc. for their mid-day meals along with sanitization kits regularly through the guardians concerned. Besides, school bags, shoes, etc. too were distributed to them. The cyclonic storm Umphan ruined the kitchen and dining room of the school verily. At this with the financial assistance of Rs.434447/- from the Mass Education Dept. they have been re-constructed fine. Moreover, the cyclonic storm Yass in 2021 ruined the doors and the windows of the school for which we received Rs.10500/- from Dept. and we have repaired them duly. Later, as a preparation of reopening the school Rs.10000/- was received from the Dept. to clean and sanitize the school campus and we properly utilized the same. Application has already been submitted to the Dept. to upgrade the school upto class VIII. By the way the Dept. has considered for development of infrastructure of our school. So resolution has been made by the M.C. for school rooms, lift, swimming pool, model toilet, etc.

## D.Ed. Special Education (MR)

Recognized by RCI, Govt of India

At Vivekananda Complex, Faridpur the course started in September, 2013. It is equivalent to D.El.Ed course and the successful trainees are eligible for candidature of TET examination for primary school teachership. The course is recognized by Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI), a statutory body of the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India. Such education is required for Special Educators / Resource Teachers to teach the differently able children, especially mentally retarded

primary school goers. The course is of 2 years duration and the admission procedure is as per RCI Rules. The session starts in July every year. Total intake-30. Beneficiaries during the academic year-19.

## B.Ed. Special Education ( MR)

Our Study Centre Code No. is SEMR – 04.

Like formal education to normal students, there is need of special education to especially able children, especially the Blind, the Mentally Retarded, and the Hearing Impaired. As specially able children are unable to undergo normal education methods, separate & special course & methodology have been introduced by several Universities of our country. Realizing the deficiency of properly educated teachers in such special methodology, **Netaji Subhash Open University** introduced B.Ed. Special Education course through eligible educational Institutions, NGOs, etc. for conducting such special teachers' training in collaboration with **Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI)**. since 2005-06 academic session RCI approved ODL Course (B.Ed. Spl. Ed. MR- ODL) of 2+½ yrs. i.e. 5 semesters has been introduced at Vivekananda Complex, Faridpur as a Study Centre of the University. Now the intake of students is 40. Beneficiaries during the academic year-29.

**Eligibility for admission:** Passed 10+ 2 + 3 or equivalent with 50 % of marks in any stream (as per State Govt. rules).

## Vivekananda Primary Teachers' Training Institute (VPTTI)

The Institute is at Vivekananda Complex, Faridpur, and has been recognized by NCTE since 30.08.2008 and affiliated to W.B.B.P.E. since 21.05.2009. The institute has well-equipped multistoried building with adequate library facilities, ICT facilities, psychological lab., science lab., gymnasium facilities, two playgrounds, a superb multipurpose hall and dignified suitable manpower to provide quality education to the would be teachers of next generation. It has two separate hostels, one for boys and the other for girls. It also has waiting rooms for guests. Total intake 100. Beneficiaries during the academic year-100.

**Eligibility for admission:** Passed 10+ 2 or equivalent with 50 % of marks in any stream (as per State Govt. rules).

Additional course B.Ed. with an intake 50 from the academic session 2016-17 has been recognized by NCTE and affiliated to WBUTTEPA in composite setting.

It is a special enterprise of VLN to meet up the needs of old people or retired persons who may reside here paying costs for food & lodging, etc. The two storied building consists of 35 rooms to be used. We have provision to upgrade some rooms under A.C. system in future.

We have allowed some rooms to be used as Guest House for tourists, visitors, officers, etc. with a large CONFERENCE HALL there at a reasonable rate. We have also allowed special privilege to other NGO visitors.

It is located at New Digha (Near Amaravati Park & beside Toy Train) at a short distance from Digha Rly. Station. Contact Nos. 8670703500 & 9002464577.

**SAG-KP  
Convergence Programme**

Having had approval from the Deptt. of Women & Child Development, Govt. of West Bengal the Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG)- Kanyashree Prakalpa Convergence Programme started on 01.12.2019 in five Blocks and has been being continued through the respective ICDS offices in Contai- 1, Contai Urban, Ramnagar-I, Egra -I & Egra- II towards empowerment of adolescent girls. Total staff -13 ( PC-5 & FF-8). They work in the concerned ICDS office and work under the instruction of CDPO. Though the program was made discontinued from 01.04.2021 to 31.12.2021 by the Dept. concerned as they liked yet it resumed from 01.01.2022 till 31.12.2022.

## Multi -Gym

We got sanctioned for construction of a Multi-Gymnasium (Indoor game with Physical Culture) building from Hon'ble Ex-M.P. Mr. Prasanta Pradhan who allotted the sum of Rs. 3,00,000/- for the same.

It is being continued at Vivekananda Complex, Faridpur. Women residents of Senior Citizens' Home, Swadhar Greh, boys of Bodhodaya Home, students of VH & MR School including the trainees of D.El.Ed., D.Ed.SE(MR), B.Ed & B.Ed.SE(MR) do their regular practices here. Besides, some local youths come for practice against a token fee.

## Shikshasathi

It is a new project at Vivekananda Complex, Faridpur as a supporting educational help to the needy & helpless students of the locality. It is completely under self-finance and without seeking any assistance from the government sector. It started in January, 2016. Students come every day to get coaching on tutorial basis. Selected needy students from class VI to class X are benefitted with this scheme. Total beneficiaries-93.

## Muktaneer Open Shelter

The Shelter started in 2018 at Muktaneer Complex, Contai (Near Central Bus Terminus). It has been being continued there in the Contai Municipal area with three contact points: i) Mukta Neer Complex ii) School Bazar & iii) Darua, with financial assistance from the Ministry of Women and Child Development, Govt. of India and Deptt. of Women & Child Development, Govt. of West Bengal under ICPS for 25 boys in the age group between 6 and 18 years. To cater to children in need of care and protection particularly beggars, street and working children, rag pickers, small vendors, street performers, orphans, deserted or trafficked or run away children, children of migrant population and any other vulnerable group of children are our beneficiaries. Contact No. 7585891862. Residents as on 01.04.2021 - 20 boys and on 01.03.2022-20 boys. Total beneficiaries during the year-27.

## Shalmohua Senior Citizens' Home

The old women in the district of Jhargram are more neglected than the old men there and most of them are dependent either on alms or on shal leave collection. Under this circumstance we have been running a Senior Citizens' Home at Gidhni, PS- Jamboni in this district for poor neglected and helpless old women during the last 5 years. It is the oldest Home in the district and the location of the Home is completely a tribal area. No other Homes are in existence within 75 km from our Home. Total beneficiaries -50. But owing to CIVID -19 Pandemic, we have sent the residents to their concerned homes during the financial year as per state guidelines.



## Utkarsh Bangla Skill Development Training Centre

To improve the scope of gainful employment and entrepreneurial opportunities for the youth in the locality under "Utkarsh Bangla" scheme we applied to

the PBSSD(Paschim Banga Society for Skill Development) under the aegis of Department of Technical Education, Training and Skill Development, Government of West Bengal. We have got the project sanctioned duly for three trades: (1) Assistant Beauty Therapist, (2) Domestic Data Entry Operator & (3) Junior Software Developer with 30 intake for each of the trades. The Course is completely free of cost to every trainee. Kanyashree Girls will be given preference in selection of trainees. But we have not been able to start the trainings to be implemented in Vivekananda Complex owing to COVID-19 Pandemic.

### Eye Testing Camp

As in the previous years this year also we organized a free Eye Testing Camp on 09.01.2021 at Nivedita Complex, Faridpur with which local people got benefited. A team of doctors & nurses from Chaitanyapur Netra Niramoy Niketan in collaboration with VLN implemented the programme. Eye testing was done for 425 patients, out of them operations were done for 180. Special prescriptions with medicines & spectacles were given to needy patients free of cost.

### Dental Treatment Camp

As in the previous years this year also we organized such camp on 09.01.2021 at Nivedita Complex, Faridpur for free dental and oral diseases treatment. Dr. Rahul Sahoo, MDS & Dr. Sukriti Panda, BDS, the Dental Surgeons of Contai rendered free service with supply of some medicines. Dr. Sahoo conducted the camp. Total beneficiaries -43.

### Blood Donation Camp

A blood donation camp was organized by VLN at Faridpur on 22.08.2021 in association with Lions Club, Contai. 62 people donated their blood in this camp.

### Ambulance Services

Glad to inform that Sri Tushar Kanti Das of Paschim Bamunia wished to donate something for the benefit of local people & Home residents. As proposed by our respectable Ex-President, his mother Sailabala Das donated one vehicle i.e. "Maruti Omni" for use as Ambulance.

The vehicle is easily accessible to all, day & night, for quick transport to destined hospitals, treatment points, etc. for free services to the poor but in exchange of nominal cost from financially able persons. To call for ambulance service, dial MobileNo. 9735239774 (Bishnu Pada Dalai).

## **Staff Welfare Activities**

(Micro-credit :: PF :: Gratuity etc.)

We introduced the programme on Micro Credit basis in 1998. The fund is issued for specific purpose out of the institution's own resource. On emergency or necessity or on demand of the staff, loans are issued to them against nominal service

charges and become realized from salaries by installments. Moreover, we issue loans to the deserving staff for their children's learning, acute illness and marriage of daughters, etc. Facilities of enrollment in EPF started in the year 2014. System of gratuity has also been introduced. The programme has become very helpful to the employees of this organization.

## **IDENTIFICATION & DISTRIBUTION OF AIDS & APPLIANCES TO SPECIALLY ABLED PERSONS**

Every year identification camps of the local disable, that followed by distribution camps, were organized by VLN in association with ALIMCO and financed by CSR fund of different corporate sectors where the target people were given necessary equipments like Tri-cycles, Motorized Tri-cycles, Wheel Chairs, Hearing Aids, MR Kits, Digital Walking Sticks, Crutches, Elbo-Crutches, Commode Wheel Chairs, etc. free of cost. But this year we could not organize the same because of Pandemic COVID-19.

## **Celebration/ Observation of Auspicious Days**

As in the previous years this year also we celebrated the birth day of Swami Vivekananda including the birthdays of eminent personalities of national importance like Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, Vidyasagar, Gandhi, Rabindranath Tagore and so on. We observed International Women's Day, Children's Day, World Disabled Day, Teachers' Day, Independence Day, Republic Day, etc.

## **Chariot Festival**

To encourage the creative talent in children the tradition of chariot festival has been going on from the inception of our organization. It is needless to say that we have won the hearts of younger section of the locality participating in Chariot Festival of Lord Jagannatha on the day of Rathayatra. The festival is organized at Faridpur. Thousands of people attend the fair wherein most of the participants & visitors are school children or the teens from rural area of the locality. This year the programme has been postponed because of Pandemic COVID-19.



## City Guest House

As per our previous plan we have purchased a flat in Kolkata to use it for patients' Care Takers, Job Seekers, Interviewees or Examinees coming from remote places along with our members as well.



## YASS CAMP
